TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (32-36) play Game Three of a four-game series against the first-place Norfolk Tides (38-29)-- Baltimore's top affiliate. With an 5-3 win last night, the 'Pigs now have a franchise-high seven-game winning streak. They've also won in nine of their last 10 affairs and have started a perfect 6-0 on this eight-game, South Division road trip... Norfolk now has a season-long five-game losing streak and has dropped nine of their last 11 contests. The Tides have lost four consecutive series and are just 4-14 since they were a season-best 34-15 through May 31...First-Pitch tonight is scheduled for 1:15 p.m.

- *Southern Comfort?*: The 'Pigs are now 11-7 vs. the South -- and 30-20 (.600) in its history (only winning record).
- *Same 'ole Saturday Night?*: Last night, the 'Pigs won for the first time on a Sat. and are now 1-10 on Saturdays.

With Last Night's Win, the IronPigs:

- Have set a franchise record with a seven-game winning streak -- the longest by a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate since the SWB Red Barons won 8-straight games 7/25-8/1/06 (they also won 10 in a row in 2006, from 4/15/06-4/25/06).
- Have set a franchise record with a six-game road winning streak (prev. 5, set this year 5/26-6/4/09). The last time a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate won seven straight road games was during a 10-game road winning streak 5/26/04-6/13/07.
- Have their first 6-win road trip in franchise history (they had two 5-3 road trips in 2008).

TODAY'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- who won his first ML start this year (see below) -- is a 6-3, 225-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 2nd round of 2006 out of Long Beach State and is a member of the 40-Man Roster. He was in the Vacaville, CA, native spent a bulk of 2008 in Double-A Reading, going just 6-8 with a 5.67 ERA in 16 GS -- but was on the move in the second half, with a stint in Advanced-A Clearwater (3-3, 2.92 in 8 GS from 6/16-7/31), a ML debut with Philly (scoreless IP of relief 8/27 vs. NYM) and a start with LHV on 8/31 @ PAW (L, 7 ip 6 h, 2 er). Carpenter had a stellar 2007 season in Clearwater -- where he led the Florida State League in wins (17) and shutouts (2) while being selected to play in the 2007 FSL All-Star Game. He finished the season 17-6, 3.20 with 1 SV in 27 G, 24 GS, and tied for the league lead in CG (3). Among the highlights in his three-year MILB career was a 7-inning perfect game 8/27/07 vs. Fort Myers (7 ip, 7 k). He also won both his postseason starts (2-0, 2.92) as the Threshers won the 2007 FSL Championship.

- *Carpenter enters the season ranked as the No. 22 Prospect in the organization by Baseball America.*
- *DC won his MLB starting debut 5/16 @ WAS-G2: W*, 4.1 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k *Rule 10.17 (b) (2).*
- *Since winning his 1st ML start, DC is 5-0, 1.35 in 6 G, 5 GS with LHV (40.0 ip, 36 h, 6 er, 28 k)...*
- *DC, 6/16 @ DUR (W, 16-8): W, 5.2 ip, 10 h, 7 r, 3 er, 3 bb, 6 k Allowed 3 R on 2 HR in 2nd; settled til LO E-5 led to 4 h, 4 u/e R in 6th*

LHP **Troy Patton** -- a member of the Orioles' 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-1, 185-pound, 23-year-old lefty acquired by Baltimore with OF Luke Scott, RHP Dennis Scarfate, RHP Matt Albers and 3B Mike Costanzo from Houston for SS Miguel Tejada, 12/12/07. He was originally drafted by the Astros in the 9th round of 2004 out of Tomball (TX) H.S. (where he threw a perfect game and 2 no-hitters) -- passing up on attending with University of Texas to sign. The Texas native missed the entire 2008 season after having surgery to repair a torn labrum in his left shoulder. In 2007, Patton started at Double-A and eventually made his ML debut 8/25/07 vs. Pittsburgh (L, 5.2 ip, 3 r, 4 k) -- and next took a one-hitter into the 6th inning 9/1/07 at Chicago. With Houston, he went 0-2, 3.55 in 3 G, 2 GS (shut down with left biceps tendinitis) after pitching with Double-A Corpus Christi (6-6, 2.99 in 16 GS) and Triple-A Round Rock (4-2, 4.59 in 8 GS).

- *TP opened '09 w/ Double-A Bowie -- going 6-2, 1.99 in 11 GS (63.1, 50 h, 18 bb, 47 k, .211) -- before 6/14 promotion.*
- *TP lost his NOR debut 6-4 in his last start 6/15 @ LOU: L, 6 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 2 k, 3 hr (Sutton, Tatum, Barker).*

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the season series, 2-0... LHV won '08 series, 5-3 -- but the teams split at Harbor Park 7/29-8/1/08, 2-2.

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Turning the Corner:* RHP **Carlos Carrasco** has won 3 of his last 4 GS -- going 3-1, 4.74 (24.2 ip, 13 er). He's also had quality starts in 5 of his last 7 GS, going 3-3, 4.06 (44.1 ip, 20 er) in these last 7 GS -- lowering from 6.62 ERA.
- *Road Warriors:* LHV won 6 straight road games and 12 of last 17 G... They are now 18-16 (.529) on the road.
- *Lead Story:* LHV didn't lead until the 7th inning Sat. Prior to the game, LHV was tied or ahead in 48 of prev. 52 innings (6 G).

THE MIGHTY TRACY:

Friday, 1B **Andy Tracy** had an historical night for Lehigh Valley (3-3, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 4 R, 2 BB, SB). He: **[1]** Set a franchise record for R with 4 R (prev. 3 done 19 times). **[2]** Tied a franchise record with 5 RBI (set by Tracy 5/16 vs. NOR; tied by David Newhan 6/16 @ DUR). **[3]** Tied a franchise record with 2 HR in a game (done 5 times, four by Tracy once by Brennan King 6/3/08 @ IND). **[4]** Tied his franchise record with 9 TB in a game (set 8/7/08 @ ROC).

- Tracy has hit in 8 of his last 10 G (13-34, .382-3-12, 4 2B) & in 11 of his last 14 G (17-48, .354-3-15).

- Seven of Tracy's 12 HR have put LHV ahead in a game... and 5 were game-winners (4/17, 4/19, 6/2, 6/16, 6/19).

HEY JUNE: Tracy is batting .308-4-17 (20-65, 5 2B, 14 BB) in 19 G in June... Last season, he hit .446-4-18 (11 2B, 16 BB) in 25 G... Since 2003, Tracy is batting .339-35-121 in 139 G in June (171-505, 41 2B, 3B, 119 R, 89 BB).

BACK IN SERVICE:

Since returning from the D.L., **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 7 of 10 games, batting .262-2-11 (11-42, 2B). He missed 23 games after being placed on the D.L. on 5/18 with a right wrist fracture suffered on a HBP by RHP Tommy Hanson. Cervenak has also hit it in 22 of his last 28 G (37-111, .333-3-24, 16 R) and reached in 42 of 45 G in 2009.

BOWERS POWERS:

LHP **Cedric Bowers** has allowed just 1 R in his last 13 G (1-0, 0.50, SV, 7 holds, 18.0 IP, 7 h, 1 er, 17 k). He had an 11.0 scoreless IP streak snapped 6/8 @ LOU (1 ip, 1 r, 1 er)... But during the impressive streak, he'd unscored upon in his previous 8 G -- during which opposing batters were 0-29! The run scored after a one-out 3B by **Drew Sutton** which snapped a string of Bowers not allowing an extra basehit in a span of 16+ G, 20.2 IP & 66 AB. It was just the 3rd extra basehit that Bowers had allowed in his first since 4/19 on an **Alex Ochoa** solo HR.

THAT'S HOW THEY DREW IT UP!:

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 5-0 with a 1.35 ERA in 6 G, 5 GS with Lehigh Valley (40.0 ip, 36 h, 6 er, 28 k)... Amazingly, Carpenter has taken a shutout into the 8th inning in 3 of his last 5 G -- and into the 7th in another. On 6/16, he set a franchise-record by winning his 6th straight decision (Brian Mazzone, 5, 2008). **The 'Pigs are 9-3 when he starts'**. His win in his lone ML appearance '09 was in G2 of a DH vs. the Nats (4.1 ip*, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k); credited with a win due to Rule 10.17 (b) (2).

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

1B **Andy Tracy** (see above)... 2B **J.J. Furmaniak** has hit in his last 5 G (8-19, .421-0-2, 2 R) & in 11 of last 16 G (15-50, .300-0-7)... OF Rich Thompson has a 6-G hit streak (7-26, .269)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit in his last 4 G (5-14, 3 RBI, 2 2B, 5 R) & in 12 of his last 16 GS (17-54, .315-1-6, 5 2B)... C **Lou Marson** has hit in 6 of last 7 G (10-27, .370-0-5, 3 2B, 4 m-h G)... OF **Jason Ellison** has back-to-back multi-hit G (5-9, RBI) and has hit in 16 of last 21 G (26-84, .310-2-8, 6 2B, 8 BB)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in 6 of 8 G since his promotion to LHV (12-33, .364, 2B, 9 R)...3B **David Newhan** is batting .289-5-23 (33-114, 11 BB) in his last 31 G...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Kyle Kendrick** has 5 straight QS, going 2-1, 3.09 (32 ip, 11 er) -- taking a SHO into the 6th in 3 GS... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 13 of last his 15 relief ap's (3-0, 1.48, 24.1 ip, 4 er)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has allowed just 2 ER in his last 11 G (SV, 1.06, 17.0 IP) with LHV. He was unscored upon in his last 4 G with REA (4.2 ip, h)... RHP **Steven Register** has not allowed a R in 4 of his last 5 G (0-0, SV, 5.2 ip, 6 h, 2 er, 3 k)... LHP **Sergio Escalona** has allowed 1 R in his last 4 G (0-0, 1.35 ERA, 2 SV, H, 6.2 ip, 5 h, 5 k)...

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Going on the Offensive:* In the last 8 G, LHV is batting .275 (78-284) and .360 (27-75) w/ RISP... averaging 6.5 R/G.
- *A Case of the Runs:* The 'Pigs have scored 53 R during their 7-G win streak... they had 55 R in the prev. 16 G (5/28).
- *Getting Series-ous:* The 'Pigs have won 3 of their last 4 series (3-1 @ IND, 0-4 @ LOU, 3-1 vs. CHA, 4-0 @ DUR).
- *What a Relief!* The 'Pigs bullpen has allowed just 6 ER in its last 32.0 ip (10 G, 1-0, 1.69 ERA). Since the first series of the season (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has combined for a 2.63 ERA (205.1 ip, 60 er) in the past 63 G.
- *Getting Defensive?:* LHV is 3rd in the IL in fielding percentage (.981) and has turned an IL-best 80 double plays. The next closest team has just 70 (COL).
- *Drawing First Blood:* Not only has LHV scored in the 1st inning in 7 of the last 14 G (see below) -- and have scored 11 first-inning runs in the last 14 G after just 13 in the first 54 G. In addition, LHV's scored first in 13 of last 18 G.
- *What Happened to SWB?:* Since starting 23-5 (5/8), they've gone just 18-20 -- but the 'Pigs have actually lost 0.5 games in the standings during that period... The Yankees started 11-0 and then 14-1.
- *In a Pinch!* LHV pinch-hitters are now 7-21 (.333) with 5 BB, HBP (.481 OBP)...

CAN'T GET TO .500!:

The 'Pigs have never been at .500 in franchise history... They lost 9-2 in a chance to get to 15-15 on Monday, and are now 0-6 with a chance to get to .500+... The Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't been .500 since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07.

1,500 MILESTONE:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31 (20-29), 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. He is currently the 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.
