## TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (50-53) play Game Two of a four-game series against the fourth-place Columbus Clippers (56-47) -- the Indians' top affiliate. With a 4-2 win last night, the 'Pigs snapped a two-game skid (and a four-game losing streak to Columbus) after finishing just 2-6 on their eight-game South Division road trip. Lehigh Valley is 7-6 in its last 13 games and, over a longer stretch, 27-18 (.600) since 6/11... The Indians previously split a four-game series at Pawtucket and are still 7-5 since the All-Star Break -- all against North Division foes. But since improving to 31-30 on June 12, Columbus has managed just a 14-27 (.341) record. *First-pitch today is at 11:05 a.m. for Camp Day.*

- *Home Boys!* LHV has won a franchise-record 6-straight G at Coca-Cola Park... and is now .500 (26-26) at home.
- *Go West, Young Men?* LHV is just 11-14 vs. the West this season -- the only division it has a losing record against.
- With SWB's win loss night, the 'Pigs pulled to 7.5 GB in the North; with GWN's loss, they're 6.5 GB of Wild Card.

## HOME-COOKING:

Upon their return home, the 'Pigs batted .364 (12-33) last night -- though just 2-11 w/ RISP -- and allowed just 2 ER in 9 IP (2.00 ERA)... During their 2-6 road trip, LHV batted .255 (71-278) -- and just .169 (13-77) w/ RISP. The Pigs had just 2 HR and averaged just 2.9 R/G (23 R)... and the pitching staff had a 5.61 ERA in the 8 G (67.1 ip, 42 er).

## TODAY'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** -- the youngest IronPig -- is a 6-3, 215-pound 22-year-old signed by Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela on 10/25/03 (at age 16 for \$300,000). A member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster, Carrasco flourished in his Triple-A debut with the 'Pigs after his promotion on 8/2/08 -- going 2-2, 1.72 in 6 GS. He started last season in Double-A Reading, going 7-7, 4.32 in 20 G, 19 GS -- starting out 4-4, 3.10 in his first 10 GS (through 5/25); but going just 3-3, 5.70 in his last 10 with the R-Phils. In '07, Carrasco was a Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Clearwater prior to a 6/20 promotion to Reading -- where he threw a rain-shortened 6-inning no-hitter 8/21/07 vs. Altoona (2 bb, 8 k). In '06, Carrasco captured the Paul Owens Award, awarded to the top pitcher in the system, while helping guide Lakewood to a SAL Championship. Carrasco was named to the World Team of the All-Star Futures game 3 times (2006-08) and was the starting and winning pitcher (1.0 ip, 2 k) in '08 at Yankee Stadium on 7/13.

- Carrasco is rated as the #2 Prospect in the system by Baseball America behind Dominic Brown (he was #1 in '08).
- Carrasco started his IL career by going 2-3, 1.94 (55.2 ip, 12 er, 2 wins blown by pen) in his first 11 GS (2008-09).
- Last 10 GS: 6-3, 4.77 (60.1 ip, 32 er), lowering ERA from 5.40... He'd been 0-6, 7.25 (36/29) in prev. 7 GS (4/21-5/24).
- Last 4 GS: 1-2, 7.15 (22.2 ip, 18 er) after setting franchise record winning 4 straight GS 6/15-7/2 (4-0, 2.46).
- CC, 5/12 @ COL (L, 8-4): L, 4 ip, 11 h, 7 r, 7 er, 2 bb, 3 k LO runners in 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th led to Rs in all 4 IP; KO'd on 3 straight H in 5th
- CC, 7/24 @ GWN (L, 7-5): L, 6 ip, 4 h, 6 r, 6 er, 4 bb, 5 k 2 LO BB in 2nd led to 3 R; Down 3-2 in 6th, allowed 2-out, 3-R HR (Barton)

LHP **Chuck Lofgren**, 23, is a 6-3, 205-pound lefty drafted by Cleveland in the 4th round of 2004 out of Junipero Serra H.S. in San Mateo, Calif. (same high school as Barry Bonds, Tom Brady and Lynn Swann). Lofgren spent the entire 2008 season with Double-A Akron, going 2-6, 5.99 in 28 G, 15 GS (first 13 appearances were starts). Following the season, went 0-3, 32.14 in 10 G with the Surprise Rafterers in the Arizona Fall League (18 BB in 7 ip). It was the first rough season for Lofgren -- who had been a 2007 Eastern League mid-season All-Star and Futures Game selection with Akron and the 2006 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year (as well as mid- and post-season All-Star with Kinson [17-5, 2.32 ERA in 25 GS; led the league in wins, and ranked second in ERA and strikeouts (125)].

- CL started '09 in Akron (AA), going 3-1, 1.48 in 8 GS (42.2 ip, 24 h, 9 r, 7 er, 15 bb, 31 k, .160) until a 5/31 promotion.
- CL has won 3 straight starts, going 3-0, 1.80 (20 ip, 20 h, 4 er) vs. IND, SYR, PAW... He started 2-5, 5.88.
- CL won his 3rd straight start his last time out: a 3-1 victory on 7/24 @ PAW: W, 6 ip, 2 h, 1 r, 1 er, 3 bb, 2 k).

## SERIES INFORMATION:

COL leads the series, 4-1 (swept LHV at Huntington Park, 5/12-15)... The teams split the '08 series, 4-4 -- but that was when COL was a Washington affiliate. LHV and BUF (Cleveland's '08 affiliate) split the '08 season-series, 8-8.

## BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Night Owls?* The 'Pigs have gone just 9-18 during day games as compared to 41-35 (.539) in night games.
- *Lean, Mean, Fighting Chacin:* LHP **Gustavo Chacin** has gone 4-0, 3.41 (31.2 ip, 12 er, 4 QS) in his last 5 GS.

### TRANSACTIONS RECAP:

Yesterday, SS **Jason Donald** was activated off the D.L. He hadn't played with LHV since 6/11 (surgery to repair a torn left meniscus) and missed 43 G... While rehabbing in the GCL, Donald went .231-0-1 (6-26, 4 R, 2B, 3B, 2 BB, 5 BB, SB). To make room for Donald, OF **Michael Spidale** was assigned to Reading... Sunday, RHP **Tyson Brummett** was promoted from Reading (AA), where he was 3-9, 4.86, SV in 24 G, 15 GS (96.1 ip, 112 h, 56 r, 52 er, 27 bb, 67 k, .296). He hadn't won since 6/2 (0-4, SV in 12 G, 4 GS)... Saturday, RHP **Kyle Kendrick** and RHP **Steven Register** were recalled by Philadelphia and RHP **Drew Carpenter** was optioned back to LHV...

### THREE-PEAT?:

With ROC's win last night, LHV is still in a tie for third place with the Wings. The 'Pigs had regained sole possession of 3rd place in the North for the second time in team history on Saturday, 7/26 (they took residence for 4 days from 7/18-7/21)... Previously, the 'Pigs took their initial sole residence of 4th place for 10 days (4/16; 6/24-7/2).

### .500 ALLERGY?:

It took 220 games for Lehigh Valley to get to .500 for the first time in franchise history -- which the 'Pigs did on 6/28/09 at 38-38 after a 6-1 win vs. NOR. But then they lost two-straight games and seven of their next nine... The 'Pigs then reeled off seven wins in their next nine contests to get back to .500 for just the second time in team history (7/19/09 at 47-47 after a 3-2 win vs. ROC) -- and have now since lost 6 of their last 9 affairs...

### LOUIE, LOUIE!:

C **Lou Marson** has hit safely in 19 of his last 23 G (28-75, .373-0-9) and in 24 of 30 G (36-99, .364-0-17) since coming off the D.L. with a on 6/19 with a right ankle contusion. Since June 4, he's raised his AVG from .202 to .294 by hitting safely in 28 of his last 35 G (43-117, .368-0-21, 7 2B, 13 m-h G)...

### WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **Michael Taylor** has hit in 7 of his last 9 G (9-30, .300-1-3, 5 R) since starting his Triple-A career 2-13 -- and he has reached safely in his last 9 G... OF **Mike Cervenak** has an 8-G hitting streak (12-34, .353-0-6, 2 2B) and has 9 multi-hit G in his last 16 G (24-68, .353-1-9, 5 2B, 3B)... INF **Miguel Cairo** has a 7-G hitting streak (8-29, .276-0-1, 2 2B) and has hit in 19 of his last 21 G (24-79, .304)... INF **Terry Tiffee** has a 5-G hitting streak (7-20, .350-1-3) and has hit in 13 of his last 15 G (21-60, .350-1-7); 17 of his last 20 G (27-80, .338-1-8)... INF **David Newhan** has hit safely in 10 of his last 14 G (18-45, .400-1-6, 4 2B)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in 14 of 20 GS since his promotion to LHV (24-80, .300, 17 R) -- and the 'Pigs are 13-7 in those games...

### WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** won 5 of his last 7 decisions, but has a 4.66 ERA (48.1 ip, 25 er) in these last 8 GS... Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 8-2 with a 1.83 ERA in his last 11 G, 10 GS with LHV (73.2 ip, 15 er, 61 k)... RHP **Steven Register** has been unscored upon in 9 of his last 10 G (13 ip, 1 er; 1-0, 0.69, 4 SV) and in 13 of his last 15 G (1-0, 1.47, 18.2 ip, 3 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 19 of last his 24 relief app's (5-0, 2.11, 38.1 ip, 9 er)... In his last 19 G with LHV, RHP **Jason Anderson** in 0-1, 1.78 and 2 SV (30.1 ip, 6 er)... RHP **Patrick Overholt** has been unscored upon in 3 of his 4 Triple-A G (6/1 ip, er)...

### RARE ROUGH STRETCH FOR BULLPEN:

In its last 16 G, the 'Pigs bullpen in 2-3, 4.26 (44.1 ip, 21 er)... Still, since June 14, the corps is now 5-4, 2.44 (133.0 ip, 36 er) in 40 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.68 ERA (315.2 ip, 94 er) in 99 G.

### BACON BITS, PT. 2:

- *Walks Hurt*: In the GWN series, LHV pitching issued 19 BB -- and 9 scored in the 4 G... In fact, of the 11 frames in which the Braves scored, at least one BB was issued in 8 of those innings (72.7%).
- *Power Outage?*: In their last 25 G, LHV has just 9 HR in 224 innings (which inc. a 74.1-inning drought 6/30-7/8).
- *Getting Defensive*: The 'Pigs have committed just 5 E in the last 19 G -- and have the best total (68 in the I.L. by 4 E ahead of SWB). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.982) and has turned an IL-best 110 double plays (SYR has 109)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.
- *Scoring in Bunches!*: In the last 43 G, LHV has now scored multiple R in 48 innings...and after not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 15 times in their last 42 G.
- *Closer by Committee*: LHV has had 4 different RPs earn saves in their last 5 (Register-2, Taschner, Majewski, Anderson). In fact 12 of their last saves have been recorded by 6 RP (add Bowers, Escalona). In all, 8 pitchers have combined for the team's 26 SV (add Koplove, Walker).
- *Difference a Year Makes*: LHV is 9.0 G better from this point last season (41-62) & is on pace to finish 70-74.

### TAYLOR MADE:

OF **Michael Taylor** was promoted from Reading (AA) to LHV on 7/16. The 6-6, 260-pound Eastern League All-Star was batting .333-15-65 in 86 G -- and was leading the EL in hits (106); 2nd in extra base hits (40); tied for 2nd in runs (59); 3rd in average (.333), RBI (65) and slugging percentage (.569); 4th in HR (15) and 5th in SB (18)... The Phillies' 5th-round pick in 2007 out of Stanford combined to hit .346-19-88 in 132 G between Lakewood (.361) and Clearwater (.329) in 2008 and is rated the No. 6 Prospect in the system by *Baseball America*.

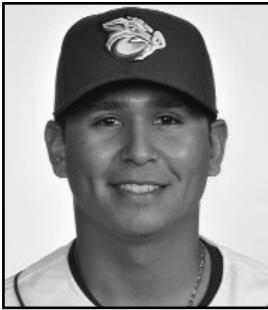
