TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (33-37) start an 11-game, 11-day homestand tonight when they play the opener of a four-game series against the West's second-place Indianapolis Indians (33-36)-- Pittsburgh's top affiliate. With an 11-1 rain-shortened win last night in Norfolk, the 'Pigs took the series at Harbor Park, 3-1 -- and finished 7-1 on their eight-game, South Division road trip. Streaking Lehigh Valley has won eight of its last nine games and 10 of the last 12 affairs... Indy swept a doubleheader last night to take a rain-shortened series at SWB, 2-1. The Indians had previously dropped five of six contests after a season-high four-game winning streak, June 9-13... First-Pitch is scheduled for 7:05 p.m.

• *Road Warriors:* LHV has won 7 of its last 8 G road games and 13 of last 19 G... and is now 19-17 (.528) on the road.

With Last Night's Win, the 'Pigs:

- Have won three consecutive series for the first time in franchise history (3-1 vs. CHA, 4-0 @ DUR, 3-1 @ NOR).. They've also taken four of their last five.
- Had their first 7-win road trip in franchise history (prev. best was 5; had two 5-3 road trips in 2008) -- the first 7-1 road trip since the SWB Red Barons accomplished the feat 5/29/04-6/6/04 (4-0 @ IND, 3-1 @ LOU).

During the Road Trip:

- The 'Pigs franchise-record, seven-game winning streak was the longest by a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate since the SWB Red Barons won 8-straight games 7/25-8/1/06 (they also won 10 in a row in 2006, from 4/15/06-4/25/06).
- The 'Pigs franchise-record, six-game road winning streak was the longest by a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate since SWB won seven straight road games during a 10-game road winning streak 5/26/04-6/13/04.
- *No Bull, Durham!*: DUR became the first team that LHV has won back-to-back season-series against: 5-3 in 2008 & '09.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Rodrigo Lopez**, 33, is a 6-1, 187 pound righty signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent on 3/5/09. A native of Mexico, Lopez missed most of the 2008 campaign recovering from "Tommy John" surgery 8/22/07. He was signed by Atlanta exactly one year later (8/22/08), and made two starts in the GCL (3 ip, 0 er) and in Single-A Rome (0-1, 2 ip, 9 er). Lopez was the runner-up for the 2002 A.L. Rookie of the Year (Eric Hinske) and twice won 15 games for Baltimore before being traded to Colorado for Jason Burch and Jim Miller, 1/12/07. Additional accolades for Lopez include representing Mexico in the 2006 World Baseball Classic (0-2, 3.86). Originally signed as a minor league free agent by San Diego on 3/21/95, Lopez has logged more than six years of Major League service and has a career mark of 65-65 with a 4.80 ERA (187 g, 161 gs, 1016.2 ip, 1113 h, 577 r, 542 er, 315 bb, 674 k).

- Lopez was on the D.L. (right shoulder strain) from 4/19 through 4/27...
- Lopez's win on 4/28 @ SWB was his first since 7/7/07, when the Rockies defeated the Phil, 6-3, at CBP.
- In his last 5 GS, RL has gone 1-2, 6.04 (25.1 ip, 33 h, 17 er). The span came after back-to-back QS: 1-0, 2.77.
- RL, 6/18 @ DUR (W, 6-2): W, 7 ip, 8 h, r, er, bb, 4 k LO INF-1B + 3 H led to R in 1st; stranded 2-on, 1-out in 3rd; retiring 12 of last 16

RHP **Virgil Vasquez** -- a member of the Pirates' 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-3, 205-pound, 26-year-old claimed off waivers from San Diego on 1/26/09. Originally drafted by Detroit in the 7th round of 2003 out of University of California-Santa Barbara, he spent 2008 in Toledo -- going 12-12, 4.81 in 27 GS and 2 SHO before being claimed off waivers by Boston on 10/28/08 then by SD 1/9/09. The Santa Barbara native made his ML debut with the Tigers 5/13/07 at Minnesota, suffering a 16-4 loss (2.2 ip, 9 h, 6 r, 6 er) and wound up going 0-1, 8.64 in 5 G, 3 GS in his rookie season (0.034 service time). IN 2006, he led Phoenix to an AFL Championship -- earning the win in the title game (W, 5 ip, 2 h, r).

- VV has gone 3-0, 3.41 (37 ip, 14 er) in his last 6 starts (since 5/19) -- after starting 2-2, 4.97 in first 7 GS.
- VV, 6/5 vs. LHV (L, 3-0): n/d, 7 ip, 3 h, 0 r, bb, 4 k Duel w/ Carpenter; didn't allow H til 2-outs in 3rd then ret'd 12 of last 14; left 0-0
- VV won for the 1st time in 4 outings his last start, a 3-2 win (in 7 inn.) 6/17 vs. GWN: CG, W, 7 ip, 5 h, 2 r, 2 er, bb, 2 k.

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *More Records:* Last night, the 10-run margin of victory tied LHV's franchise record (set w/ 13-3 win 4/24/09 vs. PAW) and the 7-run inning in the 4th tied a franchise high from 4/24/09 vs. PAW (3rd) and two times in 2008... The 4th-inning grand slam by **Jason Ellison** was the 2nd of the trip (Newhan, 6/16 @ DUR) and 3rd in LHV history (Jon Knott, 6/19/08 @ CHA).
- *Hey, June:* LHV is tied with SYR for the most wins in the month (13) and is 3rd in AVG (.271) & 4th in ERA (3.17) in June.

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the season series, 3-1, taking the first series at Victory Field 6/2-6/5... LHV won the '08 season series, 5-3.

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

In the last 9 G (8-1), LHV is batting .291 (94-323) and .333 (31-93) w/ RISP... averaging 7.6 R/G... The 'Pigs have scored 68 R in these 9 G after scoring just 70 R in the previous 19 G (5/25-6/13)... After not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 6 of their last 86 innings (11 G).

TRACY NAMED BATTER OF THE WEEK (AGAIN):

Today, 1B **Andy Tracy** has been named I.L. Batter and Pitcher of the Week for the period from June 15-21. Lehigh Valley won all six games in which Tracy played, giving the team its first ever six-win road trip. Tracy hit .381-3-10 for the week, leading the I.L. with 10 RBI and 9 runs scored. He finished 2nd in the circuit in home runs (3), on-base percentage (.533), slugging percentage (.952), and extra-base hits (6). Friday night in Norfolk Tracy served up one of the best performances in Lehigh Valley history, setting a single-game franchise record with 4 runs scored and tying franchise marks with 2 home runs, 5 RBI, and 9 total bases.

• Tracy -- the only IronPigs player to ever win I.L. Player of the Week honors, has now done so three times in his Lehigh Valley career. He was honored 6/23-6/29/08 (.520-2-6) and again 8/4-8/10/08 (.526-4-8, 3 2B)...

THE MIGHTY TRACY:

Friday, 1B **Andy Tracy** had an historical night for Lehigh Valley (3-3, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 4 R, 2 BB, SB). He: **[1]** Set a franchise record for R with 4 R (prev. 3 done 19 times). **[2]** Tied a franchise record with 5 RBI (set by Tracy 5/16 vs. NOR; tied by David Newhan 6/16 @ DUR). **[3]** Tied a franchise record with 2 HR in a game (done 5 times, four by Tracy once by Brennan King 6/3/08 @ IND). **[4]** Tied his franchise record with 9 TB in a game (set 8/7/08 @ ROC).

• Tracy has hit in 9 of his last 11 G (14-38, .368-3-14, 5 2B) & in 12 of his last 15 G (18-52, .346-3-17).

• Seven of Tracy's 12 HR have put LHV ahead in a game... and 5 were game-winners (4/17, 4/19, 6/2, 6/16, 6/19).

HEY JUNE: Tracy is batting .304-4-19 (21-69, 6 2B, 14 BB) in 20 G in June... Last season, he hit .446-4-18 (11 2B, 16 BB) in 25 G... *Since 2003, Tracy is batting .338-35-123 in 140 G in June (172-509, 42 2B, 3B, 119 R, 89 BB).*

BACK IN SERVICE:

Since returning from the D.L., **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 9 of 12 games, batting .313-2-12 (15-48, 3 2B) -- and LHV is 10-2! He missed 23 G after being placed on the D.L. on 5/18 with a right wrist fracture suffered on a HBP by RHP Tommy Hanson. Cervenak has also hit in 24 of his last 30 G (41-117, .350-3-25, 18 R) and reached in 44 of 47 G in 2009.

BOWERS POWERS:

LHP **Cedric Bowers** has allowed just 1 R in his last 13 G (1-0, 0.50, SV, 7 holds, 18.0 IP, 7 h, 1 er, 17 k). He had an 11.0 scoreless IP streak snapped 6/8 @ LOU (1 ip, 1 r, 1 er)... But during the impressive streak, he'd unscored upon in his previous 8 G -- during which opposing batters were 0-29! The run scored after a one-out 3B by **Drew Sutton** which snapped a string of Bowers not allowing an extra basehit in a span of 16+ G, 20.2 IP & 66 AB. It was just the 3rd extra basehit that Bowers had allowed in his first since 4/19 on an **Alex Ochoa** solo HR.

THAT'S HOW THEY DREW IT UP!:

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 5-1 with a 1.76 ERA in 7 G, 6 GS with Lehigh Valley (46.0 ip, 9 er, 31 k)... Amazingly, Carpenter has taken a shutout into the 8th inning in 3 of his last 6 G -- and into the 7th in another. On 6/16, he set a franchise-record by winning his 6th straight decision (Brian Mazzone, 5, 2008). The 'Pigs are 9-4 when he starts*. His win in his lone ML appearance '09 was in G2 of a DH vs. the Nats (4.1 ip*, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k); credited with a win due to Rule 10.17 (b) (2).

1B **Andy Tracy** (see above)... 2B **J.J. Furmaniak** has hit in his last 7 G (11-26, .423-1-4, 5 R) & in 13 of last 18 G (18-57, .316-1-9)... OF **Rich Thompson** has an 8-G hit streak (10-33, .303)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit in his last 5 G (6-18, .333, 3 RBI, 2 2B, 5 R) & in 13 of his last 17 GS (18-58, .310-1-6, 5 2B)... C **Lou Marson** has hit in all 4 G since coming off the D.L. (6-16, .375-0-5) and in 8 of his last 9 G (13-34, .382-0-2, 3 2B, 5 m-h G)... OF **Jason Ellison** has hit in last 4 G (7-18, .389-1-5) and has hit in 18 of his last 23 G (28-93, .301-3-12, 6 2B, 8 BB)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in 7 of 10 G since his promotion to LHV (14-41, .341, 2B, 11 R)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

In his last 6 GS, RHP **Kyle Kendrick** is 2-1, 3.34 (32.1 ip, 12 er, 5 QS) -- taking a SHO into the 6th in 3 GS... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 13 of last his 16 relief ap's (3-0, 1.71, 26.1 ip, 5 er)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has allowed just 2 ER in his last 11 G (SV, 1.06, 17.0 IP) with LHV. He was unscored upon in his last 4 G with REA (4.2 ip, h)... RHP **Steven Register** has not allowed a R in 5 of his last 6 G (0-0, 2.35, SV, 7.2 ip, 8 h, 2 er, 4 k)... LHP **Sergio Escalona** has allowed 1 R in his last 4 G (0-0, 1.35 ERA, 2 SV, H, 6.2 ip, 5 h, 5 k)...

BACON BITS, PT 2:

• *What a Relief!*: In the last 11 G, the 'Pigs bullpen has allowed just 7 ER in its last 38.2 ip (1-0, 1.63). Since the first series of the season (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has combined for a 2.59 ERA (212.0 ip, 61 er) in the past 65 G.

• *Getting Defensive?*: LHV is 2nd in the IL in fielding percentage (.981) and has turned an IL-best 81 double plays. The next closest team has just 72 (COL).

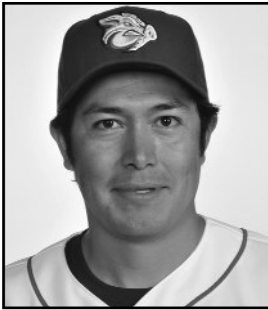
