## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (41-45) open a mini two-game home\* series against the first-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Yankees (48-34) -- New York's top affiliate. With a 12-0 shutout of Pawtucket last night, the 'Pigs snapped a two-game skid to split the two-game series versus the Red Sox. Still, Lehigh Valley has dropped seven of its last 10 games after winning 13 of 15 contests from 6/14-6/28. Even so, the 'Pigs remain 18-10 in their last 28 affairs... SWB lost last night, 4-1, to split its two-game series at Buffalo and end its four-game winning streak. The Yanks are 6-2 in their last eight games after falling in seven of their previous eight games... *Since SWB started 23-5 (5/8), they've gone just 25-29 -- but LHV has gained just 0.5 G in the span. The Yankees started 11-0 and then 14-1.*

\* First-Pitch is scheduled at 7:05 p.m. both tonight and tomorrow.

### \*SERIES SWITCH:

The IronPigs-Yankees series has been shifted to Coca-Cola Park due to the SWB's continuing efforts to correct drainage issues at PNC Field in Moosic. The 'Pigs are offering complimentary tickets to season ticket and mini-plan holders for these upcoming games. In addition, those holding tickets to the games originally scheduled for PNC Field can exchange those tickets for a complimentary Field Level ticket (subject to availability) at Coca-Cola Park.

### ABOUT LAST NIGHT:

**[1]** The 12-0 victory was the largest in LHV history. The 'Pigs previous mark was 10, set in a 13-3 win 4/24 vs. PAW (also started by LHP Kris Johnson)... **[2]** The 12 runs was also the 'Pigs 2nd-highest at Coca-Cola Park... **[3]** LHV had its 7th SHO of the season last night -- passing the '08 total of 6 SHO in 144 G (59 fewer games)! It was also the 'Pigs 5th in last the 33 G. It was their 6th in a 9-inning game -- they had only 4 in 9-inning games in '08... **[4]** It was also the 3rd SHO started by RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- who's now one win away from tying the franchise-record for wins in a season (LHP Brian Mazzone, 9 in '08).

### TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Gustavo Chacin** -- making his 8th start as an IronPig -- is a 5-11, 207-pound, 28-year-old lefty signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 4/6/09 (he had been released by Washington at the end of Spring Training). After undergoing surgery for a slight tear in his labrum on 8/29/07, the native of Maracaibo, VZ, spent 2008 battling injuries rehabbing for Toronto in Single-A Dunedin (1-7, 7.88 in 11 GS before a season-ending ACL tear). Chacin last pitched in MLB for Toronto in 2007, and went 25-15, 4.18 in a 4-year stint with the Jays. He made his ML debut 9/20/04 at NYY and became the 7th Jay to win his first start (7 ip, 3 er). In his rookie season of '05, Chacin went 13-9, 3.72 in 34 GS and led TOR with 121 SO. The 13 wins set a team rookie record for starting pitchers and he was AL Rookie of the Month twice (April: 2-1, 2.48 in 5 GS; and July: 5-0, 2.97 in 6 GS) and became the fastest Blue Jay to ever reach the 10-win plateau. Chacin emerged in MiLB in 2004, when he went 16-2, 2.86 in 25 with New Hampshire and was an Eastern League post-season All-Star. Originally signed by TOR as a non-drafted free agent 7/3/98, he worked hand-and-hand with fragrance experts to concoct *Chacin Cologne* for a team promotion.

- GC started in Reading (1-0, 3.21, 2 G, 1 GS): winning his lone 5/23 @ ALT (5 ip, er) -- his first win since 6/4/08 @ FTM.
- GC lost his prev 2 starts -- both to NOR -- going 0-2, 4.50 (10 ip, 5 er)... He'd won his previous 2 GS (2-0, 3.75).
- GC, 7/4 @ SYR (L, 3-2): n/d, 7.1 ip, 7 h, r, er, bb, 5 k. Duel w/ Martin; solo HR in 2nd (Casto) then ret'd 17 of 22 til 3B in 8th; left up 2-1

RHP **Josh Towers**, 32, is a 6-1, 185-pound righty signed by New York as a minor league free agent 5/10/09 (went to Spring Training with Washington but was released 5/5/09 after spending time in Syracuse). The native Port Hueneme, Calif., was originally drafted by Baltimore in the 15th round of 1996 out of Oxnard (CA) J.C. -- where he was named Conference MVP and Juco All-America. He spent the entire 2008 season in Triple-A Colorado Springs, going 6-7, 6.27 in 31 G, 15 GS. Towers made his ML debut with Baltimore 5/2/01 vs. TB (1.1 scoreless relief) and earned his first ML win 5/9 @ TB. In his ML career, he's gone 45-55, 4.96 in 137 G, 112 GS with BAL (2001-02) and TOR (2003-07).

- JT started 0-4, 5.85 in 6 G, 4 GS (27.2 ip, 18 er)... but since then, has gone 3-1, 3.10 in 5 GS (29 ip, 10 er).
- JT won his last outing in effective fashion, 6-1, on 7/3 @ SWB: W, 7 ip, 4 h, r, er, 0 bb, 4 k, hr (Denker).

### REHABBING RAUL (see page 2 for more):

Phillies All-Star OF **Raul Ibanez** is scheduled to continue a ML rehab (left groin strain) for the IronPigs. Tuesday, he became the fifth Phillies player to rehab with the IronPigs -- going 1-2, BB, R playing 7 innings in LF.

### SERIES INFORMATION:

SWB leads the 2009 series, 5-1 -- and overall series, 19-3; winning 11 of 12 at CCP. The Yanks won 8 straight G from 8/16/08 (4) through 4/12/09 (4). Of note: the Triple-A Yanks Spring Training team was 4-0 vs. the Phils' this exh season.

• **Shelley Duncan** has 4 HR and 15 RBI in just 10 career G vs. LHV; **Juan Miranda** has 5 HR, 18 RBI in 21 G.

### NORTHERN EXPOSURE:

LHV is in Game 9 of 16 straight against division rivals, going 3-5 so far... LHV plays the ND in 50 of the final 66 G (inc. 10 against division-leading SWB). The 'Pigs are 17-21 (.447) against the North in '09 after faring just 22-58 (.275) in '08.

### BACON BITS, PT. 1:

• **Power Outage Over!**: The HR by 1B **Andy Tracy** in the 3rd inning last snapped LHV's HR-draught at 74.1 innings (since Terry Tiffée's HR on 6/30, 8 games prior).

• Prior to last night's 12-run outburst, the 'Pigs had only scored 17 R in the prev. 9 G (1.9 R/G) going 2-7.

• **Taxed but Tickin'**: With a Day-Night DH (7/3) and just 3 QS in the last 7 GS, the **LHV bullpen** has thrown 28 IP in the last 7 G (an AVG of 4.0 IP per game). During the span, they've maintained a 2.57 ERA (8 er)... In its last 15 G, the LHV bullpen has allowed just 8 ER in hit last 48.0 IP (1.50 ERA) -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... Since June 14, the corps is now 2-1, 1.56 (86.1 ip, 15 er) in 25 G... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.44 ERA (269.0 ip, 73 er) in 82 G.

• **For Starters...**: Still, in the last 22 G, LHV starters are 10-8, 2.52 ERA (CG, 128.1 ip, 36 er) with 14 quality starts.

• **Getting Defensive**: LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.981) and has turned an IL-best 100 double plays. The next closest team has just 92 (ROC)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.

• **More Clutch Hits, More Runs**: In the last 25 G (16-9), is batting .278 (62-223) w/ RISP and averaging 5.0 R/G (126 R) after scoring just 104 R in the previous 30 G (5/14-6/13), averaging 3.5 R/G...

### MORE ON IBANEZ / REHABS:

OF **Raul Ibanez** may resume his ML Rehab Assignment with Lehigh Valley Thursday in Moosic. Last night, he became the 5th Phillies player to rehab with the IronPigs (1-2, BB, R). Prior to suffering the injury, the 37-year-old was enjoying an MVP-caliber season (.312-22-59 in 62 G), ranking second in the National League in both HR (22) and RBI (59). Despite not appearing in a game since mid-June, Ibanez received the 2nd-most All-Star votes among N.L. outfielders and, if healthy, will appear in his first Midsummer Classic on July 14 at Busch Stadium in St. Louis.

Ibanez batted .293 with 23 home runs and 110 RBI for Seattle in 2008 -- his third straight 20-plus homer, 100-plus RBI campaign with the Mariners. During a 13-year Major League career with Seattle, Kansas City and Philadelphia, the New York City native has batted .287 with 204 home runs and 853 RBI. A late-bloomer, Ibanez has connected on 190 of his career home runs since 2001. Prior to the setback, Ibanez had been of the most dependable position players in all of baseball, appearing in at least 149 games (including 162 in both 2005 and 2008) during each of the last four seasons. The Phillies inked Ibanez to a three-year, \$30-million deal this past off-season. All ML Rehab Assignments at CCP are presented by **Good Shephard Rehabilitation Network**.

*Other notable rehabs at Coca-Cola Park*: OF **Shane Victorino** (4/26-4/27/08), RHP **Rudy Seanez** (8/11/08), C **Carlos Ruiz** (4/25-5/1) and LHP **J.C. Romero** (5/18-5/31); Boston's RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka** (6/16/08) & SS **Julio Lugo** (4/24-4/26/09); Detroit's LHP **Dontrelle Willis** (5/11/09).

### KYLE KAN!:

Even though his last win was his first since 5/27 @ BUF (had gone 6 straight starts w/o a win), RHP **Kyle Kendrick** has turned in Quality Starts in 7 of his last 9 GS -- and really 7 of 8 since one was a 0.1 IP rain-shortened start 6/22 @ NOR. In his last 9 G, Kendrick is 3-2, 2.93 with a CG (55.1 ip, 19 r, 18 er). He has taken a SHO into the 6th in 4 of the starts.

### BOWERS POWERS:

LHP **Cedric Bowers** -- who now has a 12.1 scoreless IP streak -- has allowed just 1 R in his last 18 G (1-0, 0.39, 3 SV, 7 holds, 23.1 IP, 11 h, 1 er, 23 k). He also had an 11.0 scoreless IP streak 5/17-6/7, going unscored upon in his first 8 G -- during which opposing batters were 0-29! The R scored after a 3B by **Drew Sutton** which snapped a string of Bowers not allowing an extra basehit in a span of 16+ G (20.2 IP; 66 AB since 4/19). He's allowed just 5 xbh in '09.

### WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

In his last 27 G, 1B **Andy Tracy** is batting .327-6-22 (32-98, 10 2B, 25 R) and has batted .321-6-25 (36-112) in his last 31 G... C **Lou Marson** has hit in 13 of 16 G since coming off the D.L. (23-56, .411-0-13) and in 17 of his last 21 G (30-74, .405-0-17, 4 2B, 12 m-h G) -- raising AVG from .202 to .292 since 6/4... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in his last 5 G (8-17, .471) and in 18 of 22 G (26-82, .317, 11 BB, 9 R)... INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit in 10 of his last 13 G (16-46, .348-0-7, 3 2B)... INF **Terry Tiffée** has hit in 5 of his last 6 G (7-20, .350-0-1)... OF **Michael Spidale** has hit in 10 of 15 GS since his promotion to LHV (19-60, .317, 2B, 15 R)...

### WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

Despite a being hit hard in a loss (4 ip, 6 er) last time out, RHP **Carlos Carrasco** remains 4-1, 3.94 (29.2 ip, 13 er) in his last 5 GS... Since winning his first ML start 5/16 @ Washington, RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 7-2 with a 1.89 ERA in 10 G, 9 GS with Lehigh Valley (66.2 ip, 14 er, 53 k)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 17 of last his 21 relief ap's (4-0, 2.08, 34.2 ip, 8 er)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has allowed just 4 ER in his last 16 G (0-1, SV, 1.52, 23.2 IP) with LHV... RHP **Steven Register** hasn't allowed a R in his last 6 G (8.0 ip) & in 10 of last 11 G (0-0, 1.32, 2 SV, 13.2 ip, 2 er, 7 k)... LHP **Sergio Escalona** has allowed 1 ER in his last 7 G w/ LHV (0-0, 0.87, 2 SV, H, 10.1 ip, 3 r, 7 k)...
