TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (16-27) play Game Two of a four-game series against the last-place Buffalo Bisons (13-29) -- the new New York Mets' affiliate. With another tough loss by an 8-7 score to Buffalo yesterday, the 'Pigs have dropped three straight games overall and two in a row to the Bisons. Over a longer stretch, Lehigh Valley has now dropped 12 of its last 14 games... Buffalo now has a season-high three-game winning streak. Since starting 2-17, the Bisons have gone 11-12 in their last 23 games... First-Pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m.

• *Road Warriors?*: The 'Pigs have lost six straight road games and are now just 6-11 away from CCP this season. Lehigh Valley lost 14 of its last 16 road games in 2008 after going 20-12 in the previous 32 G.

LOST PUNCH:

1B Andy Tracy has left the team for the remainder of the series to be with his wife and the birth of their second child... Without INF **Mike Cervenak** (DL) and OF **John Mayberry** (promotion) the 'Pigs are without the entire 'heart of their lineup.' The three players comprise 19 of LHV's 29 HR (66%), 46 of 127 extra basehits (36%), and 41 of 137 BB (30%). Without them, the team overall average drops from .247 to .237 and the slugging percentage from .382 to .342.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- who won his first ML start this year (see below) -- is a 6-3, 225-pound, 23-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 2nd round of 2006 out of Long Beach State and is a member of the 40-Man Roster. The Vacaville, CA, native spent a bulk of 2008 in Double-A Reading, going just 6-8 with a 5.67 ERA in 16 GS -- but was on the move in the second half, with a stint in Advanced-A Clearwater (3-3, 2.92 in 8 GS from 6/16-7/31), a ML debut with Philly (scoreless IP of relief 8/27 vs. NYM) and a start with LHV on 8/31 @ PAW (L, 7 ip 6 h, 2 er). Carpenter had a stellar 2007 season in Clearwater -- where he led the Florida State League in wins (17) and shutouts (2) while being selected to play in the 2007 FSL All-Star Game. He finished the season 17-6, 3.20 with 1 SV in 27 G, 24 GS, and tied for the league lead in CG (3). Among the highlights in his three-year MILB career was a 7-inning perfect game 8/27/07 vs. Fort Myers (7 ip, 7 k). He also won both his postseason starts (2-0, 2.92) as the Threshers won the 2007 FSL Championship.

- *Carpenter enters the season ranked as the No. 22 Prospect in the organization by Baseball America.*
- *DC pitched very well in Triple-A Spring training (2-0, 1.04 in 2 GS) after starting in ML S.T. (0-1, 8.53 in 3 G).*
- *DC won his MLB starting debut 5/16 @ WAS-G2: W*, 4.1 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k *Rule 10.17 (b) (2).*
- *DC, 5/21 vs. DUR (L, 6-2): n/d, 6 ip, 8 h, 0 r, 3 bb, 2 k Stranded bases loaded in 3rd and 8 runners in 6 IP; left up 2-0; win blown*

LHP **Oliver Perez** -- pitching in a ML Rehab Assignment after going on the D.L. on 5/7 (right patella tendinitis) -- is a 6-3, 205-pound, 27-year-old righty originally obtained by the Mets along with RHP Roberto Hernandez from Pittsburgh for OF Xavier Nady, 7/31/06. He was then resigned as a free agent this offseason for a 3-year, \$36 M deal. Last season, native of Culiacan, Mexico, went 10-7, 4.22 in 34 GS for New York (194 ip, 167 h, 105 bb, 180 k) -- after going 15-10, 3.56 in 29 GS in 2007. Perez originally won his ML debut with San Diego on 6/16 vs. SEA (5 ip, 4 h, 2 er, 4 bb, 7 k) at age 20 and 305 days -- making him the youngest player in the MLB at that time -- and finished his rookie year 4-5, 3.50 in 16 G, 15 GS. After signing with the Padres as a non-drafted free agent 3/4/99, he was later traded from SD with OF Jason Bay and a PTBNL to Pittsburgh for OF Brian Giles, 8/26/03. In his ML career (entering '09), Perez is 55-60, 4.39 in 175 G, 174 GS with 1,027 K in 999.1 IP... however, he has walked 528 -- 4.8 BB/9 IP. Perez played for Mexico in the WBC in 2006 (0-0, 0.00 in 2 G, 1 GS) and again in 2009 (0-1, 9.45 in 2 GS).

- *Perez in 2009 w/ NYM: 1-2, 9.97 in 5 GS (21.2 ip, 28 h, 24 r, 24 er, 21 bb, 20 k, .315). His 1 QS was 4/15 vs. SD.*
- *Last outing, OP started a 6-5 loss 5/2 @ PHI: n/d, 2.1 ip, 5 h, 4 r, 4 er, 6 bb, 2 k. He was 0-1, 11.92 in last 3 GS.*

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- The blown 4-run lead ties a LHV high (3rd time in 2009) -- and the second time in the past 3 G (blew a 4-0 lead vs. DUR, 5/23). The 'Pigs have held leads in 52% of their losses (14 of 27). If they hung on in 1/2 those, they'd be 23-20.
- *One is the Loneliest...:* The 'Pigs have now lost their last 6 one-run games... They are now 5-10 in one-run G in '09.
- The 7 R scored by LHV was the team's most since an 11-7 loss on 5/9 @ TOL (15 games ago). After scoring 6+ in 7 of their first 28 G (25%), the 'Pigs have scored 6+ just once in the last 15 G.
- *Not the Pace Game* (: : Despite the fair start (14-15 in 29 G), the LHV's on pace to go 54-90... they finished 55-89 in '08

SERIES INFORMATION:

The season series is tied, 2-2... The team split in '08, 8-8, with BUF winning 5 of the last 7 G vs. LHV -- of course, that was when BUF was a CLE affiliate. LHV was 5-3 at Coca-Cola Park; BUF was 5-3 at then-Dunn Tire Park.

TRANSACTIONS:

No transactions the past 2 days, but the 'Pigs have had 12 transactions in the previous 4 days... They've added LHP Sergio Escalona and INF Miguel Cairo from Philadelphia, INF Jorge Velandia from Williamsport (R), RHP Tyler Walker for the D.L., LHP Antonio Bastardo from Reading (AA), RHP Steven Register waivers from Colorado Springs (AAA) and LHP J.C. Romero on an ML Rehab... They've lost OF John Mayberry to Philadelphia, RHP Justin Lehr to a trade, RHP Jason Anderson to Reading, and released RHP Dave Borkowski and RHP Steve Green.

SAY IT AIN'T SO, CERVI!

After starting in the first 35 G (reaching safely in 33), INF Mike Cervenak was placed on the D.L. 5/18 (retro to 5/17) with a right wrist fracture (HBP, Tommy Hanson on 5/16) -- and a time-table for his return is not yet know. The IronPigs are 10-26 (.278) when he has been out of the lineup in 2008-09. He is batting .326-3-23 this season and reached base safely in a LHV-record 22-consecutive games from 4/17-5/10.

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF Pablo Ozuna snapped his '09 LHV high 13-G hitting streak last Tuesday. He hit .422-0-4 (19-45) during streak... Ozuna holds the modern-day Phillies' Triple-A record for hitting streak at 27 G from 7/27-8/24/04 (SWB Red Barons)... He still has hit safely in 16 of his last 19 G (24-69, .348-0-5, 12 R)... INF Miguel Cairo has hit safely in his first 4 G with LHV (6-16, .375-0-2)... 3B David Newhan has hit in 10 of last 12 G (12-35, .343-2-4, 8 BB)... OF Rich Thompson is 11-12 in SB (92%) and is now 36-39 (92%) in LHV career... After starting the first 35 games without an error at SS, INF Jason Donald committed his first 2 errors at shortstop Sunday. He started errorless in his first 174 chances. He still leads all IL shortstops in fielding PCT...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP Mike Koplove had his streak of 15+ G and 18.2 consecutive IP without an ER snapped on a 2-run HR by Chris Richard on Saturday... Still, he's allowed just 2 ER in his last 16 G (1-2, 4 SV, 2 H, 19.1 ip, 13 h, 7 r, 9 bb, 26 k)... RHP Tyler Walker has a season-starting 12.0 scoreless IP streak in his first 7 G. He has only allowed four batters to reach safely: 2 1Bs (inc. a hit-and-run dribbler), a BB and a HB. He's retired 35 of 40 BF (87.5%)...

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Better Late than Never?*: During the last 9 G, LHV has scored only 3 R from the 6th inning on (went 6 straight w/ 0).
- *Needing to Pop the Clutch*: In the last 9 G (2-7), the 'Pigs are batting just .162 (12-74) w/ RISP. They were 0-11 Sun.
- *Tablesetters?*: During the 2-12 skid, the Top 2 batters in lineup (Thompson/Donald/Ellison) are combined 17-112 (.152).
- *Northern Exposure*: The 'Pigs are 10-13 vs. North Division teams after starting 0-4 (started 1-20 last season). Going back to '08, the 'Pigs are just 17-40 (.298) in their last 57 G vs. the ND and 32-71 (.311) in franchise history.
- *Getting Better Starts*: LHV starters have "quality starts" in 6 of the last 8 G -- going 2-2, 3.65 ERA (44.1 ip, 18 er)... In the previous 10 G, LHV starters had just 2 QS -- going 1-6, 8.57 ERA, .351 (49.1, 74 h, 50 r, 47 er, 12 hr, 211 ab).
- *Double your Pleasure*: LHV has turned an IL-best 46 double plays. The next closest teams has 43.
- In his last 6 GS, Carlos Carrasco is 0-5, 6.84 (25.0 ip, 32 h, 19 er, 10 bb, 29 k); First 3 G: 0-1, 2.37 (19 ip, 14 h, 5 er).
- *In a Pinch!*: LHV pinch-hitters are 6-14 (.375) with 2 BB, HBP (.529 OBP)...

PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

Since the first series of 2009, the 'Pigs pen is 5-10, 2.65 with 6 SV in 39 G (136.0 ip, 40 er)... The corps had an amazing run over a span of 12 G (4/18-5/1) in which it allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41), retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%... At one point, the4 had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

COUNTDOWN TO 1,500:

'Pigs skipper Dave Huppert is up to 1,496 career MiLB wins -- 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 85-142 (.374) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 103-179 (.365) & a combined 71.0 GB.

• The 'Pigs spent the first 5 days of the '09 season in last place... after spending the first 70 days of '08 in last. To start franchise history, they were in the cellar for 130 of their first 158 days... but been out since April 15, 2009.

CAN'T GET TO .500!:

The 'Pigs have never been at .500 in franchise history... They lost 9-2 in a chance to get to 15-15 on Monday, and are now 0-6 with a chance to get to .500+... The Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't been .500 since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07.

PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 12th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 12th best system: up from 22nd in 2008 (21 in '07; 22 in '06).
