## TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (43-46) play the finale of a two-game road series against the fourth-place Rochester Red Wings (43-44) -- Minnesota's top affiliate. With a 7-5 win last night, the 'Pigs have won three of their last four games. Although having dropped seven of its last 12 games, Lehigh Valley is still 20-11 in its last 31 affairs... The Wings, who previously took a four-game series at Syracuse, 3-1, are 10-6 in their last 16 games. *First-Pitch is scheduled at 1:35 p.m.*

- The IL will now head into the All-Star Break; the 'Pigs next host the Wings in a four-game series starting Thursday.
- *Road Warriors:* The 'Pigs have won 10 of their last 14 road games... and are now 22-20 overall on the road in '09.

### With a win today, the IronPigs will:

- Sweep just their second series in franchise history (first: 6/15-6/18/09 @ DUR)... and their 1st against a ND rival.

## TODAY'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** -- the youngest IronPig -- is a 6-3, 215-pound 22-year-old signed by Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela on 10/25/03 (at age 16 for \$300,000). A member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster, Carrasco flourished in his Triple-A debut with the 'Pigs after his promotion on 8/2/08 -- going 2-2, 1.72 in 6 GS. He started last season in Double-A Reading, going 7-7, 4.32 in 20 G, 19 GS -- starting out 4-4, 3.10 in his first 10 GS (through 5/25); but going just 3-3, 5.70 in his last 10 with the R-Phils. In '07, Carrasco was a Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Clearwater prior to a 6/20 promotion to Reading -- where he threw a rain-shortened 6-inning no-hitter 8/21/07 vs. Altoona (2 bb, 8 k). In '06, Carrasco captured the Paul Owens Award, awarded to the top pitcher in the system, while helping guide Lakewood to a SAL Championship. Carrasco was named to the World Team of the All-Star Futures game 3 times (2006-08) and was the starting and winning pitcher (1.0 ip, 2 k) in '08 at Yankee Stadium on 7/13.

- Carrasco is rated as the #2 Prospect in the system by Baseball America behind Dominic Brown (he was #1 in '08).
- Carrasco started his IL career by going 2-3, 1.94 (55.2 ip, 12 er, 2 wins blown by pen) in his first 11 GS (2008-09).
- CC set a franchise record winning 4 straight GS (4-0, 2.46) from 6/15-7/2 -- passing the record set by Brian Mazone (4/25-5/6/08) and since tied by RHP Drew Carpenter (6/5-6/16/09) and RHP Rodrigo Lopez (6/18-Present).
- Last 8 GS: 5-2, 4.29 (48.1 ip, 23 er), lowering ERA from 5.40... He'd been 0-6, 7.25 (36/29) in prev. 7 GS (4/21-5/24).
- CC, 5/29 vs. ROC (L, 5-3): n/d, 7 ip, 6 h, 2 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 2 k 2-R HR in 1st (Huber); W/ 2-on, 0-out in 2nd, ret'd 16 of last 21; left up 3-2
- CC, 7/7 vs. PAW (L, 6-2): L, 4 ip, 3 h, 6 r, 6 er, 6 bb, 5 k 2 BB led to R in 2nd; 3 LO BB in 4th led to 3 R w/ 0 H, KO'd 2-R 2B in 5th

RHP **Reid Santos**, 26, is a 6-1, 170-pound lefty who was claimed off waivers from Toronto in at the start of Spring Training 2009. The native of Kaneohe, HI, was originally drafted by Cleveland in the 13th round of 2002 out Saddleback College (Mission Viejo, CA) and was part of the Tribe's system until being claimed off waivers by the Blue Jays on 9/23/08. Santos started 2008 in Buffalo, going 2-2, 7.20 in 16 G, 0 GS, before being assigned to Double-A Akron -- where he finished 2-1, 3.78 and 2 SV in 29 G, 0 GS. In 2007, Santos spent the year in Akron -- where he was named an Eastern League mid-season All-Star -- and finished 8-3, 2.72 in 39 G, 10 GS. He also posted a 2.08 ERA (8.2 ip, 2 er) in four EL playoff games... Santos was the 2004 Appalachian League Co-Pitcher of the Year while pitching for Burlington.

- RS, 6/1 @ LHV (W, 6-3): n/d, 3.1 ip, 6 h, r, er, 2 bb, 2 k Up 1-0, LO 1B in 2nd led to R; left game up 2-1 with 2-on in 4th; stranded 5
- RS won his last start 7-1 on 7/7 @ SYR: W, 5.0 ip, 2 h, 0 r, 4 bb, 4 k (first start since LHV after 6 relief app's).

## SERIES INFORMATION:

ROC leads the season series, 3-2 (took series 5/29-6/1 at CCP)... ROC won the 2008 series, 11-5 -- winning the last 4 G of the series and also sweeping the last meeting at Frontier Field 8/6-8/7/08 (3 games).

## BACON BITS, PT. 1:

- *Comeback!*: By erasing a 4-run deficit LN, the 'Pigs tied their largest comeback in LHV history (5/14/08 vs. NOR; 5/1 vs. TOL) -- their largest ever on the road... Thursday, LHV had its 16th comeback win of '09 -- just their 2nd when trailing after 7 inn.
- *Isn't it Grand?:* J.J. Furmaniak's GS was LHV's 3rd of 2009 (Newhan, Ellison). LHV had just 1 in '08 (Jon Knott).

## GOING BATTY...AGAIN!:

The 'Pigs have scored 29 R in their last 4 G, batting .315 (46-146), averaging 7.3 R/G... Previously, the 'Pigs had only scored 17 R in the prev. 9 G (1.9 R/G). During the 9-game span (2-7), LHV batted .230 (71-300) with 1 HR.

### NORTHERN EXPOSURE:

LHV is in Game 12 of 16 straight against division rivals, going 5-6 so far... LHV plays the ND in 50 of the final 66 G (inc. 10 against division-leading SWB). The 'Pigs are 19-22 (.463) against the North in '09 after faring just 22-58 (.275) in '08.

### KYLE KAN!:

RHP **Kyle Kendrick** has turned in Quality Starts in 8 of his last 10 GS -- and really 8 of 9 since one was a 0.1 IP rain-shortened start 6/22 @ NOR. In these last 10 G, Kendrick is 3-2, 3.07 with a CG (61.2 ip, 22 r, 21 er). He has taken a SHO into the 6th in 5 of the starts.

### DAILY REGISTER:

RHP **Steven Register** has been unscored upon in his last 7 G -- and has a 10.0 scoreless IP streak (2 SV). He also has held opponents scoreless in 11 of his last 12 G (0-0, 1.15, 15.2 ip, 2 er). He started his LHV career allowing at least one run in 3 of his first 5 G (0-2, 7.11).

### BOWERS POWERS:

LHP **Cedric Bowers** now has a 14.1 scoreless IP streak, going 1-0, 4 SV, H in 10+ G -- just 0.1 IP from tying RHP Drew Carpenter's 2009 LHV high (team record is 28.2 by LHP Les Walrond, 7/11-7/29). Bowers has also allowed just 1 R in his last 19 G (1-0, 0.36, 4 SV, 7 holds, 25.1 IP, 11 h, 1 er, 25 k) -- which featured an 11.0 scoreless IP streak 5/17-6/7, going unscored upon in his first 8 G -- during which opposing batters were 0-29! The R scored after a 3B by **Drew Sutton** which snapped a string of Bowers not allowing an extra basehit in a span of 16+ G (20.2 IP; 66 AB since 4/19). He's allowed just 5 xbh in '09.

### WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit in his last 8 G (12-30, .400) and in 13 of his last 16 G (20-57, .351-0-7, 4 2B)... C **Lou Marson** has hit in 16 of 19 G since coming off the D.L. (28-67, .418-0-13) and in 20 of his last 24 G (35-85, .412-0-17, 4 2B, 13 m-h G) -- raising AVG from .202 to .302 since 6/4... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in 6 of his last 8 G (9-30, .300) and in 20 of 25 G (27-95, .284, 12 BB, 11 R)... OF **Jason Ellison** has hit in 7 of his last 8 G (10-35, .286-0-3)... 1B **Andy Tracy** is batting .296-6-22 (32-108, 10 2B, 25 R)... INF **Terry Tiffie** has hit in 6 of his last 7 G (10-29, .345-0-1)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in 11 of 16 GS since his promotion to LHV (20-64, .313, 2B, 15 R) -- Pigs 12-4 in those G...

### WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

Despite a being hit hard in a loss (4 ip, 6 er) last time out, RHP **Carlos Carrasco** remains 4-1, 3.94 (29.2 ip, 13 er) in his last 5 GS... Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 7-2 with a 1.89 ERA in 10 G, 9 GS with Lehigh Valley (66.2 ip, 14 er, 53 k)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 17 of last his 22 relief app's (5-0, 2.21, 36.2 ip, 9 er)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has allowed just 4 ER in his last 16 G (0-1, SV, 1.46, 24.2 IP) with LHV... LHP **Sergio Escalona** has allowed 1 ER in his last 8 G w/ LHV (0-0, 0.79, 2 SV, H, 11.1 ip, 3 r, 8 k)...

### PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT IS!:

The LHV Bullpen has thrown 36.2 IP in the last 10 G (roughly 3.2 IP per game). During the span, they've maintained a 2.70 ERA (11 er)... In its last 18 G, the LHV bullpen has allowed just 11 ER in hit last 56.2 IP (1.75 ERA) -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... Since June 14, the corps is now 3-2, 1.80 (95.0 ip, 18 er) in 27 G... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.46 ERA (277.2 ip, 76 er) in 85 G.

### BACON BITS, PT. 2:

- *For Starters...*: In the last 25 G, LHV starters are 11-8, 2.75 ERA (CG, 140.2 ip, 43 er) with 16 quality starts.
- *More Clutch Hits, More Runs*: In the last 28 G (18-10), is batting .295 (72-244) w/ RISP and averaging 5.1 R/G (143 R) after scoring just 104 R in the previous 30 G (5/14-6/13), averaging 3.5 R/G...
- *Scoring in Bunches!*: LHV scored 6 R in the 6th LN. In the last 29 G, LHV has scored multiple R in 34 innings...and after not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 13 times in their last 28 G.
- *Power Outage Over!*: Wednesday, 1B **Andy Tracy** snapped LHV's HR-draught at 74.1 innings... they now have 3 HR in their last 4 G (32.1 innings)... Still, over a longer stretch, LHV has hit just 3 HR in its last 106.2 innings.
- *Getting Defensive*: LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.981) and has turned an IL-best 100 double plays. The next closest team has just 94 (ROC)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.
- *What Happened to the Yankees?*: Since SWB started 23-5 (5/8), the Yanks have gone just 26-31 -- but LHV has gained just 1.5 G in the span. The Yankees started 11-0 and then 14-1.
- *Difference a Year Makes*: LHV is 8.0 G better from this point last season (35-54) & is on pace to finish 70-74.
- *After Six Glow?*: Friday, the 'Pigs lost their 1-0 lead in the Yanks' 3-R run 7th... it was their IL leading 8th loss (30-8) when leading after six innings (had been tied with Gwinnett at 7).
- *Scoreless Streak Snapped*: The SWB runs in the 7th LN snapped RHP **Kyle Kendrick's** scoreless streak at 16.0 IP -- an '09 LHV high. Prev., **Drew Carpenter** went 14.2 scoreless IP (6/5-6/11) and **Cedrick Bowers** is currently at 14.1 IP.

### FORTUNE .500?:

With a 6-1 win on June 28, the 'Pigs finally got to .500 (38-38) for the first time in 220 G (and only time ever)... and for the first time for a Phils' Triple-A affiliate since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07 -- span of 318 G (2 years, 1 month, 3 days)... LHV is now 1-6 in opportunities for .500 this season; 1-8 in franchise history... LHV has never been over .500.

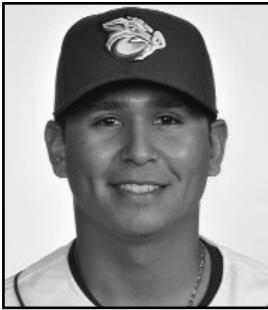
