TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (25-36) play the finale of a four-game series against the fourth-place Charlotte Knights (27-34) -- the White Sox top affiliate. With a 6-4 rain-shortened, seven-inning loss last night, the 'Pigs snapped their mini two-game streak and have now .gone just 11-21 in their last 32 games... Charlotte snapped a three-game skid, and since starting 13-22 on May 15, the Knights have gone a more respectable 14-12... *With a win today, the 'Pigs will take the four-game series (second in three tries after taking series 6/2-6/5 @ IND). They're 2-4-2 in four-gamers...*

• First-Pitch is at 1:35 p.m. Following the game, the 'Pigs embark on an eight-game South Division road trip against the top two teams in the IL, Durham (38-24) and Norfolk (36-24).

TODAY'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Gustavo Chacin** -- making his 3rd start as an IronPig... and his first since having a baby girl, Brianna, on Thursday -- is a 5-11, 207-pound, 28-year-old lefty signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 4/6/09 (he had been released by Washington at the end of Spring Training). The native of Maracaibo, VZ, spent 2008 battling injuries rehabbing for Toronto in Single-A Dunedin (1-7, 7.88 in 11 GS) -- after undergoing surgery for a slight tear in his labrum on 8/29/07. Chacin last pitched in MLB for Toronto in 2007, and went 25-15, 4.18 in a 4-year stint with the Jays. He made his ML debut 9/20/04 at NYY and became the 7th Jay to win his first start (7 ip, 3 er). In his rookie season of '05, Chacin went 13-9, 3.72 in 34 GS and led TOR with 121 SO. The 13 wins set a team rookie record for starting pitchers and he was AL Rookie of the Month twice (April: 2-1, 2.48 in 5 GS; and July: 5-0, 2.97 in 6 GS) and became the fastest Blue Jay to ever reach the 10-win plateau. Chacin emerged in MiLB in 2004, when he went 16-2, 2.86 in 25 with New Hampshire and was an Eastern League post-season All-Star. Originally signed by TOR as a non-drafted free agent 7/3/98, he worked hand-and-hand with fragrance experts to concoct *Chacin Cologne* for a team promotion.

• GC started his season with 2 appearances in Reading (1-0, 3.21, 1 GS).

• GC won his lone start w/ REA 5/23 @ ALT: W, 5.0 ip, 4 h, r, er, bb, 3 k -- his first win since 6/4/08 @ Fort Myers.

• GC, 6/7 @ LOU (L, 4-1): L, 5 ip, 9 h, 2 r, er, bb, 3 k Duel w/ Bailey; stranded 3 in first 2 IP; 2-out in 4th; u/e R in 5th; left down 2-0

LHP **Wes Whisler** -- a member of the White Sox 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-5, 240-pound, 26-year-old lefty selected by Chicago-A in the 2nd round of the 2004 draft out of UCLA (where he batted .303-34-129; went 11-14, 4.99 in 49 G, 43 GS and was the 2002 Pac-10 Freshman of the Year). The native of Noblesville, IN, spent the entire 2008 season in Charlotte, going 12-10, 3.81 in 27 GS -- where he led the Knights in victories and GS and ranked 10th in the IL in ERA. Once ranked by *Baseball America* as having the 'Best Raw Power' and as the 'Best Athlete' (along with Josh Fields) in the White Sox' 2004 draft class, Whisler appeared in 11 G as a hitter in 2004 with Kannapolis (.289-1-5 in 38 AB).

• WW vs. LHV in 2008: 1-1, 4.50 ERA in 2 GS (12.0 ip, 17 h, 9 r, 6 er, 1 bb, 3 k, hr, .327)

• WW made his ML debut on 6/02/09 vs. OAK (1 ip, bb, 2 k) and appeared in 3 G while up (1.1 ip, 0 h, 2 er, 3 bb, 2 k)

• WW's last start, which was prior to promotion, was 5/27 @ COL (L, 6-4): n/d, 6.0 ip, 7 h, 4 r, 4 er, bb, 3 k, 2 hr.

LHV leads the season series, 2-1... LHV split the '08 series, 4-4, with the teams splitting at Coca-Cola Park 5/22-5/25/08.

BANGED; BRUISED & BATTERED...AND...TRANSACTIONS (12 in last 4 days):

Over the last two days, SS **Jason Donald** (left knee inflammation) and C **Lou Marson** (right ankle contusion) were placed on the D.L... RHP **Sergio Escalona** was again promoted to Philadelphia... RHP **Jason Anderson** was promoted back from Reading (0-0, 3.52 in 9 G with LHV) as was C **Orlando Guevara** (1-3, RBI in 1 G)... INF **Jorge Velandia** was activated from the D.L...OF **Jason Ellison** (elbow) remains day-to-day...

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Same 'ole Saturday Night?:* The 'Pigs are now 0-10 on Saturdays; 0-7 wearing the Saturday alternate jerseys.
- *All that Starts Well, Ends Well?:* LHV has scored in the 1st inning in 5 of their last 7 G -- but are just 1-4 in those 5 G.
- *What a Relief:* The 'Pigs bullpen has not allowed a R in its last 13.0 ip (4 G). Since the first series of the season (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has combined for a 2.61 ERA (189.2 ip, 55 er) in the past 56 G.
- *Close Calls, Pt 1:* The 'Pigs last 12 G have been decided by 3-or-fewer runs (5-7)... as have 17 of their last 19 G...
- *Close Calls, Pt 2:* Thirteen of the 'Pigs last 15 wins are by 3-or-fewer runs -- 11 of those 13 Ws are by just 1 or 2 R.

LEAD STORY?:

After losing another first-inning lead, the 'Pigs have now blown leads in 52.8% of their losses (19 of 36). If they hung on in just 1/2* of those games, they'd be 33-28. They lead the IL with 7 losses when leading after 5 innings and have also blown an IL-high 4 G leading after 8 innings (10 teams have either 0 or just 1; TOL has 3)... The 'Pigs also have the 2nd-worst record when scoring first (17-14) behind BUF (10-10).

THAT'S HOW THEY DREW IT UP!:

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP Drew Carpenter has now gone 4-0 with a 0.79 ERA in 5 G, 4 GS with Lehigh Valley (34.1 ip, 26 h, 3 r, 3 er, 22 k)... Amazingly, Carpenter has taken a shutout into the 8th inning in 3 of his last 4 G -- and into the 7th in the other. The 'Pigs are 8-3 when he starts*. His win in his lone ML appearance '09 was in G2 of a DH vs. the Nats (4.1 ip*, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k); credited with a win due to Rule 10.17 (b) (2).

GETTIN 'MIGGY WITH IT!

INF Miguel Cairo has hit safely in 19 of his first 22 G since joining Lehigh Valley (30-85, .353-3-11) -- and he has hit 3 HR after going 850 AB without one (going back to 2005)... On 5/28 @ BUF, he hit his first HR since 7/28/05, when he hit on as a Met in Minute Maid Park against RHP Chad Qualls... After going 850 AB without one a home run, he hit two in a span of 7 AB (connected again 5/30 vs. ROC). In the Majors, he's gone 813 ABs since that HR, which, according to the Elias Sports Bureau, is the longest active homerless streak in the Majors Leagues.

BOWERS POWERS:

LHP Cedric Bowers had an 11.0 scoreless IP streak snapped Monday (1 ip, 1 r, 1 er)... But during the impressive streak, he'd unscored upon in his previous 8 G -- during which opposing batters were 0-29! The run scored after a one-out 3B by Drew Sutton which snapped a string of Bowers not allowing an extra basehit in a span of 16+ G, 20.2 IP & 66 AB. It was just the 3rd extra basehit that Bowers had allowed in his first since 4/19 on an Alex Ochoa solo HR... Even so, he has allowed just 1 R in his last 10 G (0-0, 0.66 ERA, 6 holds, 13.2 IP, 3 h, 1 er, 11 k).

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF Mike Cervenak has an 8-game hit streak (12-28, .429-0-2) and hit in 18 of his last 21 G (30-82, .366-1-15, 10 R)... C Lou Marson has hit in 4 of last 5 G (7-18, .389-0-2, 2 2B) with 3 m-h games... OF Jason Ellison has hit safely in 11 of his last 14 G (16-55, .291-2-6, 5 2B, 5 BB)... 3B David Newhan is batting .294-4-14 (25-85, 10 BB) in his last 25 G... C Paul Hoover has hit safely in 8 of his last 11 GS (12-36, .333-1-4, 3 2B)... OF Michael Spidale has hit in both games w/ LHV (3-9, 2B, R)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ WAS, RHP Drew Carpenter is 4-0, 0.79 in 5 G, 4 GS with LHV (34.1 ip, 26 h, 3 r, 3 er, 22 k)... RHP Tyler Walker had his season-starting 13.0 scoreless IP streak snapped in his 9th appearance on 5/29 vs. ROC. Still, he's been unscored upon in 13 of his 15 G (1.40, 19.1 ip, 8 h, 3 er, 3 bb, 20 k)... LHP Jake Woods is unscored upon in 12 of last his 14 relief ap's (3-0, 1.61, 22.1 ip, 4 er)... RHP Jason Anderson has allowed just 1 R in his last 8 G (12.0 IP) with LHV. He was also unscored upon in his last 4 G in REA (4.2 ip, h)...

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Getting Defensive?*: LHV has committed at least 1 E in 5 of the last 6 G (nc. a season-high 5-G streak). Previously, they committed just 4 E in prev. 12 G. Still, LHV is 2nd in the IL in fielding percentage (.981) and the 'Pigs have now turned an IL-best 687 double plays. The next closest team has just 64 (IND).
- *Power Outage?*: After clubbing 8 HR in 8 G (5/27-6/4-G1), the 'Pigs have just 2 (Slayden, Cairo) in the last 9 G.
- *Me First!*: OF Jason Ellison is batting .350-0-5 (21-60) w/ a .412 OBP when hitting No. 1; .173-1-17 (19-110) anywhere else.
- *Walk this Way!*: The walk-off win in the 10th on Friday marked the 3rd such victory of '09 -- first since 5/6 vs. BUF.
- *Extra Special?*: The 'Pigs improved to 2-6 in extra-inning games in '09 -- 7 have been at CCP (inc. the first 6 G).
- *One-derful?*: LHV has won back-to-back one-run games (2nd time in '09) after dropping 8 of the last 9 such games.
- *What Happened to SWB?*: Since starting 23-5 (5/8), they've gone just 14-20 -- but the 'Pigs have actually lost 2.0 games in the standings during that period... The Yankees started 11-0 and then 14-1.
- RHP Carlos Carrasco is now 1-6, 6.80 in his last 9 GS (47.1 ip, 61 h, 36 er) after starting his IL career 2-3, 1.94 in his first 11 GS from 2008-09 (55.2 ip, 12 er, 2 wins blown by pen).
- *Dropping the Clutch?*: In the last 25 G (10-15), the 'Pigs are batting just .217 (48-221) w/ RISP.
- *Not the Pace Game*: (: Despite the fair start (14-15 in 29 G), the LHV's on pace to go 59-85... they finished 55-89 in '08
- *In a Pinch!*: LHV pinch-hitters are now 7-21 (.333) with 5 BB, HBP (.481 OBP)...

1,500 MILESTONE:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31 (20-29), 'Pigs skipper Dave Huppert earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. He is currently the 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 94-150 (.385) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 113-187 (.377) & a combined 69.0 GB.
