TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (28-36) play Game Three of a four-game series against the second-place Durham Bulls (38-27)-- Tampa's top affiliate. With a record-setting* 16-8 win last night, the 'Pigs have tied their season-high with a three-game winning streak. They've also won five of their last six games and have started 2-0 on this eight-game, South Division road trip... Durham tied its season-high with a three-game losing streak -- and the Bulls have lost six of seven games and gone just 4-9 in their last 13 games since they were a season-best 34-18 on 6/2... First-Pitch is at 1:05 p.m.

* *Southern Comfort?*: The 'Pigs are now 7-7 vs. the South -- and 26-20 (.565) in its history (only winning record).

With a Win Tonight, the IronPigs will:

- Have a season-best, four-game winning streak -- which would tie the franchise-record set 6/25-6/28/08 and later tied 7/27-7/30/08. The Phillies' Triple-A affiliates have not won 5 straight since SWB won 5-straight games 8/11-8/15/06.
- Clinch the series victory giving them wins in 3 of their last 4 four-game series (6/2-6/5 @ IND; 6/11-6/14 vs. CHA).

*ABOUT LAST NIGHT

[1] The 16 runs were a LHV franchise-record (prev. 13, set 4/24/09 vs. PAW)... [2] Four LHV HRs were a season-high and tied a franchise high set 6/2/08 @ IND... [3] **Drew Carpenter** set a LHV record by notching his 6th consecutive win (prev. 5 by Brian Mazone in 2008)... [4] **David Newhan** hit the first LHV grand slam of 2009 and their 2nd in LHV history (John Knott, 6/19/08 @ CHA)... [5] **David Newhan** tied a franchise record with 5 RBI (Andy Tracy, 5/16/08 vs. NOR)... [6] **Michael Spidale** tied a 2009 team-high with 4 hits (Mike Cervenak) -- which ties the franchise record done 14 times in 2008 (most: Brandon Watson, 4x)... [7] Only 5 times in the first 63 G did a LHV player score 3 R in a game. Three did last night: Newhan, Mayberry, Spidale -- tying the LHV record done 11 times in 2008 (most: Andy Tracy, 5x).

TODAY'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Kyle Kendrick** -- a member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster with 1.110 years of ML service time -- is a 6-3, 190-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 7th-round of 2003 out of Mt. Vernon (WA) HS -- turning down a scholarship to play QB at Washington State to sign with the Phillies. Kendrick was initially promoted from Reading (AA) straight to the Majors on 6/13/07 -- and became a key cog in the Phils' run to capture the N.L. East. He went 10-4, 3.87 in 20 starts, leading all N.L. rookies in wins and ranking 3rd in ERA. Kendrick started 2008 right where he left off -- going 8-3, 4.47 in 19 starts before the All-Star Break. However, he struggled thereafter -- finishing just 3-6, 7.59 in his next 11 GS before being left off the Phils' postseason rosters. In all, he is 21-13, 4.78 in 51 G, 50 GS w/ PHI.

- *KK earned the 'W' in the first-ever game at CCP -- a 5-3 PHI victory over LHV in exhibition 3/30/08 (5 ip, 0 r).*
- *KK has had 4 straight QS, going 2-1, 3.81 (26 ip, 11 er) -- taking a SHO into the 6th in starts 1 & 2 in the span.*
- *KK, 5/22 vs. DUR (W, 5-3): W, 6.0 ip, 6 h, 3 r, 3 er, 2 bb, 4 k Up in 1st, stranded 5 in first 3 IP; LO BB in 6th led to 3-R HR (Richard)*
- *KK, 6/6 @ LOU (L, 5-4): n/d, 7 ip, 7 h, 3 r, 3 er, bb, 2 k Up 3-0, allowed R in 1st; Up 4-1, 2 R in 4th; ret'd 10 of last 11; left up 4-3*
- *KK's last appearance was in PHI & he took the L in relief 6/12 vs. BOS (2 ip, 4 h, 3 r, 3 er, bb). Entered 2-2 in 12th.*

LHP **Jason Cromer**, 28, is a 6-4, 225-pound righty signed by Tampa as a minor league free agent 5/4/08 (he went to Spring Training with Kansas City but was released 3/25/08). The Des Moines native was originally drafted by Tampa in the 11th round of 1999 (325th overall) out of Lincoln (IA) H.S. before spending one season in the Royals organization in 2007. Cromer spent 2008 in Double-A Montgomery, going 5-3, 3.96 in 29 G, 8 GS. He started in the bullpen -- going 2-2, 3.82 -- before a shift 7/20/08 to the starting rotation, where he went 3-1, 4.40. Previously, Cromer made it up to Durham in 2006 and went 0-1, 4.74 in 12 G, 1 GS as a Bull.

- *JC started '09 in DUR (1-0, 0.00 in 2 GS) before pitching for Double-A Montgomery 4/24-5/30 (4-3, 5.01 in 8 GS).*
- *JC was a tough-luck, 1-0 loser vs. Niese last start 6/12 @ BUF: L, 6 ip, 6 h, r, er, bb, 0 k (0-2, 2.32 last 32 GS).*

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *A Case of the Runs, PT 1:* The 'Pigs have scored 30 R during their 3-G win steak... they had 30 R in their prev. 10 G.
- *A Case of the Runs, PT 2:* The 'Pigs have scored runs in 11 of last 17 frames -- with multiple runs in five of them.
- *Going on the Offensive:* In the last 5 G, LHV is batting .315 (56-178) and .392 (20-51) w/ RISP... averaging 7.4 R/G.
- On Sunday, the 'Pigs scored 4 R in the 3rd inning -- their highest total in 30 games since scoring 4 R on 5/14 @ COL-G2. Last night, they had innings of 4, 4, 5. They've scored 4+ R in 4 of the last 24 innings after 0 in prev. 250 innings.

SERIES INFORMATION:

The 2009 season series is tied, 3-3... LHV won the 2008 series, 6-2; winning the series, 3-1, at Coca-Cola from 7/21-7/24/08. LHV also had its first-ever road series victory, 3-1, from 6/23-26/08 @ DUR.

THAT'S HOW THEY DREW IT UP!:

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP Drew Carpenter has now gone 5-0 with a 1.35 ERA in 6 G, 5 GS with Lehigh Valley (40.0 ip, 36 h, 6 er, 28 k)... Amazingly, Carpenter has taken a shutout into the 8th inning in 3 of his last 5 G -- and into the 7th in another. The 'Pigs are 9-3 when he starts*. His win in his lone ML appearance '09 was in G2 of a DH vs. the Nats (4.1 ip*, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k); credited with a win due to Rule 10.17 (b) (2).

GETTIN' MIGGY WITH IT!

INF Miguel Cairo has hit safely in 21 of his first 25 G since joining Lehigh Valley (33-98, .337-4-15) -- and he has hit 4 HR after going 850 AB without one (going back to 2005)... On 5/28 @ BUF, he hit his first HR since 7/28/05, when he hit on as a Met in Minute Maid Park against RHP Chad Qualls... After going 850 AB without one a home run, he hit two in a span of 7 AB (connected again 5/30 vs. ROC). In the Majors, he's gone 813 ABs since that HR, which, according to the Elias Sports Bureau, is the longest active homerless streak in the Majors Leagues.

BOWERS POWERS:

LHP Cedric Bowers had an 11.0 scoreless IP streak snapped 6/8 @ LOU (1 ip, 1 r, 1 er)... But during the impressive streak, he'd unscored upon in his previous 8 G -- during which opposing batters were 0-29! The run scored after a one-out 3B by **Drew Sutton** which snapped a string of Bowers not allowing an extra basehit in a span of 16+ G, 20.2 IP & 66 AB. It was just the 3rd extra basehit that Bowers had allowed in his first since 4/19 on an **Alex Ochoa** solo HR... Even so, he has allowed just 1 R in his last 11 G (0-0, 0.61, SV, 6 holds, 14.2 IP, 4 h, 1 er, 14 k).

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 5 of 6 G since returning from injury (8-25, .320-2-7) and in 10 of his last 11 G (16-42, .381-2-8). He's also hit in 20 of his last 24 G (34-96, .354-3-21, 13 R)... 3B **David Newhan** has hits in 7 of his last 11 AB with 8 RBI. He has a 5-G hitting streak (9-20, .450-1-8, 3 2B) and is batting .330-5-22 (32-97, 10 BB) in his last 28 G... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in his last 6 G (9-22, .409-1-4, 3 2B)... OF **Jason Ellison** has hit safely in 13 of last 17 G (20-68, .294-2-7, 6 2B, 7 BB)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit safely in 10 of his last 14 GS (15-47, .319-1-6, 5 2B)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in all 4 G games since his promotion to LHV (8-18, 2B, 4 R)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 12 of last his 14 relief ap's (3-0, 1.61, 22.1 ip, 4 er)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has allowed just 1 ER in his last 9 G (14.0 IP, 2 R) with LHV. He was unscored upon in his last 4 G with REA (4.2 ip, h)... RHP **Steven Register** has not allowed a R in his last 3 G (0-0, SV, 5.0 ip, 3 h, 3 k)... LHP **Sergio Escalona** has not allowed a R in his last 3 G (0-0, SV, H, 5.1 ip, 2 h, 5 k)...

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *The Mighty Tracy!*: 1B **Andy Tracy**'s 2nd inning HR LN was the game-winner... 6 of his 10 HR have put LHV ahead.
- *Closing Committee*: In their last 5 wins, the 'Pigs have had 4 different RPs earn a SV (Walker, Escalona, Bowers, Register).
- *Drawing First Blood*: Not only has LHV scored in the 1st 6 of last 10 G (see below); LHV's scored first in 11 of last 14 G.
- *All that Starts Well, Ends Well?*: LHV has scored in the 1st inning in 6 of their last 10 G -- but are just 2-4 in those 6 G. Still, they have 8 first-inning runs in those last 10 G after just 13 in the first 54 G.
- *Close Calls, Pt 1*: Fourteen of the 'Pigs last 15 G have been decided by 3-or-fewer runs (7-7)... as have 19 of their last 22 G... LHV had been involved in 14 consecutive 3-run games 6/1-6/15.
- *Close Calls, Pt 2*: Fifteen of the 'Pigs last 18 wins are by 3-or-fewer runs -- 11 of those 15 Ws are by just 1 or 2 R.
- *Getting Defensive?*: LHV has committed at least 1 E in 8 of the last 10 G (12 total, inc. a season-high 5-G streak). Previously, they committed just 4 E in prev. 12 G. During the span, LHV has fallen from 1st to 4th in the IL in fielding percentage (.980). Still, the 'Pigs have turned an IL-best 72 double plays. The next closest teams has just 65.
- *What a Relief!*: The 'Pigs bullpen has allowed just 2 ER in its last 22.0 ip (7 G, 0.82 ERA, 3 r). Since the first series of the season (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has combined for a 2.58 ERA (195.1 ip, 56 er) in the past 59 G.
- *Me First!*: **Jason Ellison** is batting .344-0-5 (22-64) w/ a .400+ OBP when hitting No. 1; .185-2-8 (22-119) anywhere else.
- *One-derful?*: LHV has won back-to-back one-run games (2nd time in '09) after dropping 8 of the last 9 such games.
- *What Happened to SWB?*: Since starting 23-5 (5/8), they've gone just 17-20 -- but the 'Pigs have actually lost 2.0 games in the standings during that period... The Yankees started 11-0 and then 14-1.
- *In a Pinch!*: LHV pinch-hitters are now 7-21 (.333) with 5 BB, HBP (.481 OBP)...

LEAD STORY?:

After losing another first-inning Saturday, the 'Pigs have blown leads in 52.8% of their losses (19 of 36). If they hung on in just 1/2* of those games, they'd be 36-28. They lead the IL with 7 losses when leading after 5 innings and have also blown an IL-high 4 G leading after 8 innings (10 teams have either 0 or just 1; TOL has 3)... The 'Pigs also have the 2nd-worst record when scoring first (19-14) behind BUF (10-10).

PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 12th:
