TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (19-27) return home for a four-game series that starts tonight against the third-place Rochester Red Wings (22-23) -- the Minnesota Twins top affiliate. With a 7-1 win yesterday, the 'Pigs have now won a season-high three straight games to take the series in Buffalo, 3-1. Lehigh Valley is also 5-4 in its last nine games following its season-high eight-game losing streak... Rochester enters having lost its last two games to drop a four-game, home series to Durham. The Red Wings have gone just 5-10 since starting 17-13 through May 12...

• First-Pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m. for Friday Night Fireworks, presented by **Haldeman Ford/Lincoln/Mercury**.

With last night's win, the IronPigs:

- Have won three-straight games for the first time since 7/27-7/30/08 (a span of 75 games) -- when they tied their franchise record four-game winning streak (which they did twice in 2008). The Phillies' Triple-A affiliates have not won 5 straight for the first time since SWB won 5-straight games 8/11-8/15/06.
- Won a 4-game road series for the first time since 7/25-7/28/08 @ RIC: they had lost 4 and split 2 in their last 6.
- Won their first 4-game road series vs. a North Division foe in LHV history (they'd won 1 at home: 6/11-6/23 vs. BUF).

With a win tonight, the IronPigs will:

- Will tie their franchise record with a four-game winning streak (6/25-6/28/08; 7/27-7/30/08).

LOST PUNCH?:

The 'Pigs played their last 2 G without normal hitters No. 1 through No. 5 in their lineup: 1. OF **Rich Thompson** (back, day-to-day); 2. SS **Jason Donald** (leg; day-to-day); 3. INF **Mike Cervenak** (DL, broken wrist); 4. 1B **Andy Tracy** (left the team Tues. to be with his wife and the birth of their second child); and 5. OF **John Mayberry** (promotion)... Yet, LHV had 4 HR in the 2 G and yesterday's 7-1 was their largest margin of victory since a 6-0 win 4/28 @ SWB.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** -- the youngest IronPig -- is a 6-3, 215-pound 22-year-old signed by Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela on 10/25/03 (at age 16 for \$300,000). A member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster, Carrasco flourished in his Triple-A debut with the 'Pigs after his promotion on 8/2/08 -- going 2-2 with a 1.72 ERA in six starts. He started last season in Double-A Reading, going 7-7 with a 4.32 ERA in 20 G, 19 GS (114.2 ip, 109 h, 58 r, 55 er, 45 bb, 109 k, .254) -- starting out 4-4, 3.10 in his first 10 GS (through 5/25); but going just 3-3, 5.70 in his last 10 games with the R-Phils. In 2007, Carrasco was a Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Clearwater prior to a 6/20 promotion to Reading -- where he threw a rain-shortened 6-inning no-hitter 8/21/07 vs. Altoona (2 bb, 8 k). In 2006, Carrasco captured the Paul Owens Award, awarded to the top pitcher in the PHI system, while helping guide Lakewood to a SAL Championship. Carrasco has also been named to the World Team of the All-Star Futures game each of the last 3 seasons and was the starting and winning pitcher (1.0 ip, 2 k) in '08 at Yankee Stadium on 7/13.

- Carrasco is rated as the #2 Prospect in the system by Baseball America behind Dominic Brown (he was #1 in '08).
- Last 6 GS: 0-5, 6.84 (25.0 ip, 32 h, 19 er, 10 bb, 29 k); First 3 GS: 0-1, 2.37 ERA (19 ip, 14 h, 5 er)
- Home Boy?: Started LHV career with 0 ER in 35.1 IP at Coca-Cola Park; since then: 19 ER, 25.0 IP (6.84 in 5 GS)
- CC, 5/24 vs. DUR (L, 6-2): L, 6.2 ip, 6 h, 3 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 8 k LO-BB led to R in 1st; after solo HR in 3rd (Ruggiano); 0 R til E-6 in 7th

LHP **Brian Duensing** -- a member of the Twins' 40-Man Roster -- is a 5-11, 211-pound, 26-year-old lefty from Omaha, NE, who was selected by Minnesota in the 3rd round of the 2005 draft out of University of Nebraska (where he was honorable mention All-American as a freshman in 2002 prior to undergoing Tommy John surgery). He spent the 2008 season in Rochester, going 5-11, 4.28 in 25 G, 24 GS -- but also played for the bronze-medal winning Team USA in the 2008 Olympic Games in Beijing from July 28-August 27 (went 1-0, 1.17 in 4 G, 7.2 ip). He earned his Olympic win on 8/16 vs. Team Canada, going 3.1 scoreless innings in a 5-4 victory. In 2007, Duensing started in Double-A New Britain (4-1, 2.66 in 9 GS) before a promotion 5/30 -- and finished third in the IL in ERA (3.24) and tied for third in wins (11). In all he was 11-5 with a 3.24 ERA in 19 GS (3 CG). He is ranked as the No. 16 Prospect in the system by Baseball America.

- BD vs. LHV in 2008: 2-0, 0.64 ERA in 2 GS (14.0 ip, 8 h, 1 r, 1 er, 0 bb, 8 k, .160).
- BD made his ML debut in a 12-5 win 4/10/09 @ CHI-A: H, 3.0 ip, 2 h, 2 r, 2 er, 0 bb, k, hr (Quentin).
- BD dominated iast start, a 6-2 win 5/24 @ NOR: W, 7.0 ip, 7 h, 0 r, 0 bb, 5 k. He hasn't allowed in ER in 9 IP.

COUNTDOWN TO 1,500:

'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** is up to 1,499 career MiLB wins -- 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

BACON BITS:

• *Finally, Some Breathing Room!*: Yesterday's 7-1 win was the 'Pigs largest margin of victory since a 6-0 win 4/28 @ SWB... The 'Pigs last 10 wins were by 3 or fewer runs -- 9 of the 10 wins by just 1 or 2 runs.

• *Northern Exposure*: The 'Pigs are now 13-13 vs. North Division teams after starting 0-4 (started 1-20 last season).

Going back to '08, the 'Pigs are just 20-40 (.333) in their last 60 G vs. the ND and 35-71 (.330) in franchise history.

• *Getting Defensive*: LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.981) and the 'Pigs have now turned an IL-best 50 double plays. The next closest team has 47.

• *Dropping the Clutch?*: In the last 12 G (5-7), the 'Pigs are batting just .154 (16-104) w/ RISP. They were 0-11 Sunday versus Durham and 0-11 Tuesday versus Buffalo.

• *Getting Better Starts*: LHV starters have "quality starts" in 9 of the last 11 G -- going 5-2, 3.08 ERA (64.1 ip, 22 er)... In the previous 10 G, LHV starters had just 2 QS -- going 1-6, 8.57 ERA, .351 (49.1, 74 h, 50 r, 47 er, 12 hr, 211 ab).

• *Lead Story?*: The 'Pigs have held leads in 52% of their losses (14 of 27). If they hung on in 1/2 those, they'd be 26-20.

• *One is the Loneliest...*: The 'Pigs are 1-6 in their last 7 one-run games; but the 2-1 win Tues. snapped a 6-G skid.

• *Not the Pace Game* (: Despite the fair start (14-15 in 29 G), the LHV's on pace to go 59-85... they finished 55-89 in '08

• *Into 'Carpentering'*: The HR by M. Abreu on Wed snapped **Drew Carpenter's** '09 LHV-high 14.0 scoreless IP streak.

• In his last 6 GS, **Carlos Carrasco** is 0-5, 6.84 (25.0 ip, 32 h, 19 er, 10 bb, 29 k); First 3 G: 0-1, 2.37 (19 ip, 14 h, 5 er).

• *In a Pinch!*: LHV pinch-hitters are 6-15 (.400) with 2 BB, HBP (.500 OBP)...

SERIES INFORMATION:

This is the first meeting in 2009... ROC won the series, 11-5 -- winning the last 4 G of the series. The 'Wings won the last series at Coca-Cola Park, 2-1 (8/2-8/4) and also swept the last meeting at Frontier Field 8/6-8/7 (3 games).

GETTIN' MIGGY WITH IT!

INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit in 6 of 7 G since joining LHV -- and yesterday hit his first HR in 851 AB and since July 28, 2005 (when he hit on as a Met in Minute Maid Park against RHP Chad Qualls)... In the Majors, he has gone 813 at-bats since that home run, which, according to the Elias Sports Bureau, it is the longest active homerless streak in the Majors Leagues.

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF **Pablo Ozuna**, who had a '09 LHV high 13-G hitting streak 5/3-5/18, has hit safely in 18 of his last 22 G (27-80, .338-0-5, 13 R)... INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit safely in 6 of his first 7 G with LHV (10-28, .357-1-5)... OF **Jeremy Slayden** hit safely in his last 5 G (6-19, .316-1-5, 2B)... 3B **David Newhan** has hit in 12 of last 15 G (16-48, .333-2-6, 8 BB)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit safely in his last 3 GS (6-10, 2 2B, HR, 2 RBI)... OF **Rich Thompson** is 11-12 in SB (92%) and is now 36-39 (92%) in LHV career... After starting the first 35 games without an error at SS, INF **Jason Donald** committed his first 2 errors at shortstop Sunday. He started errorless in his first 174 chances. He still leads all IL shortstops in fielding PCT...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Mike Koplove** had his streak of 15+ G and 18.2 consecutive IP without an ER snapped on a 2-run HR by Chris Richard on Saturday... Still, he's allowed just 2 ER in his last 18 G (1-2, 0.89, 6 SV, 2 H, 20.1 ip, 13 h, 7 r, 9 bb, 28 k)... RHP **Tyler Walker** has a season-starting 12.2 scoreless IP streak in his first 8 G. He has only allowed five batters to reach safely: 2 1Bs (inc. a hit-and-run dribbler), 2 BB and a HB. He's retired 37 of 44 BF (84.1%)... LHP **Cedrick Bowers** has allowed just 1 R in his last 8 G (0-1, 0.84, 4 H, 10.2 ip, 3 h, er, 8 bb, 11 k)... Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ WAS, RHP **Drew Carpenter** is 1-0, 0.69 in 2 GS with LHV (13.0 ip, 14 h, 1 r, 1 er, 6 k)...

SAY IT AIN'T SO, CERVII!

After starting in the first 35 G (reaching safely in 33), INF **Mike Cervenak** was placed on the D.L. 5/18 (retro to 5/17) with a right wrist fracture (HBP, Tommy Hanson on 5/16) -- and a time-table for his return is not yet know. The IronPigs are 13-26 (.333) when he has been out of the lineup in 2008-09. He is batting .326-3-23 this season and reached base safely in a LHV-record 22-consecutive games from 4/17-5/10.

PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

Since the first series of 2009, the 'Pigs pen is 5-10, 2.58 with 8 SV in 42 G (143.0 ip, 41 er)... The corps had an **amazing run** over a span of 12 G (4/18-5/1) in which it allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41), retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%... At one point, they had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 88-142 (.383) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 106-179 (.372) & a combined 69.0 GB.

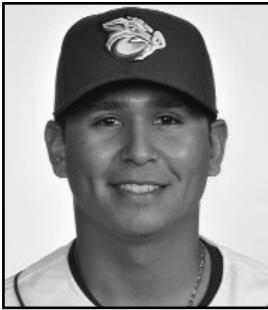
