## TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (16-25) play the finale of a four-game series against the Durham Bulls (26-16) -- the Tampa Bay Rays' affiliate which remains in second place in the South Division. After blowing a ninth-inning lead in a 5-4 loss last night, the 'Pigs have now dropped nine of their last 11 games and are just 2-5 on this eight-game, nine-day homestand... Durham has won four of its last five games and the Bulls are now 8-2 in their last 10 games... Lehigh Valley will now travel to Buffalo to begin a four-game series with an afternoon game on Monday.

• First-Pitch today is at 1:35 p.m. for IronPigs Camouflage Cap Day, presented by **Stotz & Fatzinger**.

## TODAY'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** -- the youngest IronPig -- is a 6-3, 215-pound 22-year-old signed by Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela on 10/25/03 (at age 16 for \$300,000). A member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster, Carrasco flourished in his Triple-A debut with the 'Pigs after his promotion on 8/2/08 -- going 2-2 with a 1.72 ERA in six starts. He started last season in Double-A Reading, going 7-7 with a 4.32 ERA in 20 G, 19 GS (114.2 ip, 109 h, 58 r, 55 er, 45 bb, 109 k, .254) -- starting out 4-4, 3.10 in his first 10 GS (through 5/25); but going just 3-3, 5.70 in his last 10 games with the R-Phils. In 2007, Carrasco was a Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Clearwater prior to a 6/20 promotion to Reading -- where he threw a rain-shortened 6-inning no-hitter 8/21/07 vs. Altoona (2 bb, 8 k). In 2006, Carrasco captured the Paul Owens Award, awarded to the top pitcher in the PHI system, while helping guide Lakewood to a SAL Championship. Carrasco has also been named to the World Team of the All-Star Futures game each of the last 3 seasons and was the starting and winning pitcher (1.0 ip, 2 k) in '08 at Yankee Stadium on 7/13.

- Carrasco is rated as the #2 Prospect in the system by Baseball America behind Dominic Brown (he was #1 in '08).
- Last 5 GS: 0-4, 8.35 ERA (18.1 ip, 26 h, 17 er, 8 bb, 21 k); First 3 GS: 0-1, 2.37 ERA (19 ip, 14 h, 5 er)
- Home Boy?: Started LHV career with 0 ER in 35.1 IP at Coca-Cola Park; since then: 17 ER, 18.1 IP (8.45 in 4 GS)
- CC, 5/17 vs. GWN (L, 3-2): L, 6 ip, 5 h, 3 r, 3 er, 3 bb, 7 k Up 2-0 w/ 0 hits thru 3 IP, first 4 BF to reach in 3-R 4th (1st QS in 5 GS)

RHP **Wade Davis** -- a member of the Rays' 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-5, 220-pound, 23-year-old righty drafted by Tampa in the 3rd round (75th overall) in 2004 out of Lake Wales (FL) H.S. -- where he was headed to University of Florida prior to signing with the Rays. Last season, the Floridian started in Double-A Montgomery (9-6, 3.85 in 19 GS) -- starting the Southern League All-Star Game (L), which marked the fourth time he'd been an All-Star in the Minors. He was promoted to Durham at the All-Star Break (7/16/08) and went 4-2, 2.72 in 9 GS. Eight of his nine IL appearances were "quality starts" and he was the winning pitcher of the series clinching win over Louisville (6 ip, er, 7 k) in the first round of the IL playoffs. Davis owns two of the six no-hitters in the Rays organization history (5/4/07 vs. Jupiter; 8/31/06 vs. Beloit -- though he lost that game 1-0 due to a pair of errors).

- Davis is rated as the #3 Prospect in the system by Baseball America behind LHP David Price and SS Tim Beckham.
- Last outing, WD started a 1-0 shutout 5/18 vs. ROC (LHP Brian Duensing): W, 6.2 ip, 2 h, 0 r, bb, 3 k (93 pitches).

## SERIES INFORMATION:

DUR now leads the season series is tied, 2-1... LHV won the 2008 series, 6-2; winning the series, 3-1, at Coca-Cola from 7/21-7/24/08. LHV also had its first-ever road series victory, 3-1, from 6/23-26/08 @ DUR.

## EVEN MORE TRANSACTIONS:

Today, LHP **Sergio Escalona** optioned to Lehigh Valley from Philadelphia, where he had three scoreless appearances (1-0, 2.1 ip). With Reading, he was 0-0, 2.08 and 10 SV in 14 G (17.1 ip, 15 h, 4 r, 4 er, 8 bb, 16 k)... In addition, INF **Jorge Velandia** was reassigned to Lehigh Valley from Williamsport (R). He has gone 1-10, HR, 2 RBI in 4 G... RHP **Dave Borkowski** released by Philadelphia Phillies. He had been unscored upon in 7 of his last 8 G (16.2 ip, er) after allowing Rs in first 3 G (5 ip, 8 er)... That's now 12 transactions in the last 4 days...

## BACON BITS, PT 1:

- BULLish Pen: The DUR relievers wnet 6 shutout IP last night and have now gone 13 scoreless in the series (3 h).
- The 4-run lead blown by LHV ties their largest in '09 (5/2 vs. TOL). Twas also the 13th time in 25 losses LHV blew a lead.
- The back-to-back HR last night by **David Newhan** and **Lou Marson** were the first for-or-against the 'Pigs in '09 (1st since 8/7 @ ROC: Tracy, Knott) & the 4th in LHV history... Also the 1st at CCP since 7/17 vs. SWB (Tracy, Knott).

### REHABS:

LHP **J.C. Romero** made another ML rehab assignment with the 'Pigs on Friday (H, 1.0 ip, 1 k in 13 pitches) -- and is 0-1, H, 4.50 ERA in 2 G with LHV (2.0 ip, 2 h, r, er, bb, 3 k). According to MLB policy, he has 16 games to prepare for his return from a 50-game suspension for violating MLB's Banned Substance Policy. He was suspended 1/6/09.

*Other notable rehabs at Coca-Cola Park:* OF **Shane Victorino** (4/26-4/27/08), RHP **Rudy Seanez** (8/11/08), C **Carlos Ruiz** (4/25-5/1); Boston's RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka** (6/16/08) & SS **Julio Lugo** (4/24-4/26/09); Detroit's LHP **Dontrelle Willis** (5/1/09). All ML rehab assignments at CCP are presented by **Good Shephard Rehabilitation Network**.

### SAY IT AIN'T SO, CERVII:

After starting in the first 35 G (reaching safely in 33), INF **Mike Cervenak** was placed on the D.L. 5/18 (retro to 5/17) with a right wrist fracture (HBP, Tommy Hanson on Saturday night) -- and a time-table for his return is not yet know. The IronPigs are 10-24 (.294) when he has been out of the lineup in 2008-09. He is batting .326-3-23 this season and reached base safely in a LHV-record 22-consecutive games from 4/17-5/10.

### WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF **Pablo Ozuna** snapped his '09 LHV high 13-G hitting streak Tuesday (0-4). He hit .422-0-4 (19-45) during streak... Ozuna holds the modern-day Phillies' Triple-A record for hitting streak at 27 G from 7/27-8/24/04 (SWB Red Barons)... He still has hit safely in 14 of his last 16 G (21-57, .368-0-5)... OF **John Mayberry** has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 G (15-48, .313-2-6). And, in his last 28 G, is batting .301-6-21 (31-103, 8 2B, 9 BB)... 3B **David Newhan** has hit in 8 of last 9 G (8-24, .333-1-3, 7 BB)... OF **Rich Thompson** is a perfect 10-10 in SB (100%) and is now 35-37 (95%) in LHV career... INF **Jason Donald** leads all IL shortstops having not committed an error in his 34 G (171 chances)...

### WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Mike Koplove** hasn't allowed an ER in last 15 G (1-1, 4 SV, 2 H, 18.1 ip, 12 h, 5 r, 9 bb, 24 k). He also has a 7.1 scoreless IP streak (6+ G)... RHP **Dave Borkowski** had his team-high 13.0 scoreless IP streak snapped Thursday (6+ G, 0-0, 8 h, 6 bb, 6 k) -- allowing 2 R (1 ER) in 2.0 IP... Still, he has been unscored upon in 7 of his last 8 G (16.2 ip, er) after allowing Rs in first 3 G (5 ip, 8 er)... RHP **Tyler Walker** has a season-starting 11.0 scoreless IP streak in his first 6 G. He has only allowed four batters to reach safely: 2 1Bs (inc. a hit-and-run dribbler), a BB and a HB. He's retired 32 of 37 BF (86.4%)...

### BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *One is the Loneliest...*: The 'Pigs lost their last five one-run games... They are now 5-9 in one-run games in 2009.
- *Same 'ole Saturday Night?*: The 'Pigs are now 0-7 on Saturday nights; 0-6 wearing the Saturday alternate jerseys.
- *Getting Better Starts*: LHV starters have "quality starts" in 5 of the last 6 G -- going 2-1, 2.83 ERA (35 ip, 11 er)... In the previous 10 G, LHV starters had just 2 QS -- going 1-6, 8.57 ERA, .351 (49.1, 74 h, 50 r, 47 er, 12 hr, 211 ab).
- *Lead Story?*: The 'Pigs have held leads in 52% of their losses (13 of 25). If they hung on in 1/2 those, they'd be 23-18.
- *Needing to Pop the Clutch*: In the last 7 G (2-5), the 'Pigs are batting just .143 (7-49) w/ RISP.
- *Not the Pace Game* (: : Despite the fair start (14-15 in 29 G), the LHV's on pace to go 56-88... they finished 55-89 in '08
- *Tablesetters*: During this 2-10 skid, the Top 2 batters -- Rich Thompson, Jason Donald -- are a combined 14-93 (.151).
- *Double your Pleasure*: LHV has turned an IL-best 45 double plays. The next closest teams has just 41 (Buffalo).
- *Song of the South!*: The 'Pigs were 19-13 (.594) against the South Division in 2008; 36-76 (.321) vs. North & West.
- *Eight is Enough!*: The 'Pigs snapped their 8-game losing streak Tuesday -- their longest skid since a 9-gamer from 4/16-4/24/08. The longest in team history is 11 (4/3-4/13) -- the first 11 games in IronPigs history.
- INF **Pablo Ozuna** snapped his '09 LHV high 13-G hitting streak Tuesday (0-4). During the streak, he batted .422-0-4 (19-45)... Ozuna holds the modern-day Phillies' Triple-A record for hitting streak at 27 G from 7/27-8/24/04 (SWB Red Barons).
- *In a Pinch!*: LHV pinch-hitters are 6-12 (.500) with 2 BB, HBP (.600 OBP)...
- *Record Cerved*: With his HR in the 7th 5/9, INF **Mike Cervenak** set a LHV franchise record by reaching base safely in 22 consecutive games. Previously, Jon Knott reached in 21 straight (his streak was 26 as it started w/ 5 G in ROC).
- *Thou Shalt Steal!*: During the 'Long Ball' Era, the stolen base base been coined 'a lost art.' Maybe it should be found. The 'Pigs have have a 88.2% success rate (30 of 34). Opponents have a 82% success rate (46 of 56).

### PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

Since the first series of 2009, the 'Pigs pen is 5-9, 2.37 with 6 SV in 37 G (129.0 ip, 34 er)... The corps had an **amazing run** over a span of 12 G (4/18-5/1) in which it allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41), retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%... At one point, the4 had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

### COUNTDOWN TO 1,500:

'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** is up to 1,496 career MiLB wins -- 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

### PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 85-140 (.378) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 103-177 (.368) & a combined 70.0 GB.

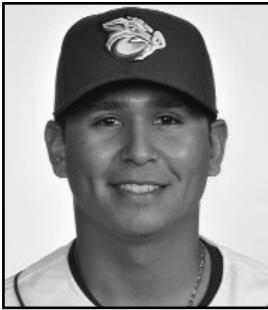
