TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (34-37) play Game Two of a four-game series against the West's second-place Indianapolis Indians (33-37)-- Pittsburgh's top affiliate. With a 6-3 win last night, the 'Pigs have won nine of their last 10 games and 11 of the last 13 affairs. Lehigh Valley has started 1-0 on this season-long 11-game, 11-day homestand... Indy had its mini two-game win streak snapped, and the Indians have now dropped six of their last nine contests after a season-high four-game winning streak, June 9-13... *First-Pitch is 7:05 p.m. for Superhero Cap Giveaway, presented by Air Products.*

With a Wln Tonight, the 'Pigs Will:

- Guarantee a season-series victory against Indianapolis (LHV won the '08 series, 5-3) -- the 2nd team they will have done this against... Durham earlier became the first team that LHV has won back-to-back season-series against: 5-3 in 2008, '09.

With Last Night's Wln, the 'Pigs:

- The 'Pigs pulled into sole possession of 4th place (passing ROC) -- for just the second day in franchise history (LHV entered in 4th on 4/16/09). They've been tied for 4th place starting 4 other days in team history: 4/14-15; 4/17-18.
- Pulled to within 8.0 games of first in the North Division for the first time since a win on 5/6 -- 46 games ago.
- The 'Pigs are out-scoring their opponents overall during the season (313-310) for the first time in LHV history.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Gustavo Chacin** -- making his 5th start as an IronPig -- is a 5-11, 207-pound, 28-year-old lefty signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 4/6/09 (he had been released by Washington at the end of Spring Training). After undergoing surgery for a slight tear in his labrum on 8/29/07, the native of Maracaibo, VZ, spent 2008 battling injuries rehabbing for Toronto in Single-A Dunedin (1-7, 7.88 in 11 GS before a season-ending ACL tear). Chacin last pitched in MLB for Toronto in 2007, and went 25-15, 4.18 in a 4-year stint with the Jays. He made his ML debut 9/20/04 at NYY and became the 7th Jay to win his first start (7 ip, 3 er). In his rookie season of '05, Chacin went 13-9, 3.72 in 34 GS and led TOR with 121 SO. The 13 wins set a team rookie record for starting pitchers and he was AL Rookie of the Month twice (April: 2-1, 2.48 in 5 GS; and July: 5-0, 2.97 in 6 GS) and became the fastest Blue Jay to ever reach the 10-win plateau. Chacin emerged in MiLB in 2004, when he went 16-2, 2.86 in 25 with New Hampshire and was an Eastern League post-season All-Star. Originally signed by TOR as a non-drafted free agent 7/3/98, he worked hand-and-hand with fragrance experts to concoct *Chacin Cologne* for a team promotion.

- GC started in Reading (1-0, 3.21, 2 G, 1 GS): *winning his lone 5/23 @ ALT (5 ip, er) -- his first win since 6/4/08 @ FTM.*
- GC has turned in back-to-back QS: 2-0, 3.75 (12 ip, 10 h, 5 r, 5 er, bb, 8, 0 xbh) -- *starting w/ 3 perfect IP in both*
- GC, 6/3 @ IND (W, 4-1): *n/d, 4 ip, 3 h, 1 r, 1 er, 4 bb, 1 k LO 1B in first would later score on BB; stranded 6 in 4 IP; left tied 1-1*
- GC, 6/19 @ NOR (W, 8-6): *W, 6 ip, 5 h, 3 r, 3 er, 1 bb, 2 k Ret'd first 9 BF; Up 5-0, allowed R in 4th; LO BB led to 2-R 6th*

RHP **Brad Lincoln** -- making his Triple-A debut tonight after being promoted earlier today-- is a 6-0, 215-pound, 24-year-old selected by Pittsburgh with the fourth overall pick in the 1st round of 2006 out of University of Houston. After missing the entire 2007 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery (4/3/07), the native of Lake Jackson, TX, started his 2008 season in mid-May with Low-A Hickory and went 5-5, 4.65 in 11 GS before being promoted to Advanced-A Lynchburg in mid-July -- finishing 1-5, 4.75 in 8 GS. He ended 2007 with a 3.71 ERA in his final 5 GS. *He entered the 2009 season ranked as the No. 4 Prospect in the system by Baseball America.*

- BL started in Double-A Altoona, going 1-5, 2.28 ERA in 13 GS (75.0 ip, 63 h, 22 r, 19 er, 18 bb, 65 k, .228).
- BL lost his last start, 7-0, on 6/18 vs. NBR: L, 5.1 ip, 4 h, 2 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 2 k. He finished 0-2, 4.36 (10.1/5) last 2 GS.

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

In the last 10 G (9-1), LHV is batting .288 (101-351) and .330 (33-100) w/ RISP... averaging 7.4 R/G... The 'Pigs have scored 74 R in these 10 G after scoring just 76 R in the previous 21 G (5/23-6/13)... After not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 6 of their last 94 innings (12 G).

- *Scoring in Bunches!* Last 10 G, LHV has scored multiple R in 19 of past 87 (22%) innings -- after doing so 19x in prev. 22 G.

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Now that's Quality!* Minus the rain-shortened Kendrick start Mon., LHV has QS in 6 straight games: 4-1, 1.85 (39/8).
- *Hey, June:* LHV is tied for 2nd with SYR for most wins in the month (14; LOU has 15) and is 3rd in AVG (.270) & ERA (3.07).

LHV leads the season series, 4-1, taking the first series at Victory Field 6/2-6/5... LHV won the '08 season series, 5-3.

QUEST FOR .500:

The 'Pigs have never been at .500 in franchise history... On 5/11, they lost 9-2 in a chance to get to 15-15, and are career 0-6 with a chance to get to .500+... The Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't been .500 since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07.

TRACY NAMED BATTER OF THE WEEK (AGAIN):

Today, 1B **Andy Tracy** has been named I.L. Batter of the Week for the period from June 15-21. LHV won all 6 G in which Tracy played, giving the team its first ever 6-win road trip. Tracy hit .381-3-10 for the week, leading the I.L. with 10 RBI and 9 runs scored. He finished 2nd in the circuit in home runs (3), on-base percentage (.533), slugging percentage (.952), and extra-base hits (6). *Tracy -- the only 'Pigs player to ever win I.L. Batter of the Week honors, has now done so 3 times in his LHV career. He was honored 6/23-6/29/08 (.520-2-6) and again 8/4-8/10/08 (.526-4-8, 3 2B)...*

THE MIGHTY TRACY:

Friday 6/19, 1B **Andy Tracy** had an historical night for Lehigh Valley (3-3, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 4 R, 2 BB, SB). He: **[1]** Set a franchise record for R with 4 R (prev. 3 done 19 times). **[2]** Tied a franchise record with 5 RBI (set by Tracy 5/16 vs. NOR; tied by David Newhan 6/16 @ DUR). **[3]** Tied a franchise record with 2 HR in a game (done 5 times, four by Tracy once by Brennan King 6/3/08 @ IND). **[4]** Tied his franchise record with 9 TB in a game (set 8/7/08 @ ROC).

• Tracy has hit in 10 of his last 12 G (16-41, .390-4-15, 6 2B) & in 13 of his last 16 G (20-55, .364-4-18).

• Seven of Tracy's 13 HR have put LHV ahead in a game... and 5 were game-winners (4/17, 4/19, 6/2, 6/16, 6/19).

HEY JUNE: Tracy is batting .319-5-20 (23-72, 7 2B, 15 BB) in 21 G in June... Last season, he hit .446-4-18 (11 2B, 16 BB) in 25 G... *Since 2003, Tracy is batting .340-36-124 in 141 G in June (174-512, 43 2B, 3B, 121 R, 90 BB).*

BACK IN CERVICE:

Since returning from the D.L., **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 9 of 13 games, batting .300-2-13 (15-50, 3 2B) -- and LHV is 11-2! He missed 23 G after being placed on the D.L. on 5/18 with a right wrist fracture suffered on a HBP by RHP Tommy Hanson. Cervenak is also batting .342-3-26 (41-120, 18 R) in his last 31 G and has reached safely in 44 of 48 G in 2009.

BOWERS POWERS:

LHP **Cedric Bowers** has allowed just 1 R in his last 14 G (1-0, 0.47, 2 SV, 7 holds, 19.1 IP, 8 h, 1 er, 18 k). He had an 11.0 scoreless IP streak snapped 6/8 @ LOU (1 ip, 1 r, 1 er)... But during the impressive streak, he'd been unscored upon in his first 8 G -- during which opposing batters were 0-29! The run scored after a one-out 3B by **Drew Sutton** which snapped a string of Bowers not allowing an extra basehit in a span of 16+ G, 20.2 IP & 66 AB. It was just the 3rd extra basehit that Bowers had allowed in his first since 4/19... he's allowed just 4 xbh in 2009.

THAT'S HOW THEY DREW IT UP!:

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 5-1 with a 1.76 ERA in 7 G, 6 GS with Lehigh Valley (46.0 ip, 9 er, 31 k)... Amazingly, Carpenter has taken a shutout into the 8th inning in 3 of his last 6 G -- and into the 7th in another. On 6/16, he set a franchise-record by winning his 6th straight decision (Brian Mazzone, 5, 2008). *The 'Pigs are 9-4 when he starts**. His win in his lone ML appearance '09 was in G2 of a DH vs. the Nats (4.1 ip*, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k); credited with a win due to Rule 10.17 (b) (2).

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

1B **Andy Tracy** (see above)... 2B **J.J. Furmaniak** has hit in his last 8 G (12-28, .429-1-5, 6 R) & in 14 of last 19 G (19-59, .322-1-10)... OF **Rich Thompson** has a 9-G hit streak (13-37, .351, 4 R)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit in his last 5 G (6-18, .333, 3 RBI, 2 2B, 5 R) & in 13 of his last 17 GS (18-58, .310-1-6, 5 2B)... C **Lou Marson** has hit in 4 of 5 G since coming off the D.L. (6-18, .333-0-5) and in 8 of his last 10 G (13-36, .361-0-2, 3 2B, 5 m-h G)... OF **Jason Ellison** has hit in 4 of his last 5 G (7-21, .333-1-5) and has hit in 18 of his last 24 G (28-96, .292-3-12, 6 2B, 9 BB)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in 7 of 10 G since his promotion to LHV (14-41, .341, 2B, 11 R)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

In his last 6 GS, RHP **Kyle Kendrick** is 2-1, 3.34 (32.1 ip, 12 er, 5 QS) -- taking a SHO into the 6th in 3 GS... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 14 of last his 17 relief ap's (3-0, 1.69, 26.2 ip, 5 er)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has allowed just 2 ER in his last 11 G (SV, 1.06, 17.0 IP) with LHV. He was unscored upon in his last 4 G with REA (4.2 ip, h)... RHP **Steven Register** has not allowed a R in 5 of his last 6 G (0-0, 2.35, SV, 7.2 ip, 8 h, 2 er, 4 k)... RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** has won back-to-back quality starts, going 2-0, 0.64 (14 ip, 12 h, 3 r, er, 2 bb, 11 k)... RHP **Carlos Carrasco** has won 3 of his last 4 GS -- going 3-1, 4.74 (24.2 ip, 13 er). He's also had quality starts in 5 of his last 7 GS, going 3-3, 4.06 (44.1 ip, 20 er) in these last 7 GS -- lowering from 6.62 ERA.

BACON BITS, PT 2:

• *In a Pinch!*: LHV pinch-hitters are now 7-22 (.318) with 5 BB, HBP (.464 OBP)...

• *What a Relief!*: In the last 11 G, the 'Pigs bullpen has allowed just 7 ER in its last 38.2 ip (1-0, 1.63). Since the first series of the season (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has combined for a 2.59 ERA (212.0 ip, 61 er) in the past 65 G.

• *Getting Defensive?*: LHV is 2nd in the IL in fielding percentage (.981) and has turned an IL-best 81 double plays. The next closest team has just 72 (COL).

• *What Happened to SWB?*: Since starting 23-5 (5/8), they've gone just 18-23 -- and the 'Pigs have now gained 1.5 game in the standings during that period... The Yankees started 11-0 and then 14-1.
