TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (51-53) play Game Three of a four-game series against the fourth-place Columbus Clippers (56-48) -- the Indians' top affiliate. With a 4-2 win yesterday, the 'Pigs have won two straight games after losing their first four contests to Columbus in May. Lehigh Valley is now 8-6 in its last 14 games and, over a longer stretch, 28-18 (.609) since 6/11... The Indians previously split a four-game series at Pawtucket and are still 7-6 since the All-Star Break -- all against North Division foes. But since improving to 31-30 on June 12, COL has managed just a 14-28 (.333) record.

- First-pitch tonight is scheduled for 7:05 p.m. for "Celtic" IronPigs Souvenir Cup Night, presented by **LCCC**.
- *Go West, Young Men?*: LHV is just 12-14 vs. the West this season -- the only division it has a losing record against.
- With SWB's rain out night, the 'Pigs pulled to 7.0 GB in the North; with GWN's win, they're 6.5 GB of Wild Card.

HOME-COOKING!

With two wins to start this series, LHV has now won a franchise-record seven straight home games...and is now above .500 (27-26, .509) at home... Upon their return home following a 2-6 South Division road trip, the 'Pigs are batting .303 (20-66) in the last 2 G -- and allowed just 4 ER in 18 IP (2.00 ERA)... During the road trip, LHV batted .255 (71-278) -- and just .169 (13-77) w/ RISP. The 'Pigs had just 2 HR and averaged just 2.9 R/G (23 R)... and the pitching staff had a 5.61 ERA in the 8 G (67.1 ip, 42 er).

PEDRO THE 'PIG (MORE ON PAGE TWO):

The Phillies announced today that three-time Cy Young Award winner RHP **Pedro Martinez** is scheduled to continue his ML rehab with the IronPigs against Columbus at Coca-Cola Park tomorrow (the game was already sold out). Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Network is the exclusive sponsor of all ML rehabilitation appearances at CCP.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- making his first LHV start since July 19 (promotion) -- is a 6-3, 225-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 2nd round of 2006 out of Long Beach State and is a member of the 40-Man Roster. The Vacaville, CA, native spent a bulk of 2008 in Double-A Reading, going just 6-8 with a 5.67 ERA in 16 GS -- but was on the move in the second half, with a stint in Advanced-A Clearwater (3-3, 2.92 in 8 GS from 6/16-7/31), a ML debut with Philly (scoreless IP of relief 8/27 vs. NYM) and a start with LHV on 8/31 @ PAW (L, 7 ip 6 h, 2 er). Carpenter had a stellar 2007 season in Clearwater -- where he led the Florida State League in wins (17) and shutouts (2) while being selected to play in the 2007 FSL All-Star Game. He finished the season 17-6, 3.20 with 1 SV in 27 G, 24 GS, and tied for the league lead in CG (3). Among the highlights in his three-year MILB career was a 7-inning perfect game 8/27/07 vs. Fort Myers (7 ip, 7 k). He also won both his postseason starts (2-0, 2.92) as the Threshers won the 2007 FSL Championship.

- Recalled by PHI from 7/23-7/25, DC appeared in 2 G out of the Phillies bullpen (1.1 ip, 3 h, 2 r, 2 er, bb, k),
- DC, 7/19 vs. ROC (W, 3-2): n/d, 7.0 ip, 3 h, r, er, 2 bb, 8 k, hr Ret'd 20 of first 24 until 2-out HR (Plouffe) broke SHO; left up 2-1

RHP **Ken Ray**, 34, is a 6-2, 200-pound righty signed by the Cleveland as a minor league free agent 5/27/09 off the Long Island Ducks of the independent Atlantic League -- where he was 4-0, 3.00 in 5 GS (27.0 ip, 30 h, 15 r, 9 er, 3 bb, 26 k). A native of Atlanta, Ray stated 2008 with the Potros de Tijuana of the Mexican League (6-3, 3.65 ERA) before finishing the season with the SK Wyverns of the Korean Baseball Organization. Ray made his ML debut 7/10/99 for Kansas City, going 1-0, 8.74 in 13 G, 0 GS and later reappeared in 2006 with Atlanta (1-1, 4.52 in 69 G, 0 GS) --striking out Barry Bonds on 3 pitches in his first appearance. Ray was later claimed off waivers by KC following the season and started 2007 with Triple-A Omaha before finishing with Triple-A Nashville (Milwaukee).

The 'Pigs received C **Kevin Nelson** (.225-2-11 in 36 G) and RHP **Francisco Butto** from Double-A Reading. In addition, OF **John Mayberry** and RHP **Steven Register** were optioned back to LHV from Philadelphia.

SERIES INFORMATION:

COL leads the series, 4-2 (swept LHV at Huntington Park, 5/12-15)... The teams split the '08 series, 4-4 -- but that was when COL was a Washington affiliate. LHV and BUF (Cleveland's '08 affiliate) split the '08 season-series, 8-8.

MORE ON MARTINEZ:

The Phillies signed RHP **Pedro Martinez**, 37, on July 15 to a one-year deal and immediately placed him on the 15-day Disabled List with a mild shoulder strain. He began his rehab with Advanced-A Clearwater this past Sunday but had his scoreless outing cut short after just an inning and a third due to rain. The native of Manoguayabo, Dominican Republic, last appeared in a Major League game with the New York Mets on September 25, 2008.

Martinez is one of just eight Major Leaguers to ever win the Cy Young Award at least three times, and only one of four pitchers in baseball history to win the award in both the National League (1997) and American League (1999, 2000) -- a list that consists of Gaylord Perry, Roger Clemens and Randy Johnson. Martinez is also seven-time All-Star (1996-99, 2002, 2005-06) who joins the Phillies organization with a career record of 214-99 (.684) and a 2.91 ERA in 467 games (400 starts) for the Los Angeles Dodgers (1992-93), Montreal Expos (1994-97), Boston Red Sox (1998-2004) and New York Mets (2005-08). Last year, he went 5-6 with a 5.61 ERA in 20 starts for the Mets and this past March he pitched for the Dominican Republic team in the World Baseball Classic -- tossing six innings of scoreless relief in two games.

Romero** (5/18-5/31) and OF **Raul Ibanez** (7/7-7/9); Boston's RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka** (6/16/08) & SS **Julio Lugo** (4/24-4/26/09); Detroit's LHP **Dontrelle Willis** (5/1/09).

THREE'S NOT A CROWD:

With ROC's win last night, LHV is now back in sole possession of third place for the third time in team history. The 'Pigs had regained sole possession of 3rd place in the North for the second time on Saturday, 7/26 (they took residence for 4 days from 7/18-7/21)... Previously, the 'Pigs took their initial sole residence of 4th place for 10 days (4/16; 6/24-7/2).

BULLPEN: TAXED BUT TICKIN!:

The 'Pigs bullpen combined for 6 scoreless, one-hit IP yesterday... Including spot-starter Jake Woods, the 'Pigs bullpen has now worked 34 IP in the last 7 G, an average of roughly 5 IP/G (starters have gone more than 6.0 IP in any of the last 7 G)... Still, since June 14, the corps is now 6-4, 2.33 (139.0 ip, 36 er) in 41 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.63 ERA (321.2 ip, 94 er) in 100 G.

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **Mike Cervenak** has an 9-G hitting streak (15-38, .395-0-8, 2 2B) and has 10 multi-hit G in his last 17 G (27-72, .375-1-11, 5 2B, 3B)... INF **Miguel Cairo** has a 7-G hitting streak (8-29, .276-0-1, 2 2B) and has hit in 19 of his last 21 G (24-79, .304)... INF **Terry Tiffee** has a 6-G hitting streak (8-24, .333-1-5) and has hit in 14 of his last 16 G (22-64, .343-1-9); 18 of his last 21 G (28-84, .333-1-10)... OF **Michael Taylor** has hit in 7 of his last 10 G (9-33, .273-1-3, 5 R) since starting his Triple-A career 2-13 -- and he has reached safely in his last 10 G... INF **David Newhan** has hit safely in 11 of his last 15 G (19-49, .388-1-6, 4 2B)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 7-2 with a 1.83 ERA in his last 11 G, 10 GS with LHV (73.2 ip, 15 er, 61 k)... RHP **Steven Register** has been unscored upon in 9 of his last 10 G (13 ip, 1 er; 1-0, 0.69, 4 SV) and in 13 of his last 15 G (1-0, 1.47, 18.2 ip, 3 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 19 of his last 24 relief app's (5-0, 2.11, 38.1 ip, 9 er)... In his last 19 G with LHV, RHP **Jason Anderson** in 0-1, 1.72 and 3 SV (31.1 ip, 6 er)... RHP **Patrick Overholt** has been unscored upon in 4 of his 5 Triple-A G (1-0, H, 1.08, 8.1 ip, er)...

.500 ALLERGY?:

It took 220 games for Lehigh Valley to get to .500 for the first time in franchise history -- which the 'Pigs did on 6/28/09 at 38-38 after a 6-1 win vs. NOR. But then they lost two-straight games and seven of their next nine... The 'Pigs then reeled off seven wins in their next nine contests to get back to .500 for just the second time in team history (7/19/09 at 47-47 after a 3-2 win vs. ROC) -- and have now since lost 6 of their last 10 affairs...

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Difference a Year Makes:* LHV is 9.0 G better from this point last season (42-62) & is on pace to finish 71-73.
- *Night Owls?:* The 'Pigs are now just 10-18 during day games as compared to 41-35 (.539) in night games.
- *Lean, Mean, Fighting Chacin:* LHP **Gustavo Chacin** has gone 4-0, 3.41 (31.2 ip, 12 er, 4 QS) in his last 5 GS.
- *Power Outage?:* In their last 26 G, LHV has just 9 HR in 232 innings (which inc. a 74.1-inning drought 6/30-7/8).
- *Getting Defensive:* The 'Pigs have committed just 5 E in the last 20 G -- and have the best total (68 in the I.L. by 4 E ahead of SWB). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.982) and has turned an IL-best 111 double plays (SYR has 110)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.
- *Scoring in Bunches!:* In the last 44 G, LHV has now scored multiple R in 49 innings...and after not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 15 times in their last 43 G.
- *Closer by Committee:* LHV has had 4 different RPs earn saves in their last 6 (Register-2, Anderson-2, Taschner, Majewski,). In fact 12 of their last saves have been recorded by 6 RP (add Bowers, Escalona).
