TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (49-52) play the finale of a four-game series against the second-place Gwinnett Braves (56-46) -- the Braves' top affiliate. With a 5-1 loss yesterday, the 'Pigs have fallen to 2-5 on this eight-game South Division road trip. Lehigh Valley is still 6-5 in its last 11 games and, over a longer stretch, 26-17 (.605) since 6/11... The Braves have won eight of their last nine games and are 11-5 in their last 15 contests. In fact, since leaving Lehigh Valley 20-20 on May 19, they're 36-26 (.581). *First-pitch tonight is at 7:00 p.m.*

- Following the game, the 'Pigs return home for a four-game series vs. the Columbus Clippers starting Tuesday.
- *Last Laugh?*: The 'Pigs are just 12-16 in series finales... but have won their last two (vs. ROC, @ CHA).
- *Southern Comfort*: The 'Pigs are still 16-15 vs. the South (9-6 on the road) -- and 35-28 (.556) in team history.
- *Road Warriors?*: The 'Pigs are just 2-5 on this trip... but they'd previously been 10-5 in their 15 prior on the road.
- With SWB loss last night, the 'Pigs remain 7.5 GB in the North; with GWN's win, they're 6.5 GB of Wild Card.

With Last Night's Loss:

GWN clinched the season-series victory vs. LHV and LHV clinched a losing road trip... The 'Pigs now need a win tonight to avoid losing back-to-back four-game series for the first time since 5/16-5/24 (GWN, DUR) -- 18 series ago.

BAT-LANTA?:

After starting the road trip by batting just .244 (33-135) and averaging 1.8 R/G (7 R) in Charlotte, LHV is hitting .262 (28-107) and averaging 4.7 R/G (14 R) in the 3 G in Gwinnett... Prior to the trip, the 'Pigs had scored 53 R in their prev. 9 G, batting .295 (87-295), averaging 5.9 R/G... Still, the staff has a 5.46 ERA (59.1 ip, 36 er) in the 7 G.

THREE-PEAT?:

With ROC's win last night, LHV is back in a tie for third place with the Wings. The 'Pigs had regained sole possession of 3rd place in the North for the second time in team history on Saturday, 7/26 (they took residence for 4 days from 7/18-7/21)... Previously, the 'Pigs took their initial sole residence of 4th place for 10 days (4/16; 6/24-7/2).

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Tyson Brummett** -- making his Triple-A debut -- is a 6-0, 150-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 7th round of 2007 out of UCLA. The native of Columbus, MS, split 2008 between three levels -- starting at Low-A Lakewood (3-0, 1.95 in 6 GS), then on Advanced-A Clearwater on 5/1 (2-3, 3.59 in 8 GS) and then to Double-A Reading on 6/17 (2-9, 7.28 in 14 GS). Brummett also pitched in the Arizona Fall League after the season, going 0-2, 6.23 in 12 G, 1 GS. In his first year of pro ball (2007), he finished 5-5, 3.40 in 15 G, 12 GS in Low-A Lakewood.

- *TB started 2009 in Reading (AA), going 3-9, 4.86, SV in 24 G, 15 GS (96.1 ip, 112 h, 56 r, 52 er, 27 bb, 67 k, .296).*
- *TB hasn't won since 6/2 (0-4, SV in last 12 G, 4 GS)... In his AA career, he's a combined 5-18, 5.98 in 38 G, 29 GS.*
- *TB last appeared in relief 7/23 vs. ALT (2 ip, 2 h, 2 k). Last start was 7/11 @ HRB (L, 2 ip, 5 h, 5 er).*

LHP **Jo-Jo Reyes** -- a member of Atlanta's 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-2, 230-pound, 24-year-old southpaw drafted by Atlanta in the 2nd round of 2003 out of Riverside Poly (CA) H.S. The Covina, CA native started the season with Richmond (1-1, 2.31 in 8 GS) before making it back up to Atlanta (3-11, 5.81 in 23 G, 22 GS) -- but finished with a 7-G losing streak (12 GS, 7.81 ERA). Reyes had a stellar 2007 campaign that included an 11-G with the Atlanta Braves. The youngster opened the season with Mississippi (AA) and went 8-1, 3.56 in 13 GS prior to a promotion to Triple-A on 6/9. He made his ML debut on 7/7/07 vs. San Diego. In total, he went 2-2, 6.22 in 11 GS for the Braves. Following the season, he earned the Phil Niekro Award as ATL's Minor League Pitcher of the Year. In 2006, Reyes led all Braves Minor Leaguers with 12 wins and 142 K pitching in both Rome (A) and Myrtle Beach (High-A).

- *After one start for GWN, JR had a stint w/ Atlanta 4/18-5/20: 0-2, 7.00 in 6 G, 5 GS (27 ip, 27 h, 13 bb, 21 k, .262).*
- *JR has yet to notch a victory in 2009 and hasn't earned a W since 6/13/08 @ LAA (a span of 29 G, 27 GS).*
- *Last start, JR didn't go long enough for a W in a 8-2 win 7/22 vs. NOR: n/d, 4.0 ip, 5 h, 2 r, 2 er, bb, k, hr.*

SERIES INFORMATION:

GWN leads the season series, 5-2 (took series at CCP 5/16-19)... In '08, LHV and RIC (ATL affiliate) split the series, 4-4 -- with the away team going 3-1 in both sets. LHV earned its first franchise win 4/14/08 vs. RIC after starting 0-11.

YESTERDAY'S TRANSACTIONS:

RHP **Tyson Brummett** was promoted from Reading (AA), where he was 3-9, 4.86, SV in 24 G, 15 GS (96.1 ip, 112 h, 56 r, 52 er, 27 bb, 67 k, .296). He hadn't won since 6/2 (0-4, SV in 12 G, 4 GS)... Saturday, RHP **Kyle Kendrick** and RHP **Steven Register** were recalled by Philadelphia and RHP **Drew Carpenter** was optioned back to LHV.

.500 ALLERGY?:

It took 220 games for Lehigh Valley to get to .500 for the first time in franchise history -- which the 'Pigs did on 6/28/09 at 38-38 after a 6-1 win vs. NOR. But then they lost two-straight games and seven of their next nine... The 'Pigs then reeled off seven wins in their next nine contests to get back to .500 for just the second time in team history (7/19/09 at 47-47 after a 3-2 win vs. ROC) -- and have now since lost 5 of their last 7 affairs...

LOUIE, LOUIE!:

C **Lou Marson** has hit safely in 17 of his last 21 G (26-68, .382-0-9) and in 22 of 28 G (34-92, .370-0-17) since coming off the D.L. with a on 6/19 with a right ankle contusion. Since June 4, he's raised his AVG from .202 to .294 by hitting safely in 26 of his last 33 G (41-110, .373-0-21, 7 2B, 13 m-h G)...

KYLE KAN!:

RHP **Kyle Kendrick** has turned in Quality Starts in 9 of his last 12 GS -- and really 9 of 11 since one was a 0.1 IP rain-shortened start 6/22 @ NOR. In these last 12 G, Kendrick is 4-3, 3.27 with a CG (77.0 ip, 29 r, 28 er). He has taken a SHO into at least the 6th inning in 6 of the starts -- including 3 of his last 4 GS.

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **Michael Taylor** has hit in 6 of his last 7 G (8-25, .320-1-3, 5 R) since starting his Triple-A career 2-13... INF **David Newhan** has hit safely in 9 of his last 12 G (17-38, .447-1-6, 4 2B)... INF **Terry Tiffie** has hit in 11 of his last 13 G (18-52, .346) and in 15 of his last 18 G (24-72, .333-0-6)... OF **Mike Cervenak** has 8 multi-hit G in his last 14 G (21-61, .344-1-8, 4 2B, 3B)... INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit in 18 of his last 20 G (23-77, .299)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in 14 of 20 GS since his promotion to LHV (24-80, .300, 17 R) -- and the 'Pigs are 13-7 in those games...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** won 5 of his last 7 decisions, but has a 4.66 ERA (48.1 ip, 25 er) in these last 8 GS... Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 8-2 with a 1.83 ERA in his last 11 G, 10 GS with LHV (73.2 ip, 15 er, 61 k)... RHP **Steven Register** has been unscored upon in 9 of his last 10 G (13 ip, 1 er; 1-0, 0.69, 4 SV) and in 13 of his last 15 G (1-0, 1.47, 18.2 ip, 3 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 19 of last his 24 relief app's (5-0, 2.11, 38.1 ip, 9 er)... In his last 19 G with LHV, RHP **Jason Anderson** in 0-1, 1.84 and a SV (29.1 ip, 6 er)...

RARE ROUGH STRETCH FOR BULLPEN:

In its last 14 G, the 'Pigs bullpen in 2-3, 4.58 (37.1 ip, 19 er)... Still, since June 14, the corps is now 5-4, 2.43 (126.0 ip, 34 er) in 39 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.68 ERA (308.2 ip, 92 er) in 97 G.

BACON BITS:

- *Walks Hurt:* In this series, the two teams have combined to issue 28 BB (LHV 15, GWN 13) -- and 13 (46%) have scored! In fact, of the 16 frames in which either team has scored, there has been a BB in 12 of those 16 (75%).
- *Power Outage?:* In their last 23 G, LHV has just 7 HR in 207 innings (which inc. a 74.1-inning drought 6/30-7/8).
- *For Starters...:* In the last 36 G, LHV starters are 15-12, 3.53 ERA (CG, 209.0 ip, 82 er) with 22 quality starts.
- *Getting Defensive:* The 'Pigs have committed just 4 E in the last 17 G -- and have the lost total (67 in the I.L. by 5 E ahead of SWB). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.982) and has turned an IL 2nd-best 107 double plays. The leader has 108 (SYR)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.
- *Scoring in Bunches!:* In the last 41 G, LHV has now scored multiple R in 46 innings...and after not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 15 times in their last 40 G.
- *One-derful?:* After starting 6-12 in one-run games, LHV has now gone 6-3 in its last seven such contests.
- *Extra! Extra!:* LHV is now 4-7 in extra-innings games; but the 'Pigs are 3-1 in their last 4 after starting 1-6 in extras.
- *Closer by Committee:* LHV has had 3 different RPs earn saves in their last 4 (Register-2, Taschner, Majewski). In fact 10 of their last saves have been recorded by 6 RP (add Anderson, Bowers, Escalona). In all, 8 pitchers have combined for the team's 25 SV (add Koplove, Walker).
- *Difference a Year Makes:* LHV is 9.0 G better from this point last season (40-60) & is on pace to finish 71-73.

INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE, CARPENTER EMERGE VICTORIOUS IN TRIPLE-A ALL-STAR GAME:

IronPigs RHP **Drew Carpenter** had literally a perfect inning of relief as the I.L. defeated the P.C.L., 6-5, in the Triple-A All-Star Game at PGE Park in Portland, Ore., on 7/14. Carpenter entered in the 2nd inning and stuck out the heart of the PCL lineup (3-4-5 hitters) on exactly nine pitches. IronPigs 1B **Andy Tracy** started at DH and batted third (0-2, K) and INF **Mike Cervenak** started at 3B and batted sixth (0-3).

TAYLOR MADE:

OF **Michael Taylor** was promoted from Reading (AA) to LHV last Thursday. The 6-6, 260-pound Eastern League All-Star was batting .333-15-65 in 86 G -- and was leading the EL in hits (106); 2nd in extra base hits (40); tied for 2nd in runs (59); 3rd in average (.333), RBI (65) and slugging percentage (.569); 4th in HR (15) and 5th in SB (18)...
