TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (35-38) play the finale of a four-game series against the West's second-place Indianapolis Indians (34-38)-- Pittsburgh's top affiliate. With a 5-4 win last night, the 'Pigs have now won 10 of their last 12 games and are 12-3 in their last 15 affairs. Lehigh Valley has started 2-1 on this season-long 11-game, 11-day homestand... Even with the loss, Indy has now won three of its last five games and has gone 8-7 its last 15 contests... Next up for the 'Pigs are the Norfolk Tides, against whom the IronPigs won three-of-four at Harbor Park, 6/19-6/22.

* First-Pitch is scheduled for 7:05 p.m. for Friday Night Fireworks, presented by **The Crayola Factory**.

With a Win Last Night, the 'Pigs:

- Clinched a season-series victory against Indianapolis for back-to-back seasons (LHV won the '08 series, 5-3). Earlier this season, Durham became the first team that LHV won back-to-back season-series against: 5-3 in 2008 and '09.
- Pulled to within 7.0 games of first place in the North for the first time since 5/1 (when they were 10-11 after 21 G).

With a Win Tonight, the 'Pigs Will:

- Have won four consecutive series for the first time in franchise history (3-1 vs. CHA, 4-0 @ DUR, 3-1 @ NOR).
- Have their winningest month in franchise history with 16 wins in June (they won 15 in May, June and July of 2008).

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** -- the youngest IronPig -- is a 6-3, 215-pound 22-year-old signed by Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela on 10/25/03 (at age 16 for \$300,000). A member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster, Carrasco flourished in his Triple-A debut with the 'Pigs after his promotion on 8/2/08 -- going 2-2 with a 1.72 ERA in six starts. He started last season in Double-A Reading, going 7-7 with a 4.32 ERA in 20 G, 19 GS (114.2 ip, 109 h, 58 r, 55 er, 45 bb, 109 k, .254) -- starting out 4-4, 3.10 in his first 10 GS (through 5/25); but going just 3-3, 5.70 in his last 10 games with the R-Phils. In 2007, Carrasco was a Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Clearwater prior to a 6/20 promotion to Reading -- where he threw a rain-shortened 6-inning no-hitter 8/21/07 vs. Altoona (2 bb, 8 k). In 2006, Carrasco captured the Paul Owens Award, awarded to the top pitcher in the PHI system, while helping guide Lakewood to a SAL Championship. Carrasco has also been named to the World Team of the All-Star Futures game each of the last 3 seasons and was the starting and winning pitcher (1.0 ip, 2 k) in '08 at Yankee Stadium on 7/13.

- Carrasco is rated as the #2 Prospect in the system by Baseball America behind Dominic Brown (he was #1 in '08).
- Carrasco started his IL career by going 2-3, 1.94 (55.2 ip, 12 er, 2 wins blown by pen) in his first 11 GS (2008-09).
- Last 10 GS*: 3-6, 6.08 (60.2 ip, 73 h, 41 er, 21 bb, 57 k); First 3 GS of '09: 0-1, 2.37 ERA (19 ip, 14 h, 5 er, bb).
- CC, 6/4 @ IND-1 (W, 4-2): W, 6.1 ip, 3 h, 2 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 5 k After LO BB in 2nd, ret'd 13 in row before 2-out BB in 6th & 3B broke SHO
- CC, 6/20 @ NOR (W, 5-3): W, 7 ip, 5 h, r, er, 2 bb, 5 k Duel w/ Pauley; stranded 4 in 4 IP until 2-out RBI-1B in 5th broke 0-0; left up 5-1

*TURNING THE CORNER: **Carlos Carrasco** has won 3 of his last 4 GS -- going 3-1, 4.74 (24.2 ip, 13 er). He's also had quality starts in 5 of his last 7 GS, going 3-3, 4.06 (44.1 ip, 20 er) in these last 7 GS -- lowering ERA from 6.62.

RHP **Jeremy Powell** -- making his 6th start of the season -- is a 6-5, 215-pound, 32-year-old righty signed by Pittsburgh as a minor-league free agent 1/7/09 -- after he had spent the previous eight seasons pitching in the Japanese Central League (69-65, 3.97 in 173 G, 150 GS). He spent last season with the Fukoka Softbank Hawks, going 2-6, 5.29 in 12 GS. Originally drafted by Montreal in the 4th round of 1994 out of Highlands (CA) H.S., the La Miranda native made it to the ML in 1998 with the Expos -- losing his ML debut 7/23/98 at CHI-N despite allowing just one run in six innings. He earned his first ML win 8/6/98 vs. LAA. In all, he has gone 5-16, 5.84 in 35 G, 27 GS in MLB. One highlight was an eight-inning shutout 8/9/00 vs. SD.

- JP lost his last start 2-1 on 6/8 @ BUF (6 ip, 2 er) but is 0-1. 1.89 in his last 4 G (2 GS). He's 0-2 as a stater.
- JP, 6/2 vs. LHV (L, 4-1): n/d, 5 ip, 5 h, 1 r, 1 er, 0 bb, 3 k Ret'd 11 of 13 before 3 straight 2-out H led to R in 4th; ret'd last 4; left 1-1
- Last outing, JP came in relief inning in the 2nd inning of a 4-3 loss 6/19 @ SWB: n/d, 5 ip, 3 h, r, er, 2 bb, 3 k.

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- One-derful?: LHV has won its 3rd straight one-run game (1st time in '09) after dropping 8 of the last 9 such games.
- What a Relief!: The LHV pen hasn't allowed a R in its last 8.1 IP (2+ G) and is now 2-0, 1.38 (45.2 ip, 7 er) in the last 12 G. Since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.56 ERA (228.1 ip, 65 er) in past 69 G.

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the season series, 5-2, taking the first series at Victory Field 6/2-6/5... LHV won the '08 season series, 5-3.

QUEST FOR .500:

The 'Pigs have never been at .500 in franchise history... On 5/11, they lost 9-2 in a chance to get to 15-15, and are career 0-6 with a chance to get to .500+... The Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't been .500 since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07.

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

In the last 12 G (10-2), LHV is batting .275 (114-414) and .308 (37-120) w/ RISP... averaging 6.7 R/G... The 'Pigs have scored 80 R in these 12 G after scoring just 81 R in the previous 22 G (5/22-6/13)...

• *Scoring in Bunches:* Last the 12 G, LHV has scored multiple R in 20 of past 104 (19%) innings -- after doing so 20x in prev. 23 G (5/21-6/13). After not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 6 of their last 112 innings (14 G).

TRACY NAMED BATTER OF THE WEEK (AGAIN):

Today, 1B **Andy Tracy** has been named I.L. Batter of the Week for the period from June 15-21. LHV won all 6 G in which Tracy played, giving the team its first ever 6-win road trip. Tracy hit .381-3-10 for the week, leading the I.L. with 10 RBI and 9 runs scored. He finished 2nd in the circuit in home runs (3), on-base percentage (.533), slugging percentage (.952), and extra-base hits (6). *Tracy -- the only 'Pigs player to ever win I.L. Batter of the Week honors, has now done so 3 times in his LHV career. He was honored 6/23-6/29/08 (.520-2-6) and again 8/4-8/10/08 (.526-4-8, 3 2B)...*

THE MIGHTY TRACY: MR. JUNE?:

1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 11 of his last 14 G (18-47, .383-4-16, 7 2B, 17 R) & in 14 of his last 18 G (22-61, .361-4-19)... Seven of Tracy's 13 HR have put LHV ahead in a game... and 5 were game-winners (4/17, 4/19, 6/2, 6/16, 6/19).

MR. JUNE: In 21 G in June, AT is batting .321-5-21 (25-78, 8 2B, 21 R, 16 BB)... Last season, he hit .446-4-18 (11 2B, 16 BB) in 25 G... *Since 2003, AT is batting .341-36-125 in 142 G in June (176-516, 44 2B, 3B, 124 R, 90 BB).*

BOWERS POWERS:

LHP **Cedric Bowers** has allowed just 1 R in his last 14 G (1-0, 0.47, 2 SV, 7 holds, 19.1 IP, 8 h, 1 er, 18 k). He had an 11.0 scoreless IP streak snapped 6/8 @ LOU (1 ip, 1 r, 1 er)... But during the impressive streak, he'd been unscored upon in his first 8 G -- during which opposing batters were 0-29! The run scored after a one-out 3B by **Drew Sutton** which snapped a string of Bowers not allowing an extra basehit in a span of 16+ G, 20.2 IP & 66 AB. It was just the 3rd extra basehit that Bowers had allowed in his first since 4/19... he's allowed just 4 xbh in 2009.

THAT'S HOW THEY DREW IT UP!:

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 5-1 with a 1.76 ERA in 7 G, 6 GS with Lehigh Valley (46.0 ip, 9 er, 31 k)... Amazingly, Carpenter has taken a shutout into the 8th inning in 3 of his last 6 G -- and into the 7th in another. On 6/16, he set a franchise-record by winning his 6th straight decision (Brian Mazzone, 5, 2008). The 'Pigs are 9-4 when he starts*. His win in his lone ML appearance '09 was in G2 of a DH vs. the Nats (4.1 ip*, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k); credited with a win due to Rule 10.17 (b) (2).

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

1B **Andy Tracy** (see above)... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in 10 of 11 G (14-43, .326, 5 BB, 5 R)... 2B **J.J. Furmaniak** has hit in 9 of his last 10 G (13-34, .382-1-6, 6 R) & in 15 of last 21 (20-65, .308-1-11)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit in his last 6 G (7-22, .318, 3 RBI, 2 2B, 5 R) & in 14 of his last 18 GS (19-62, .306-1-6, 5 2B)... C **Lou Marson** has hit in 5 of 6 G since coming off the D.L. (8-21, .381-0-6) and in 9 of his last 11 G (15-39, .384-0-10, 3 2B, 6 m-h G)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in 7 of 10 GS since his promotion to LHV (14-41, .341, 2B, 11 R)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** has won back-to-back quality starts, going 2-0, 0.64 (14 ip, 12 h, 3 r, er, 2 bb, 11 k)... In his last 7 GS, RHP **Kyle Kendrick** is 2-1, 3.76 (38.1 ip, 16 er, 5 QS) -- taking a SHO into the 6th in 3 GS... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 15 of last his 18 relief ap's (4-0, 1.57, 28.2 ip, 5 er)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has allowed just 2 ER in his last 12 G (SV, 0.95, 19.0 IP) with LHV. He was unscored upon in his last 4 G with REA (4.2 ip, h)... RHP **Steven Register** has not allowed a R in 6 of his last 7 G (0-0, 2.08, 2 SV, 8.2 ip, 9 h, 2 er, 4 k)... LHP **Sergio Escalona** has allowed 1 R in his last 4 G with LHV (0-0, 1.35 ERA, 2 SV, H, 6.2 ip, 5 h, 5 k)...

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- LHV has held sole possession of 4th place for last 3 days (6/24-pres.) -- and now 4 days in franchise history (4/16/09).
- *Hey, June:* LHV is 3rd for most wins (15) this month (LOU, 17; SYR, 16) & is 4th in ERA (3.15) and T-6th in AVG (.265).
- *For Starters...:* In the last 9 G, LHV starters have gone 4-2, 3.04 ERA (50.1 ip, 17 er) with 6 quality starts.
- The 'Pigs are back ahead in total runs w/ their opponents for the season (319-318); first 4 days LHV wasn't behind.
- *Cervice with a Smile?:* The 'Pigs have gone 12-3 since the return of **Mike Cervenak** off the DL; LHV went 9-14 w/o him.
- *In a Pinch!:* LHV pinch-hitters are now 7-26 (.269) with 5 BB, HBP (.406 OBP)...
- *Getting Defensive?:* LHV is 2nd in the IL in fielding percentage (.980) and has turned an IL-best 85 double plays. The next closest team has just 77 (COL).
- *What Happened to SWB?:* Since starting 23-5 (5/8), they've gone just 18-25 -- and the 'Pigs have now gained 2.5 game in the standings during that period... The Yankees started 11-0 and then 14-1.

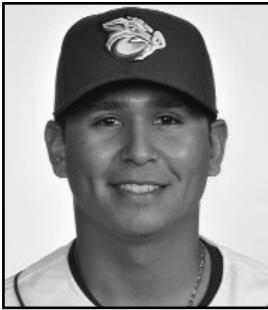
