TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (48-50) play Game One of a four-game series against the third-place Gwinnett Braves (54-45) -- the Braves' top affiliate. With a 4-3 win in Charlotte last night, the 'Pigs snapped a three-game skid to salvage the finale of a four-game series and are now 1-3 on this eight-game South Division roadtrip (outscored 20-7). Lehigh Valley is still 5-3 in its last eight games and, over a longer stretch, 25-15 (.625) since 6/11... The Braves enter with a season-high six-game winning streak (just swept Norfolk in four) and are 9-4 in their last 13 contests. In fact, since leaving Lehigh Valley 20-20 on May 19, they're 34-25 (.576). *First-pitch tonight is at 7:00 p.m. at new Gwinnett Stadium.*

• *Southern Comfort:* The 'Pigs are 15-13 vs. the South (8-4 on the road) -- and 34-26 (.567) in team history.

THANKFUL THURSDAY:

The 'Pigs snapped their 3-game losing streak and gained a game on the top 3 teams in the ND (SWB, SYR and ROC all lost) as well as a game on the Wild Card leader (DUR lost).

NOT SO 'GOOD CHARLOTTE':

The red hot 'Pigs were riding a four-game winning streak when they headed to Charlotte for a four-game series Monday-Thursday... and things cooled off quickly. It started with a 1-0 walk-off win Monday, followed by an 11-0 loss Tuesday -- tying the worst loss (largest margin of defeat) in franchise history. In doing so, the 'Pigs were shutout in back-to-back games for the first time in LHV history. This followed with a 5-3 loss on Wednesday prior to last night's 4-3 win.

• Lehigh Valley batted just .244 (33-135) in the series and averaged 1.8 R/G (7 R)... Prior to this three-game draught, the 'Pigs had scored 53 R in their previous 9 G, batting .295 (87-295), averaging 5.9 R/G.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** -- the youngest IronPig -- is a 6-3, 215-pound 22-year-old signed by Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela on 10/25/03 (at age 16 for \$300,000). A member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster, Carrasco flourished in his Triple-A debut with the 'Pigs after his promotion on 8/2/08 -- going 2-2, 1.72 in 6 GS. He started last season in Double-A Reading, going 7-7, 4.32 in 20 G, 19 GS -- starting out 4-4, 3.10 in his first 10 GS (through 5/25); but going just 3-3, 5.70 in his last 10 with the R-Phils. In '07, Carrasco was a Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Clearwater prior to a 6/20 promotion to Reading -- where he threw a rain-shortened 6-inning no-hitter 8/21/07 vs. Altoona (2 bb, 8 k). In '06, Carrasco captured the Paul Owens Award, awarded to the top pitcher in the system, while helping guide Lakewood to a SAL Championship. Carrasco was named to the World Team of the All-Star Futures game 3 times (2006-08) and was the starting and winning pitcher (1.0 ip, 2 k) in '08 at Yankee Stadium on 7/13.

- Carrasco is rated as the #2 Prospect in the system by Baseball America behind Dominic Brown (he was #1 in '08).
- Carrasco started his IL career by going 2-3, 1.94 (55.2 ip, 12 er, 2 wins blown by pen) in his first 11 GS (2008-09).
- CC set a franchise record winning 4 straight GS (4-0, 2.46) from 6/15-7/2 -- passing the record of 3 (3 others).
- Last 9 GS: 6-2, 4.31 (54.1 ip, 26 er), lowering ERA from 5.40... He'd been 0-6, 7.25 (36/29) in prev. 7 GS (4/21-5/24).
- CC, 5/17 vs. GWN (L, 3-2): L, 6 ip, 5 h, 3 r, 3 er, 3 bb, 7 k Up 2-0 w/ 0 hits thru 3 IP, first 4 BF to reach in 3-R 4th (1st QS in 5 GS)
- CC, 7/18 vs. ROC-2 (W, 6-3): W, 6 ip, 6 h, 3 r, 3 er, 0 bb, 8 k SHO into 6th, up 6-0, LO 1B led to b-2-b, 2-out HRs (Valencia, Winfree)

LHP **John Halama**, 37, is a 6-5, 215-pound left-hander from Brooklyn who had his contract purchased 6/13/09 by Atlanta from the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs (Ind.) in the Atlantic League -- he was 8-1, 2.05 in 9 GS. He also started 2008 with the Blue Crabs, going 4-1, 1.91 in 8 GS before being signed by Cleveland 6/5/08. With Buffalo last season, he went 8-6, 4.60 in 16 GS. Originally drafted by Houston in the 23rd round of 1994, Halama made his ML debut in 1998 with HOU. At midseason, he was sent to SEA along with Freddy Garcia and Carlos Guillen for Randy Johnson. He won a career-high 14 G with SEA in 2000 (14-9, 5.08 ERA in 30 GS). In nine ML seasons, Halama combined to go 56-48, 4.65 in 262 G, 119 GS with Houston (1998), Seattle (1999-02), Oakland (2003), Tampa Bay (2004), Boston (2005), Washington (2005), and Baltimore (2006). He also pitched for the Long Island Ducks (Ind.) in 2007 before being selected by the Blue Crabs in the 2008 expansion draft. In 2001, he threw one of only 8 perfect games in the history of the PCL.

GWN leads the season series, 3-1 (took series at CCP 5/16-19)... In '08, LHV and RIC (ATL affiliate) split the series, 4-4 -- with the away team going 3-1 in both sets. LHV earned its first franchise win 4/14/08 vs. RIC after starting 0-11.

TRANSACTIONS, PT 2:

Yesterday, RHP **Drew Carpenter** was recalled by Philadelphia and RHP **Tyler Walker** had his contract purchased again (LHP J.C. Romero and RHP Chad Durbin both placed on Phillies D.L.). The 'Pigs added back RHP **Patrick Overholt** from Reading (AA) where he was 0-0, 3.89 with 7 holds in 32 G. He appeared in 2 G with LHV in early July (0-0, 3.1 ip, 3 h, 1 r, 1 er, 3 bb, 3 k)... LHP **Sergio Escalona** was assigned to Reading.

.500 ALLERGY?:

It took 220 games for Lehigh Valley to get to .500 for the first time in franchise history -- which the 'Pigs did on 6/28/09 at 38-38 after a 6-1 win vs. NOR. But then they lost two-straight games and seven of their next nine... The 'Pigs then reeled off seven wins in their next nine contests to get back to .500 for just the second time in team history (7/19/09 at 47-47 after a 3-2 win vs. ROC) -- and have now since lost three of their last four affairs...

LOUIE, LOUIE!:

C **Lou Marson** has hit safely in 17 of his last 19 G (26-63, .413-0-7) and in 22 of 26 G (34-87, .391-0-15) since coming off the D.L. with a on 6/19 with a right ankle contusion. Since June 4, he's raised his AVG from .202 to .302 by hitting safely in 26 of his last 31 G (41-105, .390-0-19, 7 2B, 13 m-h G)...

KYLE KAN!:

RHP **Kyle Kendrick** has turned in Quality Starts in 9 of his last 12 GS -- and really 9 of 11 since one was a 0.1 IP rain-shortened start 6/22 @ NOR. In these last 12 G, Kendrick is 4-3, 3.27 with a CG (77.0 ip, 29 r, 28 er). He has taken a SHO into at least the 6th inning in 6 of the starts -- including 3 of his last 4 GS.

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF **David Newhan** has hit safely in 8 of his last 10 G (15-32, .469-1-5, 3 2B)... INF **Terry Tiffie** has hit in 8 of his last 10 G (13-40, .325) and in 12 of his last 15 G (19-60, .317-0-4)... OF **Mike Cervenak** has 7 multi-hit G in his last 11 G (16-47, .340-1-4, 4 2B, 3B)... INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit in 15 of his last 17 G (20-62, .323) and in 20 of his last 25 G (28-89, .315-0-9, 6 2B)... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in 9 of last 12 G (13-45, .289) & in 23 of 29 G (31-110, .282, 12 BB, 15 R)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in 13 of 19 GS since his promotion to LHV (23-75, .307, 16 R) -- and the 'Pigs are 13-6 in those games...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** is 5-1, 4.04 (42.1 ip, 19 er) in his last 7 GS... Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 8-2 with a 1.83 ERA in his last 11 G, 10 GS with LHV (73.2 ip, 15 er, 61 k)... RHP **Steven Register** has been unscored upon in 9 of his last 10 G (13 ip, 1 er; 1-0, 0.69, 4 SV) and in 13 of his last 15 G (1-0, 1.47, 18.2 ip, 3 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 19 of last his 24 relief app's (5-0, 2.11, 38.1 ip, 9 er)... In his last 18 G with LHV, RHP **Jason Anderson** in 0-1, 1.98 and a SV (27.1 ip, 6 er)...

RARE ROUGH STRETCH FOR BULLPEN:

In its last 11 G, the 'Pigs bullpen in 1-3, 5.33 (25.1 ip, 15 er)... Still, since June 14, the corps is now 4-4, 2.37 (114.0 ip, 30 er) in 37 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.67 ERA (296.2 ip, 88 er) in 94 G.

THIRD IS A CHARM?:

Until its loss Wednesday, Lehigh Valley took sole residence in 3rd place in the North for the first time in team history -- and for four days in all. With its doubleheader sweep of Rochester last Saturday, LHV passed both ROC and PAW to move into 3rd place. Previously, the 'Pigs had held sole possession of 4th place for 10 days (4/16; 6/24-7/2).

BACON BITS:

- *One-derful?:* After starting 6-12 in one-run games, LHV has now gone 6-3 in its last seven such contests.
- With the win last night, the 'Pigs avoided a 4-G losing streak (and being swept, for that matter) for the first time since being swept in a four-game series 6/6-6/9 @ LOU.
- *For Starters...:* In the last 34 G, LHV starters are 15-10, 3.18 ERA (CG, 195.0 ip, 69 er) with 22 quality starts.
- *Getting Defensive:* The 'Pigs have committed just 3 E in the last 14 G -- and have the lost total (66 in the I.L. by 3 E ahead of SWB). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.982) and has turned an IL-best 105 double plays. The next closest team has 103 (SYR)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.
- *Scoring in Bunches!:* In the last 38 G, LHV has now scored multiple R in 41 innings... and after not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 15 times in their last 37 G.
- *Power Back On!:* LHV has 4 HR in its last 7 G (56 innings)... they had just 3 in prev. 13 G (123.2 innings).
- Saturday marked LHV's first DH sweep of '09 and first since 6/11/08 vs. BUF. The 'Pigs are now 3-5 in DH games.
- *Closer by Committee:* LHV has had 3 different RPs earn saves in their last 4 (Register-2, Taschner, Majewski). In fact 10 of their last saves have been recorded by 6 RP (add Anderson, Bowers, Escalona). In all, 8 pitchers have combined for the team's 25 SV (add Koplove, Walker).
- *Difference a Year Makes:* LHV is 8.0 G better from this point last season (40-58) & is on pace to finish 71-73.

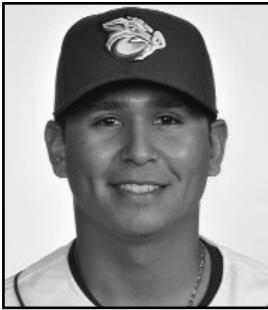
