TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (23-35) start a mini-homestand with Game One of a four-game series against the fourth-place Charlotte Knights (26-32) -- the White Sox top affiliate. With a 7-4 loss Tuesday night, the 'Pigs were swept in Louisville and finished just 3-5 on the eight-game West Division road trip (started 3-1). Lehigh Valley has lost four in a row and is just 9-20 in its last 29 games... Charlotte just split a four-game home series versus Scranton but has gone 6-4 in its last 10 games. Since starting 13-22 on May 15, the Knights have gone a more respectable 13-10.

• First-Pitch tonight is scheduled at 7:05 p.m. for "Pig Wars" Souvenir Collector's Cup #1, presented by **Sonic**.

BATTLE OF RED-HOT 4-0 PITCHERS:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** is 3-0, 0.69 ERA in his last 4 G, 3 GS & RHP **Jack Egbert** is 3-0, 1.43 in his last 4 G, 3 GS.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- who won his first ML start this year (see below) -- is a 6-3, 225-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 2nd round of 2006 out of Long Beach State and is a member of the 40-Man Roster. The Vacaville, CA, native spent a bulk of 2008 in Double-A Reading, going just 6-8 with a 5.67 ERA in 16 GS -- but was on the move in the second half, with a stint in Advanced-A Clearwater (3-3, 2.92 in 8 GS from 6/16-7/31), a ML debut with Philly (scoreless IP of relief 8/27 vs. NYM) and a start with LHV on 8/31 @ PAW (L, 7 ip 6 h, 2 er). Carpenter had a stellar 2007 season in Clearwater -- where he led the Florida State League in wins (17) and shutouts (2) while being selected to play in the 2007 FSL All-Star Game. He finished the season 17-6, 3.20 with 1 SV in 27 G, 24 GS, and tied for the league lead in CG (3). Among the highlights in his three-year MILB career was a 7-inning perfect game 8/27/07 vs. Fort Myers (7 ip, 7 k). He also won both his postseason starts (2-0, 2.92) as the Threshers won the 2007 FSL Championship.

- *DC won his MLB starting debut 5/16 @ WAS-G2: W*, 4.1 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k *Rule 10.17 (b) (2).*
- *Since winning his first ML start, DC is 3-0, 0.89 in 4 G, 3 GS with LHV (27.1 ip, 21 h, 2 r, 2 er, 18 k)...*
- *DC, 6/5 @ IND (W, 3-0): W, 7.0 ip, 4 h, 0 r, 2 bb, 6 k After LO 1B in 2nd, ret'd 13 in a row til 2-out 2B in 6th; Never a runner on 3rd*

RHP **Jack Egbert** -- a member of the White Sox 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-3, 220-pound, 26-year-old righty drafted by Chicago-A in the 13th round of 2004 out of Rutgers University. The Staten Island native entered 2008 rated the No. 3 Prospect in the organization and spent most of the season with Charlotte, going 4-12, 4.65 in 24 G, 22 GS. He began the season on the DL (rt. elbow inflammation) and was activated 4/18/08 -- when he made his lone start with Double-A Birmingham (n/d, 4 ip, er). He started 0-4, 7.55 in his first 7 G in the IL, but went 4-8, 3.73 the remainder of 2008 (inc. a 7-inning, 2-hit SHO on 7/9-G2 vs. ROC). Egbert spent the 2007 season with Birmingham, going 12-8, 3.06 in 28 GS and was an Southern League mid-season All-Star. After the season, he was honored as the starting pitcher in the AFL Rising Stars Showcase game after pitching for Phoenix Desert Dogs (1-0, 3.26 in 6 GS).

- *JE made his first 2 appearances in MLB this season, going 0-0, 27.00 (2.2 ip, 8 er); 4/21 @ BAL, 4/24 vs. TOR*
- *JE as Starter: 3-0, 1.13 in 3 GS (16 ip, 12 h, 2 er, 2 bb, 12 k, .200); As Reliever: 1-0, 9.00, SV in 11 G (16 ip)*
- *JE continued to deal his last start, a 9-1 win 6/5 vs. COL: W, 6.0 ip, 5 h, r, er, bb, 5 k. He's won his last 3 GS.*

TRANSACTIONS:

OF **Michael Spidale** has been promoted from Reading (.297-3-16 in 44 G); OF **Jeremy Slayden** was sent to REA.

LEAD STORY?:

LHV scored in the 1st inning in 3 of the 4 G in LOU, but still dropped all 4 G of the series. The 'Pigs have now blown leads in 51.4% of their losses (18 of 35). If they hung on in just 1/2 of those games, they'd be 31-27. They lead the IL with 7 losses when leading after 5 innings and have also blown an IL-high 4 G leading after 8 innings (10 teams have either 0 or just 1; TOL has 3)... The 'Pigs also have the 2nd-worst record when scoring first (16-13) behind BUF (9-10).

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- With the sweep by LOU, LHV has been swept in a four-game series for the third time this season (4/9-4/12 vs. SWB; 5/12-5/15 @ COL). They had entered 2009 having not been swept in four by anyone other than SWB & PAW...
- RHP **Carlos Carrasco** is now 1-6, 6.80 in his last 9 GS (47.1 ip, 61 h, 36 er) after starring his IL career 2-3, 1.94 in his first 11 GS from 2008-09 (55.2 ip, 12 er, 2 wins blown by pen).

SERIES INFORMATION:

This is the first meeting in 2009... LHV won the '08 series, 5-3, with the teams splitting at Coca-Cola Park 5/22-5/25/08.

INJURIES UPDATE:

INF Pablo Ozuna (stitches in rt. middle finger) has missed the last 4 G & is expected to remain out for the CHA series.

GETTIN 'MIGGY WITH IT!

INF Miguel Cairo had his 11-G hitting streak snapped Monday (0-4, bb), but he has hit safely in 17 of his first 19 G since joining Lehigh Valley (27-76, .355-3-10) -- and he has hit 3 HR after going 850 AB without one (going back to 2005)... On 5/28 @ BUF, he hit his first HR since 7/28/05, when he hit on as a Met in Minute Maid Park against RHP Chad Qualls... After going 850 AB without one a home run, he hit two in a span of 7 AB (connected again 5/30 vs. ROC). In the Majors, he's gone 813 ABs since that HR, which, according to the Elias Sports Bureau, is the longest active homerless streak in the Majors Leagues.

BOWERS POWERS:

LHP Cedric Bowers had an 11.0 scoreless IP streak snapped Monday (1 ip, 1 r, 1 er)... But during the impressive streak, he'd unscored upon in his previous 8 G -- during which opposing batters were 0-29! The run scored after a one-out 3B by **Drew Sutton** which snapped a string of Bowers not allowing an extra basehit in a span of 16+ G, 20.2 IP & 66 AB. It was just the 3rd extra basehit that Bowers had allowed in his first since 4/19 on an **Alex Ochoa** solo HR... Even so, he has allowed just 1 R in his last 9 G (0-0, 0.77 ERA, 6 holds, 11.2 IP, 3 h, 1 er).

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

C Lou Marson has a 4-G hitting streak (7-15, .467-0-2, 2 2B) with 3 multi-hit games... OF **John Mayberry** had his 8-game hitting streak snapped Sunday but has still hit safely in 17 of his last 20 G (21-72, .291-2-9, 6 2B)... OF **Jason Ellison** has hit safely in 10 of his last 13 G (15-51, .294-2-6, 4 2B, 5 BB)... 3B **David Newhan** had an 8-game RBI streak snapped 6/4, but has at least 1 RBI in 10 of last 13 G. In his last 22 G, he's batting .311-4-14 (23-74, 10 BB)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit safely in 7 of his last 9 GS (11-30, .367-1-3, 2 2B)... After starting the first 35 G without an error at SS, INF **Jason Donald** committed his first 2 errors 5/24. He started errorless in his first 174 chances. He still leads IL shortstops in fielding PCT.

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ WAS, RHP **Drew Carpenter** is 3-0, 0.66 in 4 G, 3 GS with LHV (27.1 ip, 20 h, 2 r, 2 er, 18 k)... RHP **Tyler Walker** had his season-starting 13.0 scoreless IP streak snapped in his 9th appearance on 5/29 vs. ROC. Still, he's been unscored upon in 12 of his 14 G (1.47, 18.1 ip, 8 h, 3 er, 3 bb, 19 k)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 12 of last his 14 relief ap's (3-0, 1.61, 22.1 ip, 4 er)...

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Out of Cervice*: The IronPigs are 17-34 (.333) when INF **Mike Cervenak** has been out of the lineup in 2008-09.
- *Close Calls, Pt 1*: The 'Pigs last 9 G have been decided by 3-or-fewer runs (3-6)... as have 14 of their last 16 G...
- *What Happened to SWB?*: Since starting 23-5 (5/8), they've gone just 12-19 -- but the 'Pigs have actually lost 2.0 game in the standings during that period... The Yankees started 11-0 and then 14-1.
- *Power Outage?*: After clubbing 8 HR in 8 G (5/27-6/4-G1), the 'Pigs have just 2 (Slayden, Cairo) in the last 6 G.
- *Louisville 'Gloves?*: The Bats lead the IL in errors, but LHV committed 6 E in 4 G at LSF after making just 4 E in prev. 12 G.
- *Getting Defensive*: LHV has fallen from 1st to 3rd in the IL in fielding percentage (.981); but the 'Pigs have now turned an IL-best 66 double plays. The next closest team has just 60 (IND).
- LHV's normal Top 2 in lineup -- Rich Thompson (13-86), Jason Donald (13-76) -- are a combined 26-for-their-last-162 (.160).
- *Dropping the Clutch?*: In the last 22 G (8-14), the 'Pigs are batting just .208 (40-192) w/ RISP.
- *King Lehr*: Although allowing 4 ER in 5.2 IP on Mon., **Justin Lehr** is now 2-0 w/ LOU; 7-2 in '09 and 13-4 in his IL career.
- *One is the Loneliest...*: The 'Pigs are just 1-8 in their last 9 one-run games (had a 6-G losing streak during span).
- *Extra Special?*: The 'Pigs fell to just 1-6 in extra-inning games this season. The first 6 G were all at home (1-5).
- *Not the Pace Game*: (: Despite the fair start (14-15 in 29 G), the LHV's on pace to go 57-87... they finished 55-89 in '08
- *Close Calls, Pt 2*: Twelve of the 'Pigs last 14 wins are by 3 or fewer runs -- 10 of those 12 Ws are by just 1 or 2 R.
- *Same 'ole Saturday Night?*: The 'Pigs are now 0-9 on Saturdays; 0-7 wearing the Saturday alternate jerseys.
- *In a Pinch!*: LHV pinch-hitters are now 7-21 (.333) with 5 BB, HBP (.481 OBP)...

1,500 MILESTONE:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31 (20-29), 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MilB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. He is currently the 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 92-149 (.381) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 111-186 (.374) & a combined 69.0 GB.

• The 'Pigs spent the first 5 days of the '09 season in last place... after spending the first 70 days of '08 in last. To start franchise history, they were in the cellar for 130 of their first 158 days... but been out since April 15, 2009.
