TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (21-30) play Game Two of a four-game series against the third-place Indianapolis Indians (23-28) -- the Pittsburgh Pirates top affiliate. With a 4-1 win last night, the 'Pigs have now won four straight road games and have started 1-0 on this eight-game West Division road trip. Still, Lehigh Valley is just 7-15 in its last 22 games... The Indians have now dropped three consecutive contests and are just 2-6 in their last eight affairs. Like the 'Pigs, Indy has not yet been to .500 in 2009 -- going 0-4 in such opportunities.... First-Pitch is scheduled at 1:00 p.m.

• *Road Warriors?*: The 'Pigs have tied a franchise record by winning 4-straight road games for the first time since 7/27-7/30/08 (2 G @ RIC; 2 G @ NOR). They'd previously lost six in a row on the road. Today, they will try to make it five consecutive on the road for the first time by a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate since SWB won 5 straight 8/9/05-8/17/05.

TODAY'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** -- the youngest IronPig -- is a 6-3, 215-pound 22-year-old signed by Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela on 10/25/03 (at age 16 for \$300,000). A member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster, Carrasco flourished in his Triple-A debut with the 'Pigs after his promotion on 8/2/08 -- going 2-2 with a 1.72 ERA in six starts. He started last season in Double-A Reading, going 7-7 with a 4.32 ERA in 20 G, 19 GS (114.2 ip, 109 h, 58 r, 55 er, 45 bb, 109 k, .254) -- starting out 4-4, 3.10 in his first 10 GS (through 5/25); but going just 3-3, 5.70 in his last 10 games with the R-Phils. In 2007, Carrasco was a Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Clearwater prior to a 6/20 promotion to Reading -- where he threw a rain-shortened 6-inning no-hitter 8/21/07 vs. Altoona (2 bb, 8 k). In 2006, Carrasco captured the Paul Owens Award, awarded to the top pitcher in the PHI system, while helping guide Lakewood to a SAL Championship. Carrasco has also been named to the World Team of the All-Star Futures game each of the last 3 seasons and was the starting and winning pitcher (1.0 ip, 2 k) in '08 at Yankee Stadium on 7/13.

- Carrasco is rated as the #2 Prospect in the system by Baseball America behind Dominic Brown (he was #1 in '08).
- Carrasco started his IL career by going 2-3, 1.94 (55.2 ip, 12 er, 2 wins blown by pen) in his first 11 GS (2008-09).
- Last 7 GS*: 0-5, 5.91 (32.0 ip, 38 h, 21 er, 12 bb, 35 k); First 3 GS of 2009: 0-1, 2.37 ERA (19 ip, 14 h, 5 er)
- * Even so, CC has turned in 3 consecutive QS (0-2, 3.20, 19.2 ip, 7 er). He hasn't won since 8/29/08 vs. SYR.
- CC, 5/29 vs. ROC (L, 5-3): n/d, 7 ip, 6 h, 2 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 6 k 2-RHR in 1st (Huber); W/ 2-on, 0-out in 2nd, ret'd 16 of last 21; left up 3-2

RHP **Daniel McCutchen**, 26, is a 6-2, 214-pound righty acquired via trade by Pittsburgh along with OF Jose Tabata, RHP Jeff Karstens and RHP Ross Ohlendorf from the New York Yankees for OF Xavier Nady and LHP Damaso Marte on 7/27/08. Originally drafted by NYY in the 13 round of 2006 out of Oklahoma University (where he led the Big 12 in K his senior year), McCutchen started 2008 in Double-A Trenton (4-3, 2.55 in 9 GS) before a 5/21/08 promotion to SWB (4-6, 3.58 in 11 GS). After his trade to the Pirates, the Oklahoma native was assigned to Indy -- where he finished 3-3, 4.69 in 8 GS. In all, he went 7-9, 4.03 in 19 GS in the I.L. last season. In 2007, he was promoted to Trenton on 8/1/07 and wound up earning wins in both of his postseason starts for the EL Champion Thunder. The 2007 Florida State League All-Star entered the season rated as the No. 9 Prospect in the system by Baseball America.

- DM faced LHV once last season, a 6-5 win 7/17 @ LHV (his last G with SWB): W, 5.1 ip, 4 h, 4 er, bb, 7 k, 2 hr.
- DM was fortunate to win his last start 14-7 on 5/29 vs. PAW: W, 5.0 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, bb, 4 k, hr (McAnulty).

TRANSACTIONS, INJURIES & SUCH:

Yesterday, LHP **Antonio Bastardo** had his contract purchased by Philadelphia (won his ML debut @ SD: 6 ip, 4 h, r, er, bb, 5 k) and RHP **Mike Koplove** exercised an out in his contract and was granted his release. The 'Pigs added LHP **Gustavo Chacin** (n/d, 4 ip, 3 h, r, er, 4 bb, k) was promoted from Reading, as was RHP **Francisco Butto** (1-1, 2.13, 2 SV in 10 G); OF **John Mayberry** was optioned to LHV (.222-1-3 in 3 G with PHI)... SS **Jason Donald** (hamstring) missed his 7th consecutive game last night and OF **Rich Thompson** (back) did not start for the 7th G in a row, but did PH (K)...

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Comeback*: The 'Pigs erased an early deficit to come-from-behind to win -- for the first time in 24 G since 5/8 (G #27).
- *Getting Offensive*: In their last 7 G, the 'Pigs have 5 double-digit hit totals and are batting .292 (69-236) with 8 HR.
- *Bowers Powers!*: LHP **Cedric Bowers** has a 9.2 scoreless IP streak over 7 G (5 holds) w/o allowing a hit in span (0-26).
- *The Mighty Tracy!*: 1B **Andy Tracy**'s 6th inning HR proved the game-winner... 5 of his 9 HR have put LHV ahead.

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the season series, 1-0... LHV won the '08 season series, 5-3 -- but split at Victory Field, 2-2, from 6/3-6/6/08.

GETTIN' MIGGY WITH IT!

INF **Miguel Cairo** has now hit in 11 of 12 G (.396-2-9) since joining LHV -- and has now hit 2 HR in his last 19 AB (had 2 HR in a span of 7 AB) after going 850 AB without one! On 5/28 @ BUF, he hit his first HR since 7/28/05, when he hit on as a Met in Minute Maid Park against RHP Chad Qualls)... In the Majors, he's gone 813 ABs since that HR, which, according to the Elias Sports Bureau, is the longest active homerless streak in the Majors Leagues.

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF **Pablo Ozuna**, who had a '09 LHV high 13-G hitting streak 5/3-5/18, has 3 m-h G in his last 4 G (6-15, 4 2B, 3 R) and has hit safely in 21 of his last 27 G (33-98, .337-0-6, 16 R)... INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit safely in 11 of his first 12 G with LHV (19-48, .396-2-9)... OF **Jason Ellison** has hit safely in his last 7 G (10-30, .333, 3 2B)... OF **Jeremy Slayden** hit safely in 8 of his last 10 G (10-37, .270-1-6, 2 2B)... 3B **David Newhan** has a 7-game RBI streak and has hit in 16 of his last 20 G (23-66, .348-4-12, 9 BB)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit safely in 5 of his last 7 GS (8-24, .333-1-3, 2 2B)... Prior to his promotion to PHI, OF **John Mayberry** had hit safely in 11 of his last 12 G (15-48, .313-2-6). And, in his last 28 G, is batting .301-6-21 (31-103, 8 2B, 9 BB)... OF **Rich Thompson** is 11-12 in SB (92%) and is now 36-39 (92%) in LHV career... After starting the first 35 games without an error at SS, INF **Jason Donald** committed his first 2 errors 5/24. He started errorless in his first 174 chances. He still leads all IL shortstops in fielding PCT.

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Mike Koplove** left the club after allowing just 2 ER in his last 19 G (1-2, 0.84, 6 SV, 2 H, 21.1 ip, 13 h, 7 r, 10 bb, 28 k)... RHP **Tyler Walker** had his season-starting 13.0 scoreless IP streak snapped in his 9th appearance on 5/29 vs. ROC. Still, he's been unscored upon in 9 of his 10 G (14.2 ip, 6 h, 3 er, 2 bb, 16 k)... LHP **Cedrick Bowers** has a 9.2 scoreless IP streak (7 G, 5 holds) in which he has not allowed a hit (0-26)! Also, he has only allowed just 1 R in his last 10 G (0-1, 0.66, 5 H, 13.2 ip, 3 h, er, 11 bb, 11 k)... In his last 4 G, LHP **Jake Woods** is 1-0, 0.93 (1 gs, 9.2 ip, 7 h, r, er). He's now gone unscored upon in 12 of last his 14 relief ap's (3-0, 1.61, 22.1 ip, 4 er)... Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ WAS, RHP **Drew Carpenter** is 2-0, 0.89 in 3 G, 2 GS with LHV (20.1 ip, 17 h, 2 r, 2 er, 12 k)...

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Getting Better Starts:* LHV starters have "quality starts" in 11 of the last 16 G -- going 5-4, 3.27 ERA (88.0 ip, 32 er)... In the prev. 10 G, LHV starters had just 2 QS -- going 1-6, 8.57, .351 (49.1, 74 h, 50 r, 47 er, 12 hr, 211 ab).
- *Getting Defensive:* LHV is 2nd in the IL in fielding percentage (.981) and the 'Pigs have now turned an IL-best 60 double plays. The next closest teams have just 51.
- *Dropping the Clutch?:* In the last 16 G (7-9), the 'Pigs are batting just .179 (25-140) w/ RISP.
- *Northern Exposure:* The 'Pigs are now 14-16 vs. the North Division and are now 36-74 (.327) in franchise history.
- *Not the Pace Game :(*: Despite the fair start (14-15 in 29 G), the LHV's on pace to go 58-86... they finished 55-89 in '08
- *Out of Cervice:* The IronPigs are 15-29 (.341) when INF **Mike Cervenak** has been out of the lineup in 2008-09.
- *Lead Story?:* The 'Pigs have now blown leads in 50% of their losses (15 of 30). If they hung on in 1/2* those, they'd be 29-22. They've now blown an *IL-high 4 G leading after 8 innings*... Ten teams have either 0 or just 1 (TOL has 3).
- *Close Calls:* Sixteen of the last 20 (80%) games have been decided by 1-3 R -- and three other 3 Gs were by 4.
- *Close Calls, Pt 2:* Eleven of the 'Pigs last 13 wins are by 3 or fewer runs -- 9 of those 12 wins are by just 1 or 2 R.
- *Same 'ole Saturday Night?:* The 'Pigs are now 0-8 on Saturday nights; 0-7 wearing the Saturday alternate jerseys.
- *One is the Loneliest...:* The 'Pigs are 1-6 in their last 7 one-run games; but the 2-1 win Tues. snapped a 6-G skid.
- In his last 7 GS, **Carlos Carrasco** is 0-5, 5.91 (32.0 ip, 38 h, 21 er, 12 bb, 35 k); First 3 G: 0-1, 2.37 (19 ip, 14 h, 5 er).
- *In a Pinch!:* LHV pinch-hitters are 6-16 (.375) with 2 BB, HBP (.474 OBP)...

PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

Since the first series of 2009, the 'Pigs pen is 7-11, 2.57 with 9 SV in 47 G (164.1 ip, 47 er)... The corps had an **amazing run** over a span of 12 G (4/18-5/1) in which it allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41), retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%... At one point, they had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

1,500 MILESTONE:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31 (20-29), 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his **1,500th career MiLB win** since starting his managerial career in 1986. He is currently the 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 90-144 (.385) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 109-181 (.376) & a combined 68.0 GB.

• The 'Pigs spent the first 5 days of the '09 season in last place... after spending the first 70 days of '08 in last. To start franchise history, they were in the cellar for 130 of their first 158 days... but been out since April 15, 2009.

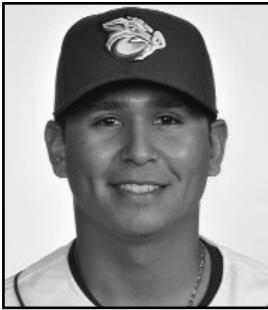
