## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (14-17) play Game Two of a four-game series against the Columbus Clippers (14-19) -- now the Cleveland Indians' affiliate -- at all new Huntington Park. With an 8-4 loss last night, the 'Pigs have dropped two straight and are now 2-3 on this eight-game West Division road trip... Columbus just split a four-game series with Pawtucket -- but the Clippers have lost seven of their last 10 games (included a six-game losing streak 5/3-5/8). First-Pitch is at 6:35 p.m.

• *Not Streaky:* Since being swept in the Opening Series vs. SWB, LHV has neither won, nor lost more than 2 straight.

## TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Drew Carpenter**, 23, is a 6-3, 225-pound right-hander drafted by Philadelphia in the 2nd round of 2006 out of Long Beach State -- and a member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster. The Vacaville, CA, native spent a bulk of 2008 in Double-A Reading, going just 6-8 with a 5.67 ERA in 16 GS -- but was on the move in the second half, with a stint in Advanced-A Clearwater (3-3, 2.92 in 8 GS from 6/16-7/31), a Major League debut with Philadelphia (scoreless IP of relief 8/27 vs. NYM) and a start with Lehigh Valley on 8/31 @ PAW (L, 7 ip 6 h, 2 er). Carpenter had a stellar 2007 season in Clearwater -- where he led the Florida State League in wins (17) and shutouts (2) while being selected to play in the 2007 FSL All-Star Game. He finished the season 17-6, 3.20 with 1 SV in 27 G, 24 GS, and tied for the league lead in CG (3). Among the highlights in his three-year MLB career was a 7-inning perfect game 8/27/07 vs. Fort Myers (7 ip, 7 k). He also won both his postseason starts (2-0, 2.92) as the Threshers won the 2007 FSL Championship.

- *Carpenter enters the season ranked as the No. 22 Prospect in the organization by Baseball America.*
- *DC pitched very well in Triple-A Spring training (2-0, 1.04 in 2 GS) after starting in ML S.T. (0-1, 8.53 in 3 G).*
- *DC, 5/8 @ TOL (W, 5-4): n/d, 6.0 ip, 3 h, 4 r, 4 er, 4 bb, 5 k Up 3-0, no hits til 2-R HR (Roberson) in 4th; 2-R HR (Ramirez) in 6th*

RHP **Tomo Ohka**, 33, is a 6-1, 200-pound right-hander out of Kyoto, Japan, signed by Cleveland as a minor league free agent 12/5/08. The former Major Leaguer spent his entire 2000 season in the IL with Charlotte, going 5-11, 4.18 in 28 G, 20 GS as a White Sox farm hand. Originally signed by the Red Sox in 1999 after spending 5 seasons with the Yokohama Bay Stars of the Japanese Central League, Ohka made it to the ML in 1999 and went 3-6, 3.12 in 13 G, 12 GS. He has pitched parts of the previous nine seasons in the Majors (Boston, Montreal, Washington, Milwaukee, Toronto) and has a combined record of 50-36, 4.14 ERA in 184 G, 172 GS. He last began 2007 with Toronto (2-5, 5.79 in 10 GS) and was designated for assignment by the Blue Jays 6/7/07. He then signed a minor league contract with St. Louis (6/19/07) and Seattle (8/5/07). He pitched a perfect game for Pawtucket on 6/1/00 vs. Charlotte.

- *Last season, Ohka was 0-7 when he earned his first Charlotte win 5/23/08 @ LHV: W, 5.2 ip, 6 h, r, er, 0 bb, 4 k.*
- *Ohka is coming off a tough-luck, 4-0 loss against Buchholz 5/8 vs. PAW: L, 6.0 ip, 8 h, 2 r, 2 er, 0 bb, 4 k, 1 hr (Denker)*

## SERIES INFORMATION:

COL leads the series, 1-0... The teams split the '08 series, 3-1, with the home teams both going 3-1 -- but that was when COL was a Washington affiliate. LHV and BUF (Cleveland's 2008 affiliate) split the 2008 season-series, 8-8.

## WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

After a 3-28 skid, INF **Pablo Ozuna** has hit safely in his last 8 G (10-29, .345-0-2)... OF **Rich Thompson** snapped his 2009 LHV-high, 9-G hit streak Sunday; but has hit in 11 of his last 12 G (16-52, .308-0-6, 7 2B, 2 3B, 12 R, 5 SB). He is a perfect 9-9 in SB (100%) this season and is now 34-36 (94%) in LHV career... INF **Mike Cervenak** franchise-record 22-game streak of reaching base safely came to an end Monday (0-4); but he has hit in 11 of his last 14 G (20-55, .364-1-12, 7 R); inc. 6 multi-hit G. He is 9 for last 18 w/ RISP (.500)... In his last 20 G, OF **John Mayberry** is batting .289-4-17 (22-76, 7 2B, 7 BB)... OF **Jason Ellison** has hit safely in 7 of last 8 GS (9-27, .333, 3 2B)...

## WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Dave Borkowski** has a current 13.0 scoreless IP streak (6+ G, 0-0, 8 h, 6 bb, 6 k) -- now the longest by any 'Pig in 2009. He has been unscored upon in his last 6 G (12.2 ip) after allowing Rs in first 3 G (5 ip, 8 er)... RHP **Tyler Walker** (on DL) has a season-starting 11.0 scoreless IP streak in his first 6 G. He has only allowed four batters to reach safely: 2 1Bs (inc. a hit-and-run dribbler), a BB and a HB. He's retired 32 of 37 BF (86.4%)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has allowed just 1 R in his last 6 G (8.0 IP). Combined with Reading stats, he had a personal 12.1 score-

less IP streak... RHP Mike Koplove hasn't allowed an ER in last 11 G (1-1, 2 SV, 2 H, 14.1 ip, 10 h, 5 r, 8 bb, 17 k)...

#### PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

In the last 27 G, the 'Pigs pen is 5-4, 2.06 with 4 SV (100.2 ip, 23 er)... The corps had an **amazing run** over a span of 12 G (4/18-5/1) in which it allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41), retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%... At one point, the corps had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 in the first 4 G (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

#### CAN'T GET TO .500!:

The 'Pigs have never been at .500 in franchise history... They lost 9-2 in a chance to get to 15-15 Monday, and are now 0-6 with a chance to get to .500+... The Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't been .500 since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07.

#### KING LEHR!:

After not having an I.L. Pitcher of the Week in 2008, RHP **Justin Lehr** has become the league's first repeat winner in 2009 named Pitcher of Week for May 4-10 (2-0, 1.35, SHO, 13.1 ip, 12 h, 2 er). The IL's first five-game winner this season, Lehr earning two victories during the week: tossing a 7.0-inning shutout Tuesday against Buffalo in G1 of a doubleheader, limiting the Bisons to just three hits and two walks while striking out four. It was just the second shutout in the IL so far this season (Homer Bailey, Louisville; May 2 @ BUF). Lehr's fifth win came Sunday at Toledo. He pitched 6.1 solid innings as the IronPigs went on to win 5-3. It was the fourth "quality start" in six outings for Lehr, who owns more than 1/3 of LHV's 14 victories. In his IL career, Lehr is now 11-3, 2.36 (99.0 ip, 26 er) in 22 G, 14 GS.

#### COUNTDOWN TO 1,500:

'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** is up to 1,494 career MiLB wins -- 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

#### WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES!:

- LHV is still just 14-17, but the IronPigs were 4-27 at this point in 2008. It took the 'Pigs 29 games to get win No. 14 in 2009. Last year, it took 48 games to get win No. 14 -- May 22 vs. Charlotte, when they 'improved' to 14-34.
- The 'Pigs have scored 138 runs in their first 31 G of 2009. It took them until Game 46 (5/19) to get to 138 R in '08.

#### BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Road Warriors?*: The 'Pigs are 6-7 on the road this season. Last season, the 'Pigs lost 14 of their last 16 road games.
- With 20 DPs in the last 14 G, LHV has now turned an IL-best 38 double plays. The next closest teams have 31.
- *Lead Story*: LHV has scored first in 8 of its last 12 G. Prior, the 'Pigs opponents scored first in 11 of last 13.
- *Record Cerved*: With his HR in the 7th yesterday, INF **Mike Cervenak** set a LHV franchise record by reaching base safely in 22 consecutive games. Previously, Jon Knott reached in 21 straight (his streak was 26 as it started w/ 5 G in ROC).
- *Thou Shalt NOT Steal!*: The CS of Wilkin Rakmirez by C **Lou Marson** on a pitch-out Sunday marked the first time a LHV catcher recorded a CS since 4/16 (Hoover gunned down Eldred). Opponents had stolen 25 straight vs. C.
- *Thou Shalt Steal!*: During the 'Long Ball' Era, the stolen base base been coined 'a lost art.' Maybe it should be found. The 'Pigs have have a 89% success rate (24 of 27). Opponents have a 90% success rate (37 of 41).
- *In a Pinch!*: With **Jeremy Slayden's** PH BB and **Pablo Ozuna's** PH 1B on 5/6, LHV pinch-hitters are 4-5 (.800) with a BB, HBP (.857 OBP)... they started 3-24 (.125) in '08.
- *Bowers Powers*: The "W" recorded by LHP **Cedric Bowers** on 5/6 was his first in the IL since 8/20/03 vs. NOR (w/ DUR).
- *Northern Exposure*: The 'Pigs are 10-12 vs. North Division teams after starting 0-4 (started 1-20 last season). Going back to '08, the 'Pigs are just 17-39 (.304) in their last 56 G vs. the ND and 32-70 (.314) in franchise history.
- *Past Last!*: Since 4/14, the 'Pigs have climbed out of the ND cellar. LHV spent the first 5 days of this season in last place after starting in the cellar their first 70 days of 2008.

#### TOP PROSPECTS:

According to *Baseball America*, three of the Top 4 Prospects in the Phillies' system will start in the Lehigh Valley: the returning 22-year-old RHP **Carlos Carrasco** (#2), a three-time member of the World Team's Future Game roster and a pair of 2008 Olympians, C **Lou Marson** (#3) and SS **Jason Donald** (#4).

#### PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 12th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 12th best system: up from 22nd in 2008 (21 in '07; 22 in '06).

#### PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 83-132 (.386) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 101-169 (.374) & a combined 67.0 GB.

- The 'Pigs spent the first 5 days of the '09 season in last place... after spending the first 70 days of '08 in last. To start franchise history, they were in the cellar for 130 of their first 158 days... but been out since April 15, 2009.
