TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (38-39) play the finale of a four-game series against the Norfolk Tides (42-34)-- Baltimore's top affiliate. With a 6-1 loss last night, the 'Pigs had their four-game winning streak snapped and fell back below .500. Even so, they have now won 13 of their last 16 games and are 15-4 in their last 19 affairs. Lehigh Valley is started 5-2 on this season-long 11-day, 11-game homestand... Norfolk previously split a four-game series versus Pawtucket -- snapping a string of four-consecutive series losses. Still, the Tides have dropped seven of their last 11 games and are 6-14 in their last 20. In addition, they're 8-19 (month of June) since they were a season-best 34-15 on May 31...

- *First-Pitch is 7:05 p.m. for Team Card Set, presented by Verizon Wireless... The 'Pigs next have a day off Wednesday before welcoming in the Syracuse Chiefs for three games in two days (day-night DH on Friday)...*
- *Southern Comfort:* The 'Pigs are now 14-9 vs. the South -- and 33-22 (.600) in its history (only winning record).

With a Win Tonight, the 'Pigs Will:

- Get back to .500 -- after getting there 6/28 for the first time in LHV history (220 G)... and for the first time for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07 -- span of 318 G (2 years, 1 month and 3 days). They had gone 0-4 in four opportunities this season [last: 5/11 @ TOL (L, 9-2) for a chance to get to 15-15] and were 0-6 in history.
- Clinch the series against Norfolk and have 5 consecutive series for the first time in franchise history (3-1 vs. CHA, 4-0 @ DUR, 3-1 @ NOR, 3-1 vs. IND) and for the first time by a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate since the SWB Red Barons won 5 straight series 5/25/04-6/14/04 (3-1 @ COL, 3-1 vs. IND, 3-1 vs. LOU, 4-0 @ IND, 2-1 @ LOU).

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Kyle Kendrick** -- a member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster with 1.110 years of ML service time -- is a 6-3, 190-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 7th-round of 2003 out of Mt. Vernon (WA) HS -- turning down a scholarship to play QB at Washington State to sign with the Phillies. Kendrick was initially promoted from Reading (AA) straight to the Majors on 6/13/07 -- and became a key cog in the Phils' run to capture the N.L. East. He went 10-4, 3.87 in 20 starts, leading all N.L. rookies in wins and ranking 3rd in ERA. Kendrick started 2008 right where he left off -- going 8-3, 4.47 in 19 starts before the All-Star Break. However, he struggled thereafter -- finishing just 3-6, 7.59 in his next 11 GS before being left off the Phils' postseason rosters. In all, he is 21-13, 4.78 in 51 G, 50 GS w/ PHI.

- *KK earned the 'W' in the first-ever game at CCP -- a 5-3 PHI victory over LHV in exhibition 3/30/08 (5 ip, 0 r).*
- *KK's lost his lone appearance with PHI in relief 6/12 vs. BOS (2 ip, 4 h, 3 r, 3 er, bb). Entered 2-2 in 12th.*
- *In his last 7 GS, KK's has 5 quality starts, going 2-1, 3.76 (38.1 ip, 16 er) -- taking a SHO into the 6th in 3 GS.*
- *KK, 6/25 vs. IND (W, 5-4): n/d, 6 ip, 5 h, 4 r, 4 er, 3 bb, 3 k Up 4-0, LO BB led to 2-R 4th; 2 solo HR in 6th (Jones, Myron); left 4-4*

RHP **David Pauley** -- who just turned 26 on 6/17 -- is a 6-2, 170-pound righty acquired by Baltimore from Boston for RHP Randor Bierd on 1/20/09 (had been designated to make room for John Smoltz). The native of Longmont, CO, was originally selected by SD in the 8th round of 2001 out of Longmont H.S. -- and then was acquired by Boston with OF Jay Payton, INF Ramon Vazquez and cash consideration from SD for OF Dave Roberts, 12/20/04. Pauley spent most of 2008 in Pawtucket, going 14-4, 3.55 in 25 GS and had two stints in Boston, where he went 0-1, 11.68 in 6 G, 2 GS. He made his ML debut 5/31/06 at TOR (David Wells injury) and went 0-2, 7.88 in 3 GS with the Red Sox.

- *DP was a 7-4 loser last start, 6/25 vs. PAW: L, 5 ip, 10 h, 7 r, 7 er, 2 bb, k, 2 hr (Carter, McNulty); 0-2, 7.50 last 2 GS*

TRANSACTIONS:

LHP **Sergio Escalona** was again promoted to Philadelphia today (5th stint)... Former 'Pigs All-Star LHP **Brian Mazone** was acquired in a trade with LAD and assigned to LHV. Mazone, who opened the year on the D.L. until 5/2, was 0-1, 8.44 in 13 G, 0 GS with Albuquerque. He was transferred to Ogden roster 6/13-6/23, then back on D.L. (rt. calf).

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Refuse 2 Lose:* LHV has not lost back-2-back games since they were swept in four 6/6-6/9 @ LOU (span of 19 G).
- The Grand Slam hit by NOR's **Melvin Dorta** in the 5th was the first allowed by LHV in 2009 and just the 2nd in franchise history (first: 5/16/08 vs. NOR, OF **Chris Roberson** off RHP **Matt Childers** in 9th; 178 games ago).

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the season series, 5-2, after taking the series in NOR, 6/19-22... LHV won '08 series, 5-3 (3-1 at CCP).

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

In the last 16 G (13-3), LHV is batting .272 (147-540) and .311 (47-151) w/ RISP... averaging 6.1 R/G... The 'Pigs have scored 98 R in these 16 G after scoring just 97 R in the previous 28 G (5/15-6/13)...

• *Scoring in Bunches!*: Last the 16 G, LHV has scored multiple R in 24 of past 137 (18%) innings -- after doing so 25x in prev. 29 G (5/15-6/13). After not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 9 of their last 145 innings (18 G).

PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT IS!:

The LHV bullpen hasn't allowed a R in its last **17.0 IP** (6+ G) and is now 2-0, 1.14 (55.1 ip, 7 er) in the last 16 G. Since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.46 ERA (238.0 ip, 65 er) in past 73 G.

THAT'S HOW THEY DREW IT UP!:

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 6-1 with a 1.50 ERA in 8 G, 7 GS with Lehigh Valley (54.0 ip, 9 er, 38 k)... Amazingly, Carpenter has taken a shutout into the 8th inning in 4 of his last 7 G -- and into the 7th in another. On 6/16, he set a franchise-record by winning his 6th straight decision (Brian Mazzone, 5, 2008). *The 'Pigs are 10-4 when he starts**. His win in his lone ML appearance '09 was in G2 of a DH vs. the Nats (4.1 ip*, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k); credited with a win due to Rule 10.17 (b) (2).

THE MIGHTY TRACY... MR. JUNE!:

1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 14 of his last 18 G (22-61, .361-5-19, 9 2B, 21 R) & in 17 of his last 22 G (26-75, .347-5-22)... Seven of Tracy's 14 HR have put LHV ahead in a game... and 5 were game-winners (4/17, 4/19, 6/2, 6/16, 6/19).

MR. JUNE: In 27 G in June, AT is batting .315-6-24 (29-92, 10 2B, 25 R, 18 BB)... Last season, he hit .446-4-18 (11 2B, 16 BB) in 25 G... *Since 2003, AT is batting .340-37-128 in 146 G in June (180-530, 46 2B, 3B, 128 R, 92 BB).*

BOWERS POWERS:

LHP **Cedric Bowers** -- who now has a 10.1 scoreless IP streak -- has allowed just 1 R in his last 16 G (1-0, 0.42, 2 SV, 7 holds, 21.1 IP, 10 h, 1 er, 20 k). He also had an 11.0 scoreless IP streak 5/17-6/7, going unscored upon in his first 8 G -- during which opposing batters were 0-29! The R scored after a 3B by **Drew Sutton** which snapped a string of Bowers not allowing an extra basehit in a span of 16+ G (20.2 IP; 66 AB since 4/19). He's allowed just 4 xbh in '09.

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

1B **Andy Tracy** (see above)... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in 12 of 14 G (17-54, .315, 7 BB, 6 R)... 2B **J.J. Furmaniak** has hit in 11 of his last 14 G (15-47, .319-1-8, 8 R) & in 17 of last 25 (22-78, .282-1-13)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit in 6 of last 7 G (7-25, .280, 4 RBI, 2 2B, 5 R) & in 14 of his last 19 GS (19-65, .292-1-7, 5 2B)... C **Lou Marson** has hit in 7 of 9 G since coming off the D.L. (11-31, .355-0-8) and in 11 of his last 14 G (18-49, .367-0-12, 3 2B, 7 m-h G)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in 9 of 12 GS since his promotion to LHV (18-49, .367, 2B, 14 R)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** is 3-0, 0.86 (21 ip, 19 h, 4 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 14 k) in his last 3 GS... In his last 7 GS, RHP **Kyle Kendrick** is 2-1, 3.76 (38.1 ip, 16 er, 5 QS) -- taking a SHO into the 6th in 3 GS... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 16 of last his 19 relief ap's (4-0, 1.47, 30.2 ip, 5 er)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has allowed just 2 ER in his last 13 G (SV, 0.90, 20.0 IP) with LHV. He was unscored upon in his last 4 G with REA (4.2 ip, h)... RHP **Steven Register** has not allowed a R in 7 of his last 8 G (0-0, 1.86, 2 SV, 9.2 ip, 9 h, 2 er, 4 k)... LHP Brian Mazzone was unscored upon in his last 5 G with ALB (6.0 ip, 6 h, 1 bb, 6 k)...

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- LHV has held sole possession of 4th place for last 7 days (6/24-pres.) -- and now 8 days in franchise history (4/16/09).
- *Hey, June*: LHV is now tied for 2nd with 18 wins this month (LOU, 19) & is 2nd in ERA (2.79) and 6th in AVG (.265).
- *For Starters...*: In the last 13 G, LHV starters have gone 7-3, 2.34 ERA (76.2 ip, 20 er) with 9 quality starts.
- *Hot Rod & Co.*: RHP **Rodrigo Lopez**, who is 3-0, 0.86 (21 ip, 19 h, 4 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 14 k) in his last 3 GS, has become the 3rd LHV starter this month to tie the franchise record for most consecutive starts won (3, set by **Brian Mazzone** 4/25-5/6/08)... RHP **Carlos Carrasco** has won 3 straight (6/15-present) and RHP **Drew Carpenter** (6/5-6/16/09)...
- *Turning the Corner*: RHP **Carlos Carrasco** has won 4 of his last 5 GS -- going 4-1, 4.06 (31.0 ip, 14 er). He's also had quality starts in 6 of his last 8 GS, going 4-3, 3.73 (50.2 ip, 21 er) in these last 87 GS -- lowering ERA from 6.62.
- *Difference a Year Makes*: LHV is now 10.0 G better from this point last season (28-49) & is on pace to finish 72-72.
- LHV now has a season-series victory against both Norfolk and Indy for back-to-back seasons. Earlier this season, Durham became the first team that LHV won back-to-back season-series against: 6-2 in '08; 5-3 in '09.
- *One-derful?*: LHV has won three straight one-run game (1st time in '09) after dropping 8 of the last 9 such games.
- The 'Pigs are back ahead in total runs w/ their opponents for the season (337-326); first 8 days LHV wasn't behind.
- *Cervice with a Smile?*: The 'Pigs have gone 15-4 since the return of **Mike Cervenk** off the DL; LHV went 9-14 w/o him.
- *In a Pinch!*: LHV pinch-hitters are now 7-26 (.269) with 5 BB, HBP (.406 OBP)...
- *Getting Defensive?*: LHV again leads the IL in fielding percentage (.981) and has turned an IL-best 88 double plays. The next closest team has just 79 (COL).
- *What Happened to SWB?*: Since starting 23-5 (5/8), they've gone just 21-25 -- and the 'Pigs have now gained 1.0 game in the standings during that period... The Yankees started 11-0 and then 14-1.
