## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (14-20) start an eight-game, nine-day South Division homestand with Game One of a four-game series against the Gwinnett Braves (17-19) -- the Atlanta Braves' affiliate. With an 8-5 loss at Columbus last night, the 'Pigs limped home with a season-long five-game losing streak -- finishing 2-6 on their eight-game West Division road trip... Gwinnett just split a doubleheader at Buffalo last night to split a four-game series at Coca-Cola Field. The Braves are 6-4 in their last 10 games and 12-7 since starting 5-12 (April 25)... LHV is 7-3 in series openers in '09.

- First-Pitch is scheduled for 7:05 p.m. for Fireworks Night, presented by **Coors Light**.

### With last night's loss, the IronPigs:

- Have a season-long 5-game losing streak -- LHV's longest since a six-game skid 8/22-8/27/08.
- Swept in a four-game series for the 2nd time this season (4/9-4/12 vs. SWB) and for the first time in a road four-game series since 8/24-8/27/08 at Pawtucket.
- Swept in a series for the first time in LHV history by a team outside the North Division
- Swept in a four-game series by someone other than Pawtucket (3x) or Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (3x).

## TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

**RHP Kyle Kendrick** -- making just his eighth career Triple-A start -- is a 6-3, 190-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 7th-round of 2003 out of Mt. Vernon (WA) HS -- turning down a scholarship to play QB at Washington State to sign with the Phillies. A member of Philadelphia's 40-Man Roster with 1.110 years of ML service time already accrued, Kendrick was initially promoted from Reading (AA) straight to the Majors on 6/13/07 -- and became a key cog in the Phils' run to capture the N.L. East. He went 10-4, 3.87 in 20 starts, leading all N.L. rookies in wins and ranking 3rd in ERA. Kendrick started 2008 right where he left off -- going 8-3, 4.47 in 19 starts before the All-Star Break. However, he struggled thereafter, finishing just 3-6, 7.59 in his next 11 GS before being left off the Phils' postseason rosters. In all, he is 21-13, 4.78 in 51 G, 50 GS w/ PHI (276.2 ip, 323 h, 147 er, 82 bb, 117 k).  
 • *KK earned the 'W' in the first-ever game at CCP -- a 5-3 PHI victory over LHV in exhibition 3/30/08 (5 ip, 0 r).*  
 • *In ML Spring Training, KK went 1-3, 9.20 in 4 GS. In Triple-A S.T., KK went 0-1, 13.51 in 1 GS (3.1 ip, 5 er).*  
 • *KK, 5/11 @ TOL (L, 9-2): L, 5.0 ip, 9 h, 7 r, 6 er, bb, 4 k Up 1-0, allowed 3 R (2 er) in 3rd; 2-R HR in 4th (Frazier); HR (Kelly) in 5th*

**RHP Tommy Hanson**, 22, is a 6-6, 220-pound right-hander selected by Atlanta in the 22nd round of 2005 out of Riverside (CA) C.C. The Tulsa, Okla., native began last season with Advanced-A Myrtle Beach, going 3-1 with a gaudy 0.90 ERA (7 gs, 40.0 ip, 15 h, 6 r, 4 er, 5 bb, 49 k) before a 5/11 promotion to Double-A Mississippi. With the M-Braves, he continued to excel -- going 8-4, 3.08 in 18 gs (98.0 ip, 70 h, 39 r, 33 er, 41 bb, 114 k). On 6/25/08, he tossed the first no-hitter in Mississippi Braves history, a 6-0 ousting of Birmingham (9.0 ip, 0 h, 0 r, 3 bb, 2 hb, 14 k). Hanson is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 1 Prospect in Atlanta's organization and the fourth-best in all of baseball. The recipient of the Phil Niekro award (given annually to the top pitcher in the Braves' system), Hanson has a career Minor League mark of 21-18, 2.68 (71 g, 65 gs, 363.1 ip, 258 h, 132 r, 107 er, 132 bb, 430 k). Following the 2008 season, Hanson became the first-ever pitcher to be named the Arizona Fall League MVP, going 5-0, 0.63 (28.2 ip, 49 k).

- *Hanson leads the IL with 57 strikeouts and has fanned at least six in all 7 GS; K/BB ratio is an amazing 12.6.*
- *Despite a 1.99 ERA in 7 games, Gwinnett has gone just 2-5 in Hanson's starts.*
- *Last time out, TH worked a season-high 8 ip in 4-3 loss on 5/10 vs. DUR: n/d, 8 ip, 6 h, 3 r, 3 er, bb, 9 k, 3 hr.*

## SERIES INFORMATION:

This is the first-ever meeting between LHV and GWN... Last season, LHV and RIC (Braves affiliate) split the season series, 4-4 -- with the away team going 3-1 in both sets. LHV earned its first franchise win 4/14/08 vs. RIC.

### WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

After a 3-28 skid, INF **Pablo Ozuna** has hit safely in his last 10 G (11-32, .344-0-2) -- passing Rich Thompson's 9-gamer as the '09 LHV-high... Ozuna holds the modern-day Phillies' Triple-A record for hitting streak at 27 G from 7/27-8/24/04 (SWB Red Barons)... INF **Mike Cervenak** franchise-record 22-game streak of reaching base safely came to an end Monday (0-4); but he has hit in his last 4 G (7-15, 2B) and in 14 of his last 17 G (25-67, .373-1-13, 9 R); inc. 8 multi-hit G. He is 9 for last 19 w/ RISP (.474)... OF **John Mayberry** has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 G (10-30, .333-2-6). And, in his last 23 G, is batting .306-6-21 (26-85, 7 2B, 8 BB)... OF **Rich Thompson** snapped his 9-G hit streak Sunday; but has hit in 12 of his last 14 G (17-60, .283-0-6, 7 2B, 2 3B, 12 R, 5 SB). He is a perfect 9-9 in SB (100%) this season and is now 34-36 (94%) in LHV career... OF **Jason Ellison** has hit safely in 7 of last 9 GS (9-31, .290, 3 2B)...

### WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Mike Koplove** hasn't allowed an ER in last 12 G (1-1, 2 SV, 2 H, 15.1 ip, 10 h, 5 r, 8 bb, 18 k)... RHP **Dave Borkowski** had his team-high 13.0 scoreless IP streak snapped Thursday (6+ G, 0-0, 8 h, 6 bb, 6 k) -- allowing 2 R (1 ER) in 2.0 IP... He had been unscored upon in his last 6 G (12.2 ip) after allowing Rs in first 3 G (5 ip, 8 er)... RHP **Tyler Walker** (on DL) has a season-starting 11.0 scoreless IP streak in his first 6 G. He has only allowed four batters to reach safely: 2 1Bs (inc. a hit-and-run dribbler), a BB and a HB. He's retired 32 of 37 BF (86.4%)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has allowed just 1 R in his last 7 G (10.0 IP). Combined with Reading stats, he had a personal 12.1 scoreless IP streak...

### PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

In the last 30 G, the 'Pigs pen is 5-6, 2.17 with 4 SV (108.0 ip, 26 er)... The corps had an **amazing run** over a span of 12 G (4/18-5/1) in which it allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41), retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%... At one point, the corps had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 in the first 4 G (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

### CAN'T GET TO .500!:

The 'Pigs have never been at .500 in franchise history... They lost 9-2 in a chance to get to 15-15 on Monday, and are now 0-6 with a chance to get to .500+... The Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't been .500 since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07.

### KING LEHR!:

After not having an I.L. Pitcher of the Week in 2008, RHP **Justin Lehr** became the league's first repeat winner in 2009 named Pitcher of Week for May 4-10 (2-0, 1.35, SHO, 13.1 ip, 12 h, 2 er). The IL's first 5-game winner this season, Lehr earning two victories during the week: tossing a 7.0-inning shutout Tuesday against Buffalo in G1 of a doubleheader, limiting the Bisons to just 3 hits and 2 walks while striking out 4. It was just the 2nd shutout in the IL so far this season (Homer Bailey, LOU; 5/2 @ BUF). Lehr's 5th win came Sunday at TOL (6.1 ip, 2 er) in a 5-3 win. It was the fourth "quality start" in six outings for Lehr, who owns more than 1/3 of LHV's 14 victories. In his IL career, Lehr is now 11-4, 2.86 (104.0 ip, 33 er) in 23 G, 15 GS.

### COUNTDOWN TO 1,500:

'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** is up to 1,494 career MiLB wins -- 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

### WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES!:

- LHV is still just 14-20, but the IronPigs were 5-29 at this point in 2008. It took the 'Pigs 29 games to get win No. 14 in 2009. Last year, it took 48 games to get win No. 14 -- May 22 vs. Charlotte, when they 'improved' to 14-34.
- The 'Pigs have scored 150 runs in their first 34 G of 2009. It took them until Game 47 (5/20) to get to 150 R in '08.

### PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 83-135 (.381) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 101-172 (.370) & a combined 69.0 GB.

• The 'Pigs spent the first 5 days of the '09 season in last place... after spending the first 70 days of '08 in last. To start franchise history, they were in the cellar for 130 of their first 158 days... but been out since April 15, 2009.

### BACON BITS, PT 1:

- With 22 DPs in the last 17 G, LHV has now turned an IL-best 40 double plays. The next closest team has 35.
- *Road Warriors?*: The 'Pigs are 6-9 on the road this season. Last season, the 'Pigs lost 14 of their last 16 road games.
- *Record Cerved*: With his HR in the 7th Sunday, INF **Mike Cervenak** set a LHV franchise record by reaching base safely in 22 consecutive games. Previously, Jon Knott reached in 21 straight (his streak was 26 as it started w/ 5 G in ROC).
- *Thou Shalt Steal!*: During the 'Long Ball' Era, the stolen base base been coined 'a lost art.' Maybe it should be found. The 'Pigs have have a 89% success rate (24 of 27). Opponents have a 87% success rate (39 of 45).
- *In a Pinch!*: With **Jeremy Slayden's** PH BB and **Pablo Ozuna's** PH 1B on 5/6, LHV pinch-hitters are 4-5 (.800) with a BB, HBP (.857 OBP)... they started 3-24 (.125) in '08.
