TONIGHT'S GAMES:

After a rainout of Game Two last night, the IronPigs (11-13) will now attempt their first doubleheader of the season tonight with Games Two & Three of a four-game series against the last-place Buffalo Bisons (4-19) -- the new New York Mets affiliate (the Mets went 66-75 in New Orleans last season). With a 3-0 win in Game One (and Only) last night, the 'Pigs snapped a mini two-game skid with their second shutout of 2009. LHV is 3-2 on this current eight-game homestand... Buffalo entered the series having won two of their last three games and are 2-2 since starting 2-17.

Municipal Golf Course. Note: Thursday's game is at 10:35 a.m. -- three games scheduled within 17 hours!

LAST NIGHT'S SHUTOUT: FIRST FOR 'KING' LEHR!

After going 70 games without a shutout (dating back to Les Walrond's 17-strikeout gem on 7/6/08 vs. LOU), the IronPigs have two SHO's in their last seven games... RHP Rodrigo Lopez started a 6-0 win 4/28 @ SWB. For RHP **Justin Lehr**, it was his first shutout (as well as CG) in 115 starts in his professional career. Lehr joins Walrond (9.0 ip and 7.0 ip) and LHP Brian Mazone (7.0 ip) as the only LHV pitchers toss a shutout. In his IL career, Lehr is now 9-3, 2.52 (85.2 ip, 24 er) in 20 G, 12 GS.

TONIGHT'S G1 PITCHERS (G2 APPEAR ON NEXT PAGE):

RHP **Kyle Kendrick** -- making just his sixth career Triple-A start -- is a 6-3, 190-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 7th-round of 2003 out of Mt. Vernon (WA) HS -- turning down a scholarship to play QB at Washington State to sign with the Phillies. A member of Philadelphia's 40-Man Roster with 1.110 years of ML service time already accrued, Kendrick was initially promoted from Reading (AA) straight to the Majors on 6/13/07 -- and became a key cog in the Phils' run to capture the N.L. East. He went 10-4, 3.87 in 20 starts, leading all N.L. rookies in wins and ranking 3rd in ERA. Kendrick started 2008 right where he left off -- going 8-3, 4.47 in 19 starts before the All-Star Break. However, he struggled thereafter, finishing just 3-6, 7.59 in his next 11 GS before being left off the Phils' postseason rosters. In all, he is 21-13, 4.78 in 51 G, 50 GS w/ PHI (276.2 ip, 323 h, 147 er, 82 bb, 117 k).

- KK earned the 'W' in the first-ever game at CCP -- a 5-3 PHI victory over LHV in exhibition 3/30/08 (5 ip, 0 r).
- In ML Spring Training, KK went 1-3, 9.20 in 4 GS. In Triple-A S.T., KK went 0-1, 13.51 in 1 GS (3.1 ip, 5 er).
- KK, 4/30 vs. TOL (W, 4-2): W, 6.0 ip, 3 h, 0 r, 2 bb, 4 k Stranded 2 in 1st; after misplay 2B in 2nd, ref'd 12 in row & 13 of last 15

RHP **Tim Redding** -- on a ML Rehab Assignment (right rotator cuff strain) -- is a 5-11, 230-pound, 31-year-old righty signed by New York to a one-year, \$2.25 million contract this off-season after going 10-11, 4.95 for the Washington Nationals in 2008 - not miss a turn in the rotation while establishing career-highs in GS (33), IP (182.0) and K (120). Most impressively, the Nationals (59-102, .364) went 20-13 (.606) in his starts. Redding was originally selected by the Houston Astros in the 20th round of 1997 and went 3-1, 5.50 during his rookie season in 2001. The Rochester, N.Y., native had a breakout season with the Astros in 2003, posting 10 wins and a 3.68 ERA while finishing second on the Astros' staff in innings pitched (176.0) and starts (32). In parts of 7 seasons in the Majors, Redding has pitched for HOU (2001-04), SD (2005), NYY (2005) and Washington (2007-08) and compiled a 34-51 mark with a 4.92 ERA. In 11 career starts against Philadelphia, Redding is an impressive 5-3, 3.29. As a piece of remote baseball trivia, Redding surrendered Barry Bonds' 757th career home run -- one after Hank Aaron's record was broken.

TONIGHT'S G2 PITCHERS:

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** -- the youngest IronPig -- is a 6-3, 215-pound 22-year-old signed by Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela on 10/25/03 (at age 16 for \$300,000). A member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster, Carrasco flourished in his Triple-A debut with the 'Pigs after his promotion on 8/2/08 -- going 2-2 with a 1.72 ERA in six starts. He started last season in Double-A Reading, going 7-7 with a 4.32 ERA in 20 G, 19 GS (114.2 ip, 109 h, 58 r, 55 er, 45 bb, 109 k, .254) -- starting out 4-4, 3.10 in his first 10 GS (through 5/25); but going just 3-3, 5.70 in his last 10 games with the R-Phils. In 2007, Carrasco was a Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Clearwater prior to a 6/20 promotion to Reading -- where he threw a rain-shortened 6-inning no-hitter 8/21/07 vs. Altoona (2 bb, 8 k). In 2006, Carrasco captured the Paul Owens Award, awarded to the top pitcher in the PHI system, while helping guide Lakewood to a SAL Championship. Carrasco has also been named to the World Team of the All-Star Futures game each of the last 3 seasons and was the starting and winning pitcher (1.0 ip, 2 k) in '08 at Yankee Stadium on 7/13.

- Carrasco is rated as the #2 Prospect in the system by Baseball America behind Dominic Brown (he was #1 in '08).
- In just 10 career Triple-A starts, Carrasco has gone 2-4, 2.87 (62.2 ip, 20 er) with 3 wins blown by the bullpen.
- Last 2 GS: 0-1, 10.29 ERA (7.0 ip, 13 h, 11 r, 8 er, 4 bb, 11 k); Prev. 3 GS: 0-1, 2.37 ERA (19 ip, 14 h, 5 er)
- CC, 5/1 vs. TOL (W, 6-5): n/d, 4.1 ip, 5 h, 5 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 8 k Cruised thru 3 IP w/ 7 K; E-6, E-4 led to 3 R in 4th; 2-r HR (Larish) in 5th

• Home Boy!: CC started his career going 35.1 IP at Coca-Cola Park without allowing an ER (0 er in his first 5 career GS). The streak was broken with an ER 4/16 vs. SYR. In all, he's now 2-2, 2.02 in 8 GS (44.2/10) at CCP.

RHP **Kyle Snyder**, 31, is a 6-8, 222-pound righty signed by New York as a minor league free agent 1/26/09. Originally drafted first-round (7th overall) by Kansas City in 1999 out of University of North Carolina, the Sarasota native started last season in Boston's bullpen (2 g, 0-0, 21.60) before being designated and assigned to Pawtucket (1-4, 5.26 in 14 G, 7 GS). He had two separated stints on the FL (rt. groin) and rehabbed with the GCL Red Sox (0-0, 3.38 in 6 G, 3 GS) and Advanced Rookie Lowell (0-0, 0.00 in 1 GS). Snyder has had a career beset by injuries -- missing most of 2000 and 2001 due to a right elbow injury (had Tommy John surgery 9/7/00), much of 2003 (rt. shoulder surgery) all of 2004 (torn labrum). Through it all, he made his ML debut 5/1/03 at Boston (n/d, 5.0 ip, 1 er) and earned his first ML win 6/4/03 at LAD (6.0 ip, 1 er). He went 1-6, 5.17 in 15 GS as a rookie before the injuries again took their toll. His best year came in 2007 with Boston, when he finished 2-3, 3.81 in 46 G, 0 GS and was added to the Red Sox World Series Roster (though he didn't appear in the 4-G sweep of Colorado). In all, he is 8-17, 5.57 in 93 G, 29 GS in 4.047 years of ML service time.

- In his last outing (first start of '09), KS lost 2-0 on 5/2 vs. LOU-G1: L, 4 ip, 4 h, 2 r, 2 er, bb, k (2-G losing streak).

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Tyler Walker** has a season-starting 11.0 scoreless IP streak in his first 6 G. He has only allowed four batters to reach safely: 2 1Bs (inc. a hit-and-run dribbler), a BB and a HB. He's retired 32 of 37 BF (86.4%)... RHP **Dave Borkowski** has a current 10.1 scoreless IP streak (5+ G, 0-0, 6 h, 4 bb, 4 k) and has been unscored upon in last 5 G (10.0 ip) after allowing Rs in first 3 G (5 ip, 8 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** snapped his team-high 12.0 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) on 2-out 2-R 2B by Ryan Roberson on Sunday... RHP **Mike Koplove** hasn't allowed an ER in last 9 G (0-1, SV, 2 H, 11.2 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 7 bb, 12 k)...

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **John Mayberry** has hit safely in 3 of his last 4 G (5-16, .313-1-5)... He's also hit safely in 10 of his last 13 G (16-49, .327-4-15, 5 2B, 7 BB); slugging .673 in span... INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 5 of his last 7 G (12-27, .444-0-9, 5 R); inc. 3 multi-hit G. Has reached safely in his last 17 G (23 h, 5 BB, HBP)... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in his last 5 G (7-21, .3333-0-0, 2 2B, 2 3B, 7 R, 4 SB) and has a 4-G run streak. He is a perfect 7-7 in SB (100%) this season and is now 32-34 (94%) in IronPigs career...

PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

In the last 3 G, the LHV bullpen is 0-2 with 2 BS and a 9.58 ERA (10.1 ip, 14 r, 11 er)... This came after an **amazing run** in which the corps had allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41) over a span of 12 G from 4/18-5/1 (retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%). At one point, the corps had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... Still, in the last 20 G, the 'Pigs pen is 3-4, 1.72 with 3 SV (78.2 ip, 15 er)... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 in the first 4 G (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES!:

- LHV is still just 11-13; but the IronPigs were 3-21 at this point in 2008. It took the 'Pigs 24 games to get win No. 10 in 2009. Last year, it took 42 games to get win No. 11 -- May 15 vs. Norfolk, when they 'improved' to 11-31.
- The 'Pigs have scored 109 runs in their first 24 G of 2009. It took them until Game 40 (5/13) to get to 109 R in '08.

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Lead Story:* LHV's scored first in all 5 G on the homestand after the 'Pigs opponents scored first in 11 of the prev. 13 G.
- *Northern Exposure:* The 'Pigs are 9-11 vs. North Division teams after starting 0-4 (started 1-20 last season). Going back to '08, the 'Pigs are just 16-38 (.283) in their last 54 G vs. the ND and 31-69 (.310) in franchise history.

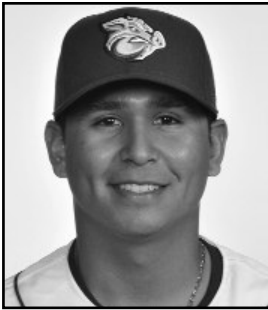
