TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (51-54) play the finale of a four-game series against the fourth-place Columbus Clippers (46-58) -- the Indians' top affiliate. With a 5-4 loss in 10 innings last night, the 'Pigs had their mini two-game winning streak halted and clinched a losing season-series against the Clippers (who have now won five of eight scheduled games). Still, Lehigh Valley is 8-7 in its last 15 games and, over a longer stretch, 28-19 (.596) since 6/11... The Clippers are now 8-6 since the All-Star Break -- all against North Division foes. But since improving to 31-30 on June 12, Columbus has managed just a 15-28 (.349) record... The 'Pigs next start a four-game series in Rochester tomorrow.

- First-pitch tonight is set for 7:05 p.m. for Friday Night Fireworks, presented by **Haldeman Ford/Lincoln/Mercury**.
- With SWB's DH split, the 'Pigs fell to 7.5 GB in the North; with GWN's win, they're now 7.5 GB of the Wild Card.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Pedro Martinez**, 37, is a 5-11, 193-pound righty signed by Philadelphia on 7/15/08 to a one-year, prorated \$2 M contract (approximately \$900,000 with another \$1.25 M in incentives) and was immediately placed him on the 15-day D.L. with a mild shoulder strain. The native of Santo Domingo, D.R., spent 2008 with the New York Mets, going 5-6, 5.61 in 20 GS (losing record for first time in pro career) -- then pitched in March for the Dominican Republic team in the World Baseball Classic (0-0, 0.00, 2 G, 0 GS, 6 ip, 1 h, 0 r, 0 bb, 6 k, hb). Martinez is one of just eight Major Leaguers to ever win the Cy Young Award at least three times, and only one of four pitchers in baseball history to win the award in both the National League (1997) and American League (1999, 2000) -- a list that consists of Gaylord Perry, Roger Clemens and Randy Johnson. Martinez is also seven-time All-Star (1996-99, 2002, 2005-06) who joins the Phillies organization with a career record of 214-99 (.684) and a 2.91 ERA in 467 G, 400 GS for the Los Angeles Dodgers (1992-93), Montreal Expos (1994-97), Boston Red Sox (1998-2004) and New York Mets (2005-08). Martinez ranks T-13th (Gibson) in ML history in career strikeouts (3,117), becoming the 15th pitcher in ML history to record 3,000 strikeouts on September 3, 2007 at Cincinnati.

- *PM last win came in a 6-2 victory on 8/31/08 @ FLA (W, 6 ip, 7 h, 2 r, 2 er, bb, 4 k).*
- *His last MiLB win was with Advanced-A St. Lucie on 8/20/07 vs. Brevard -- just his 2nd MiLB G since 1993.*

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** -- making his first start with COL -- is a 6-3, 215-pound 22-year-old acquired via trade by Cleveland with SS Jason Donald, C Lou Marson and RHP Jason Knapp from Philadelphia for LHP Cliff Lee and OF Ben Francisco on 7/29/09. Originally signed by PHI as a non-drafted free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela on 10/25/03 (at age 16 for \$300,000). A member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster, Carrasco flourished in his Triple-A debut with the 'Pigs after his promotion on 8/2/08 -- going 2-2, 1.72 in 6 GS. He started last season in Double-A Reading, going 7-7, 4.32 in 20 G, 19 GS -- starting out 4-4, 3.10 in his first 10 GS (through 5/25); but going just 3-3, 5.70 in his last 10 with the R-Phils. In '07, Carrasco was a FSL Midseason All-Star with Clearwater prior to a 6/20 promotion to REA -- where he threw a rain-shortened 6-inning no-hitter 8/21/07 vs. Altoona (2 bb, 8 k). In '06, Carrasco captured the Paul Owens Award, awarded to the top pitcher in the system, while helping guide Lakewood to a SAL Championship. Carrasco was named to the World Team of the All-Star Futures game 3 times (2006-08) and was the starting and winning pitcher (1.0 ip, 2 k) in '08 at Yankee Stadium on 7/13.

- *Carrasco was rated as the #2 Prospect in PHI's system by Baseball America behind Dominic Brown (he was #1 in '08).*
- *Carrasco started his IL career by going 2-3, 1.94 (55.2 ip, 12 er, 2 wins blown by pen) in his first 11 GS (2008-09).*
- *Last 10 GS: 6-3, 4.77 (60.1 ip, 32 er), lowering ERA from 5.40... He'd been 0-6, 7.25 (36/29) in prev. 7 GS (4/21-5/24).*
- *Last 4 GS: 1-2, 7.15 (22.2 ip, 18 er) after setting franchise record winning 4 straight GS 6/15-7/2 (4-0, 2.46).*
- *CC, 7/24 @ GWN (L, 7-5): L, 6 ip, 4 h, 6 r, 6 er, 4 bb, 5 k 2 LO BB in 2nd led to 3 R; Down 3-2 in 6th, allowed 2-out, 3-R HR (Barton)*

TONS 'O TRANSACTIONS:

Today, RHP **Pedro Martinez** was assigned to LHV for Major League Rehab Assignment. His first rehab was with Clearwater on 7/26, but his outing was cut short by rain (n/d, 1.1 ip, 1 h, 0 r, 0 bb, 1 k, 1 hb). The three-time Cy Young Award winner was 5-6, 5.61 in 20 GS with the New York Mets last season... RHP **Joe Savery** -- a 1st rounder in 2007 -- was promoted from Reading (AA), where he was 12-4, 4.41 in 21 G, 20 GS... OF **John Mayberry, Jr.**, and RHP **Steven Register** both rejoined the IronPigs today after being optioned from Philadelphia yesterday... To make room, RHP **Francisco Butto** and RHP **Tyson Brummett** were assigned to Reading (AA).

- The 'Pigs have now had 23 transactions in the past 9 days, and are nearing 2008's total of 110 (104 at current).

COL leads the series, 5-2 (swept LHV at Huntington Park, 5/12-15)... The teams split the '08 series, 4-4 -- but that was when COL was a Washington affiliate. LHV and BUF (Cleveland's '08 affiliate) split the '08 season-series, 8-8.

MORE ON REHABS:

The rehab appearance of three-time Cy Young Award winner RHP **Pedro Martinez** tonight is presented **Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Network**, the exclusive sponsor of all ML rehabilitation appearances at Coca-Cola Park.

Other notable rehabs at Coca-Cola Park: OF **Shane Victorino** (4/26-4/27/08), RHP **Rudy Seanez** (8/11/08), C **Carlos Ruiz** (4/25-5/1), LHP **J.C. Romero** (5/18-5/31) and OF **Raul Ibanez** (7/7-7/9); Boston's RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka** (6/16/08) & SS **Julio Lugo** (4/24-4/26/09); Detroit's LHP **Dontrelle Willis** (5/1/09).

HOME-COOKING:

Last night's loss snapped the 'Pigs franchise-record seven-game home winning streak... but they are still .500 (27-27) at home... Upon their return home following a 2-6 South Division road trip, the 'Pigs are batting .269 (28-104) in the last 3 G, averaging 4.0 R/G (12 R) -- and allowing just 8 ER in 28 IP (2.57 ERA).... During the road trip, LHV batted .255 (71-278) -- and just .169 (13-77) w/ RISP. The 'Pigs had just 2 HR and averaged just 2.9 R/G (23 R)... and the pitching staff had a 5.61 ERA in the 8 G (67.1 ip, 42 er).

THREE'S NOT A CROWD:

With ROC's loss last night, LHV is still in sole possession of third place for the third time in team history (7/29-Present). The 'Pigs had regained sole possession of 3rd place in the North (for one day) a second time on Saturday, 7/26. They took their initial residence of 3rd place was for 4 days from 7/18-7/21... Previously, the 'Pigs took their initial sole residence of 4th place for 10 days (4/16; 6/24-7/2).

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Extra Special?*: The 'Pigs fell to 4-8 in extra-inning games last night. They had, however, won 3 of 4 prior to last night.
- *Blown Leads*: LHV lost its IL-leading 10th game when leading after 5 innings (BUF-8, GWN-7, all other teams 6 or less).
- *Fast Starters*: LHV has scored at least one R in the first inning of 5 of its last 8 G (11 R) -- but are just 3-2 in these G.
- *Go West, Young Men?*: LHV is just 12-15 vs. the West this season -- the only division it has a losing record against.
- *Difference a Year Makes*: LHV is 9.0 G better from this point last season (42-63) & is on pace to finish 70-74.
- *Power Outage?*: In their last 27 G, LHV has just 10 HR in 242 innings (which inc. a 74.1-inning drought 6/30-7/8).
- *Getting Defensive*: The 'Pigs have committed just 6 E in the last 21 G -- and have the best total (69 in the I.L. by 5 E ahead of SWB). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.982) and has turned an IL 2nd-best 111 double plays (SYR has 113)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.
- *Scoring in Bunches!*: In the last 45 G, LHV has now scored multiple R in 50 innings...and after not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 15 times in their last 44 G.

BULLPEN: TAXED BUT TICKIN!:

The 'Pigs bullpen has combined 11 IP in the last 2 G (3 ER)... Including spot-starter Jake Woods, the 'Pigs bullpen has now worked 39 IP in the last 8 G, an average of roughly 5.0 IP/G (starters have not gone more than 6.0 IP in any of the last 8 G)... Still, since June 14, the corps is now 6-5, 2.44 (144.0 ip, 39 er) in 42 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.67 ERA (326.2 ip, 97 er) in 101 G.

OF **Mike Cervenak** had his third 9-G hitting streak of 2009 snapped last night (0-4, BB). Still, he has hit in 9 or 10 G (15-42, .357-0-8, 2 2B) and has 10 multi-hit G in his last 18 G (27-76, .355-1-11, 5 2B, 3B)... INF **Miguel Cairo** has a 7-G hitting streak (8-29, .276-0-1, 2 2B) and has hit in 19 of his last 21 G (24-79, .304)... INF **Terry Tiffee** has hit in 6 of his last 7 G (8-29, .276-1-5) and has hit in 14 of his last 17 G (22-69, .319-1-9)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in his last 5 G (7-22, .318-2-4) after a 2-36 skid... C Paul Hoover has hit in 7 of his last 9 G (10-28, .357-0-5)... OF **Michael Taylor** has hit in 8 of his last 11 G (11-38, .289-1-3, 5 R) since starting his Triple-A career 2-13 -- and he has reached safely in his last 12 G... INF **David Newhan** has hit safely in 11 of his last 16 G (19-52, .365-1-6, 4 2B)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

Lean, Mean, Fighting Chacin: LHP **Gustavo Chacin** has gone 4-0, 3.41 (31.2 ip, 12 er, 4 QS) in his last 5 GS... Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 7-2 with a 1.83 ERA in his last 12 G, 11 GS with LHV (78.2 ip, 16 er, 65 k)... RHP **Steven Register** has been unscored upon in 9 of his last 10 G (13 ip, 1 er; 1-0, 0.69, 4 SV) and in 13 of his last 15 G (1-0, 1.47, 18.2 ip, 3 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 19 of last his 24 relief app's (5-0, 2.11, 38.1 ip, 9 er)... In his last 19 G with LHV, RHP **Jason Anderson** in 0-1, 1.72 and 3 SV (31.1 ip, 6 er)... RHP **Patrick Overholt** has been unscored upon in 4 of his 5 Triple-A G (1-0, H, 1.08, 8.1 ip, er)...

.500 ALLERGY?:

It took 220 games for Lehigh Valley to get to .500 for the first time in franchise history -- which the 'Pigs did on 6/28/09 at 38-38 after a 6-1 win vs. NOR. But then they lost two-straight games and seven of their next nine... The 'Pigs then reeled off seven wins in their next nine contests to get back to .500 for just the second time in team history (7/19/09 at 47-47 after a 3-2 win vs. ROC) -- and have now since lost 7 of their last 11 affairs...

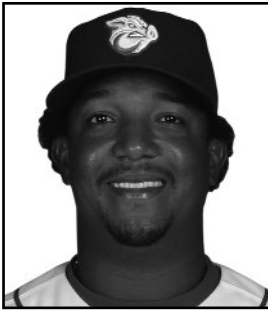
