TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (23-32) play Game Two of a four-game series against the second-place Louisville Bats (27-28) -- the Cincinnati Reds top affiliate. With a tough 5-4 loss last night, the 'Pigs are now 3-2 on this eight-game West Division road trip. Still, Lehigh Valley is just 9-17 in its last 26 games... Louisville had now won five of hits last six contests and have a chance to get back to .500 for the first time since May 16 (18-18). Even so, the Bats have managed just a 9-14 record after starting 18-14 through May 12... First-Pitch tonight is at 6:15 p.m...

• *One is the Loneliest...* The 'Pigs are now 1-8 in their last 9 one-run games (had a 6-G losing streak during span).

ROAD WARRIORS:

The 'Pigs have won six of their last eight road games -- which featured a franchise record five-game road winning streak 5/26-6/4 (passing their previous record of four set 7/27-7/30/08). They'd previously lost six in a row on the road. *The last time a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate won five consecutive on the road was SWB from 8/9/05-8/17/05.*

• With a win tonight, LHV win insure at least a .500 trip. They had two winning road trips in 2008 (5-3 in both).

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP Gustavo Chacin -- making his 2nd start as an IronPig -- is a 5-11, 207-pound, 28-year-old lefty signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 4/6/09 (he had been released by Washington at the end of Spring Training). The native of Maracaibo, VZ, spent 2008 battling injuries rehabbing for Toronto in Single-A Dunedin (1-7, 7.88 in 11 GS) -- after undergoing surgery for a slight tear in his labrum on 8/29/07. Chacin last pitched in MLB for Toronto in 2007, and went 25-15, 4.18 in a 4-year stint with the Jays. He made his ML debut 9/20/04 at NYY and became the 7th Jay to win his first start (7 ip, 3 er). In his rookie season of '05, Chacin went 13-9, 3.72 in 34 GS and led TOR with 121 SO. The 13 wins set a team rookie record for starting pitchers and he was AL Rookie of the Month twice (April: 2-1, 2.48 in 5 GS; and July: 5-0, 2.97 in 6 GS) and became the fastest Blue Jay to ever reach the 10-win plateau. Chacin emerged in MiLB in 2004, when he went 16-2, 2.86 in 25 with New Hampshire and was an Eastern League post-season All-Star. Originally signed by TOR as a non-drafted free agent 7/3/98, he worked hand-and-hand with fragrance experts to concoct *Chacin Cologne* for a team promotion.

• GC started his season with 2 appearances in Reading (1-0, 3.21, 1 GS).
 • GC won his lone start w/ REA 5/23 @ ALT: W, 5.0 ip, 4 h, r, er, bb, 3 k -- his first win since 6/4/08 @ Fort Myers.
 • GC, 6/3 @ IND (W, 4-1): n/d, 4 ip, 3 h, 1 r, 1 er, 4 bb, 1 k LO 1B in first would later score on BB; stranded 6 in 4 IP; left tied 1-1

RHP Homer Bailey -- a member of the Reds' 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-4, 205-pound, 23-year-old right-hander selected by Cincinnati in the first round (7th overall) of 2004 out of La Grange (TX) HS. Entering the 2008 season as the No. 2 prospect in the Reds System (behind Jay Bruce) by *Baseball America*, Bailey spent most of last year with Louisville (4-7, 4.77 in 19 GS) -- and won Game Two of the IL Playoffs versus Durham, 19-3 (snapping a 21-start winless drought between LOU and CIN). Bailey had two stints with Cincinnati, going 0-6, 7.93 in 8 GS in two stints from 6/5-6/17 and 7/13-8/9. While up, he only received 1.75 R/G of support and was the victim of two blown saves. The Texan made his ML debut 6/8/07 vs. CLE (W, 5 ip, 5 h, 2 er, 4 bb, 3 k) -- becoming the youngest Red to debut as a starter since Milt Wilcox on 9/5/70 and the first Reds starter to win in his debut since Larry Leubbers on 7/9/93. He started the season in LOU (6-3, 3.07 in 12 GS) before his promotion to CiN, where he went 4-2, 5.76 in 9 GS -- and had wins blown in 3 of his 9 GS. The 2006 Florida State League All-Star led La Grange HS to state baseball titles in 2001 & 2004.

• Bailey vs. LHV in 2009: 0-1, 6.23 ERA in 2 GS (8.2 ip, 9 h, 6 r, 6 er, 2 bb, 9 k, .265)
 • HB made one start with CIN on 5/23/09 vs. CLE, starting a 7-6 loss: n/d, 4.1 ip, 3 h, 6 r, 6 er, 6 bb, 3 k, hr (DeRosa).
 • HB has turned in 3 straight QS, going 2-1, 1.80 (20 ip, 4 er). Since his first 2 GS of '09, he's 5-3, 2.63 in 8 GS.
 • Bailey was again sharp in his last start, starting a 6-0 shutout his 6/2 @ PAW: W, 8.0 ip, 4 h, 0 r, 2 bb, 8 k.

SERIES INFORMATION:

LOU leads the season series, 1-0... LOU won the '08 series, 5-3 -- winning 3-1 at Louisville Slugger Field (5/30-6/2).

BACON BITS, PT 1:

• *Lead Story?*: The 'Pigs blew a pair of 3 run leads in a 5-4 loss last night and have now blown leads in 50% of their losses (16 of 32). If they hung on in 1/2 of those games, they'd be 31-24. They lead the IL with 7 losses when leading after 5 innings & they've also blown an IL-high 4 G leading after 8... Ten teams have either 0 or just 1 (TOL has 3).

GETTIN 'MIGGY WITH IT!

INF **Miguel Cairo** has now hit in 15 of 16 G (.359-2-9) since joining LHV. On 5/28 @ BUF, he hit his first HR since 7/28/05, when he hit on as a Met in Minute Maid Park against RHP Chad Qualls... After going 850 AB without one a home run, he hit two in a span of 7 AB (connected again 5/30 vs. ROC). In the Majors, he's gone 813 ABs since that HR, which, according to the Elias Sports Bureau, is the longest active homerless streak in the Majors Leagues.

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit safely in the last 10 G (15-40, .375-2-6, 10 R) and in 15 of his first 16 G with LHV (23-64, .359-2-9)... OF **John Mayberry** has hit safely in his last 8 G (10-28, .357, 3 2B) and in 15 of his last 17 G (20-62, .323-2-7, 5 2B). In his last 32 G, he's batting .310-6-22 (36-116, 10 2B, 10 BB)... INF **Pablo Ozuna**, who had a '09 LHV high 13-G hitting streak 5/3-5/18, has hit safely in 23 of his last 30 G (35-105, .333-0-6, 17 R)... OF **Jason Ellison** has hit safely in 8 of his last 10 G (13-41, .317-2-6, 3 2B)... 3B **David Newhan** had an 8-game RBI streak snapped 6/4, but has at least 1 RBI in 9 of last 11 G. In his last 20 G, he's batting .313-4-13 (21-67, 9 BB)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit safely in 5 of his last 7 GS (8-24, .333-1-3, 2 2B)... OF **Jeremy Slayden** hit safely in 8 of his last 10 G (10-37, .270-1-6, 2 2B)... OF **Rich Thompson** is 12-13 in SB (92%) and is now 37-40 (93%) in LHV career... After starting the first 35 games without an error at SS, INF **Jason Donald** committed his first 2 errors 5/24. He started errorless in his first 174 chances. He still leads all IL shortstops in fielding PCT.

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ WAS, RHP **Drew Carpenter** is 3-0, 0.66 in 4 G, 3 GS with LHV (27.1 ip, 20 h, 2 r, 2 er, 18 k)...LHP **Cedrick Bowers** has a 10.2 scoreless IP streak (8 G, 6 holds) in which he has not allowed a hit (0-29)! Also, he has only allowed just 1 R in his last 11 G (0-1, 0.61, 6 H, 14.2 ip, 3 h, er, 12 bb, 12 k)... RHP **Tyler Walker** had his season-starting 13.0 scoreless IP streak snapped in his 9th appearance on 5/29 vs. ROC. Still, he's been unscored upon in 11 of his 12 G (1.65, 16.1 ip, 7 h, 3 er, 3 bb, 18 k)... In his last 4 G, LHP **Jake Woods** is 1-0, 0.93 (1 gs, 9.2 ip, 7 h, r, er). He's now gone unscored upon in 12 of last his 14 relief ap's (3-0, 1.61, 22.1 ip, 4 er)... RHP **Carlos Carrasco** earned his 1st win of '09 in GS #11 (first since 8/29/08 vs. SYR). Even with the lack of wins, Carrasco has now turned in 4 consecutive QS (1-2, 3.12, 26.0 ip, 9 er).

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *What Happened to SWB?:* Since starting 23-5 (5/8), they've gone just 10-18.... They started 11-0 and then 14-1.
- *Same 'ole Saturday Night?:* The 'Pigs are now 0-9 on Saturdays; 0-7 wearing the Saturday alternate jerseys.
- *All that Starts Well:* LHV starters have "quality starts" in 14 of the last 20 G -- going 7-4, 2.93 ERA (113.2 ip, 37 er)...
- *Getting Offensive:* In their last 11 G, the 'Pigs have 6 double-digit hit totals and are batting .271 (97-358) with 8 HR.
- *Getting Defensive:* LHV still leads IL in fielding percentage (.982) and the 'Pigs have now turned an IL-best 64 double plays. The next closest team has just 55 (Norfolk).
- The 3-0 shutout 6/5 was the 3rd for LHV -- but the first since LOU's Justin Lehr won 3-0 on 5/5 vs. BUF-G1 (30 G ago).
- The 1-0 shutout in G2 Thursday marked the 3rd time LHV was blanked -- the first since 4/29 @ SWB (35 G ago).
- *Extra Special?:* The 'Pigs fell to just 1-6 in extra-inning games this season. The first 6 G were all at home (1-5).
- *Dropping the Clutch?:* In the last 19 G (8-11), the 'Pigs are batting just .206 (34-165) w/ RISP.
- *Out of Cervice:* The IronPigs are 17-31 (.354) when INF **Mike Cervenak** has been out of the lineup in 2008-09.
- *Not the Pace Game :* (: Despite the fair start (14-15 in 29 G), the LHV's on pace to go 60-84... they finished 55-89 in '08
- *Close Calls:* Twelve of the 'Pigs last 14 wins are by 3 or fewer runs -- 10 of those 12 wins are by just 1 or 2 R.
- *Northern Exposure:* The 'Pigs are now 14-16 vs. the North Division and are now 36-74 (.327) in franchise history.
- *In a Pinch!:* LHV pinch-hitters are 6-17 (.353) with 3 BB, HBP (.476 OBP)...

PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

Since the first series of '09, the 'Pigs pen has a 2.62 ERA with 11 SV in 51 G (171.2 ip, 50 er)... The corps had an **amazing run** over a span of 12 G (4/18-5/1) in which it allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41), retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%... At one point, they had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

1,500 MILESTONE:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31 (20-29), 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. He is currently the 3rd most amongst all active managers behind (1) Round Rock's Marc Bombard [entered season with 1,709] and (2) Orem's Tom Kotchman [entered with 1,542]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by Stan Wasiak 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 92-146 (.387) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 111-183 (.378) & a combined 67.0 GB.

• The 'Pigs spent the first 5 days of the '09 season in last place... after spending the first 70 days of '08 in last. To start franchise history, they were in the cellar for 130 of their first 158 days... but been out since April 15, 2009.

CAN'T GET TO .500!:

The 'Pigs have never been at .500 in franchise history... They lost 9-2 in a chance to get to 15-15 on Monday, and are now 0-6 with a chance to get to .500+... The Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't been .500 since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07.
