## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (20-29) play the finale of a four-game series against the third-place Rochester Red Wings (24-24) -- the Minnesota Twins top affiliate. With a 5-1 win yesterday, the 'Pigs snapped a two-game skid and a six-game losing streak to the Red Wings going back to 2008. Even so, Lehigh Valley is still just 6-14 in its last 20 games... Rochester has now dropped three of its last five games and has gone just 7-11 since starting 17-13 through May 12.

- First-Pitch is scheduled at 7:05 p.m. for IronPigs Mouse Pad Giveaway, as presented by **The Morning Call**.
- *Go West, Young Men!*: Following the game, the 'Pigs embark on an eight-game West Division trip through Indianapolis and Louisville -- two teams LHV has not yet faced in 2009. So far, the 'Pigs are 4-8 vs. the West.

## 1,500 MILESTONE:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win yesterday, 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. He is currently the 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

RHP **Kyle Kendrick** -- making just his 10th career Triple-A start -- is a 6-3, 190-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 7th-round of 2003 out of Mt. Vernon (WA) HS -- turning down a scholarship to play QB at Washington State to sign with the Phillies. A member of Philadelphia's 40-Man Roster with 1.110 years of ML service time already accrued, Kendrick was initially promoted from Reading (AA) straight to the Majors on 6/13/07 -- and became a key cog in the Phils' run to capture the N.L. East. He went 10-4, 3.87 in 20 starts, leading all N.L. rookies in wins and ranking 3rd in ERA. Kendrick started 2008 right where he left off -- going 8-3, 4.47 in 19 starts before the All-Star Break. However, he struggled thereafter, finishing just 3-6, 7.59 in his next 11 GS before being left off the Phils' postseason rosters. In all, he is 21-13, 4.78 in 51 G, 50 GS w/ PHI (276.2 ip, 323 h, 147 er, 82 bb, 117 k).

- *KK earned the 'W' in the first-ever game at CCP -- a 5-3 PHI victory over LHV in exhibition 3/30/08 (5 ip, 0 r).*
- *KK has won his last 2 GS -- going 6.0 ip, 3 er in both -- but has also taken a shutout into the 6th inning in both.*
- *KK, 5/27 @ BUF (W, 5-3): W, 6+ ip, 9 h, 3 r, 3 er, 2 k LO 1B in 1st then ret'd 8 in row, 15 of 16; R in 6th; pulled after 2 2B in 7th*

RHP **Reid Santos**, 26, is a 6-1, 170-pound lefty who was claimed off waivers from Toronto in at the start of Spring Training 2009. The native of Kaneohe, HI, was originally drafted by Cleveland in the 13th round of 2002 out Saddleback College (Mission Viejo, CA) and was part of the Tribe's system until being claimed off waivers by the Blue Jays on 9/23/08. Santos started 2008 in Buffalo, going 2-2, 7.20 in 16 G, 0 GS, before being assigned to Double-A Akron -- where he finished 2-1, 3.78 and 2 SV in 29 G, 0 GS. In 2007, Santos spent the year in Akron -- where he was named an Eastern League mid-season All-Star -- and finished 8-3, 2.72 in 39 G, 10 GS. He also posted a 2.08 ERA (8.2 ip, 2 er) in four EL playoff games... Santos was the 2004 Appalachian League Co-Pitcher of the Year while pitching for Burlington.

- *RS lost his last start 13-2 on 5/27 vs. DUR: L, 4.0 ip, 5 h, 3 r, 3 er, 1 bb, 5 k... He is yet to go more than 5 IP.*

## TRANSACTIONS, INJURIES & SUCH:

The Phillies announced LHP **Antonio Bastardo** will start on Tuesday at SD -- and LHP **Gustavo Chacin** is expected to replace his start in Indy. Chacin, who made 2 appearances with Reading (1-0, 3.21, 1 GS), last pitched in the MLB for Toronto in 2007, and went 25-15, 4.18 in a 4-year stint with the Jays. He was signed by PHI on 4/6 after being released by WAS.. OF **Rich Thompson** (back) and SS **Jason Donald** (leg) missed their 5th consecutive games.

## SERIES INFORMATION:

ROC leads the series, 2-1... ROC won the 2008 series, 11-5 -- winning the last 4 G of the series. The 'Wings won the last series at Coca-Cola Park, 2-1 (8/2-8/4) and also swept the last meeting at Frontier Field 8/6-8/7 (3 games).

## BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Into 'Carpentering':* For the second straight 'start', RHP **Drew Carpenter** took a shutout into the 8th inning... Since winning his ML starting debut 5/16 @ WAS, Carpenter has gone 2-0, 0.89 in 3 G, 2 GS (20.1 ip, 17 h, 2 r, 2 er, 12 k).
- *Koplove Factor:* RHP **Mike Koplove** has appeared in 7 of the last 8 LHV wins. From 5/7-5/27, they didn't win a G w/o him.

### GETTIN 'MIGGY WITH IT!

INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit in 9 of 10 G (.350-2-8) since joining LHV -- and has now hit 2 HR in his last 11 AB (in a span of 7 AB) after going 850 AB without one! Thursday, he hit his first HR since 7/28/05, when he hit on as a Met in Minute Maid Park against RHP Chad Qualls... In the Majors, he's gone 813 ABs since that HR, which, according to the Elias Sports Bureau, is the longest active homerless streak in the Majors Leagues.

### WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF **Pablo Ozuna**, who had a '09 LHV high 13-G hitting streak 5/3-5/18, has hit safely in 20 of his last 25 G (31-91, .341-0-6, 16 R)... INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit safely in 9 of his first 10 G with LHV (14-40, .350-2-8)... OF **Jeremy Slayden** hit safely in 7 of his last 8 G (9-29, .310-1-5, 2B)... 3B **David Newhan** has a 5-game RBI streak and has hit in 14 of last 18 G (19-58, .328-3-9, 9 BB)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit safely in 4 of his last 6 GS (7-21, .333-1-2, 2 2B)... OF **Rich Thompson** is 11-12 in SB (92%) and is now 36-39 (92%) in LHV career... After starting the first 35 games without an error at SS, INF **Jason Donald** committed his first 2 errors at shortstop last Sunday. He started errorless in his first 174 chances. He still leads all IL shortstops in fielding PCT...

### WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Mike Koplove** had his streak of 15+ G and 18.2 consecutive IP without an ER snapped on a 2-run HR by Chris Richard on Saturday... Still, he's allowed just 2 ER in his last 19 G (1-2, 0.84, 6 SV, 2 H, 21.1 ip, 13 h, 7 r, 10 bb, 28 k)... RHP **Tyler Walker** had his season-starting 13.0 scoreless IP streak snapped in his 9th appearance on Friday. In his first 8 G, he went 12.2 IP and only allowed five batters to reach safely: 2 1Bs (inc. a hit-and-run dribbler), 2 BB and a HB. He retired 37 of 44 BF (84.1%)... LHP **Cedrick Bowers** has allowed just 1 R in his last 9 G (0-1, 0.78, 4 H, 11.2 ip, 3 h, er, 9 bb, 11 k)... Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ WAS, RHP **Drew Carpenter** is 2-0, 0.89 in 2 GS with LHV (20.1 ip, 17 h, 2 r, 2 er, 12 k)...

### BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Getting Better Starts:* LHV starters have "quality starts" in 10 of the last 14 G -- going 5-3, 3.39 ERA (77.0 ip, 29 er)... In the prev. 10 G, LHV starters had just 2 QS -- going 1-6, 8.57, .351 (49.1, 74 h, 50 r, 47 er, 12 hr, 211 ab).
- *Getting Defensive:* LHV is leading IL in fielding percentage (.982) and the 'Pigs have now turned an IL-best 57 double plays. The next closest teams have just 47.
- *Northern Exposure:* The 'Pigs are now 14-15 vs. the North Division and are now 36-73 (.330) in franchise history.
- *Out of Cervice:* The IronPigs are 14-28 (.333) when INF **Mike Cervenak** has been out of the lineup in 2008-09.
- *Lead Story?:* The 'Pigs have now blown leads in 52% of their losses (15 of 29). If they hung on in 1/2\* those, they'd be 28-21. They've now blown an *IL-high 4 G leading after 8 innings*... The next teams have just 2 (6 teams have 0).
- *Close Calls:* Fourteen of the last 18 (78%) games have been decided by 1-3 R -- and three other 3 Gs were by 4.
- *Close Calls, Pt 2:* Ten of the 'Pigs last 12 wins are by 3 or fewer runs -- 9 of those 11 wins are by just 1 or 2 runs.
- *Same 'ole Saturday Night?:* The 'Pigs are now 0-8 on Saturday nights; 0-7 wearing the Saturday alternate jerseys.
- *Dropping the Clutch?:* In the last 14 G (6-8), the 'Pigs are batting just .180 (23-128) w/ RISP. They were 0-11 last last Sunday versus Durham and 0-11 Tuesday versus Buffalo.
- *One is the Loneliest...:* The 'Pigs are 1-6 in their last 7 one-run games; but the 2-1 win Tues. snapped a 6-G skid.
- *Not the Pace Game :(*: Despite the fair start (14-15 in 29 G), the LHV's on pace to go 59-85... they finished 55-89 in '08
- In his last 7 GS, **Carlos Carrasco** is 0-5, 5.91 (32.0 ip, 38 h, 21 er, 12 bb, 35 k); First 3 G: 0-1, 2.37 (19 ip, 14 h, 5 er).
- *In a Pinch!*: LHV pinch-hitters are 6-15 (.400) with 2 BB, HBP (.500 OBP)...

### PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

Since the first series of 2009, the 'Pigs pen is 6-11, 2.63 with 8 SV in 45 G (157.1 ip, 46 er)... The corps had an **amazing run** over a span of 12 G (4/18-5/1) in which it allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41), retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%... At one point, they had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

### PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 89-143 (.384) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 108-180 (.375) & a combined 69.0 GB.

• The 'Pigs spent the first 5 days of the '09 season in last place... after spending the first 70 days of '08 in last. To start franchise history, they were in the cellar for 130 of their first 158 days... but been out since April 15, 2009.

### CAN'T GET TO .500!:

The 'Pigs have never been at .500 in franchise history... They lost 9-2 in a chance to get to 15-15 on Monday, and are now 0-6 with a chance to get to .500+... The Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't been .500 since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07.

### PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 12th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 12th best system: up from 22nd in 2008 (21 in '07; 22 in '06).

### TOP PROSPECTS:

According to *Baseball America*, three of the Top 4 Prospects in the Phillies' system will start in the Lehigh Valley: the returning 22-year-old RHP **Carlos Carrasco** (#2), a three-time member of the World Team's Future Game roster and a pair of 2008 Olympians, C **Lou Marson** (#3) and SS **Jason Donald** (#4).
