## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (56-57) play Game One of a four-game series against the Louisville Bats (65-49) -- The Reds' top affiliate -- who lead with West with the International League's best record. With a 6-1 loss last night, the 'Pigs had a mini-two game win streak snapped to split four games with SWB (last two at Coca-Cola Park). Even so, Lehigh Valley has four of its last six contests and, over a longer stretch, is 33-23 (.589) since 6/11... With a 7-2 win last night, Louisville just split a four-game series at Rochester and has now won in five of its last six affairs. Since June 6 (when LOU hosted LHV), the Bats have gone 39-21 (.650) in their last 60 games.

- First-Pitch tonight is set for 7:05 p.m. along with Skyy Dog USA act & Dog Day #2, presented by **TD Bank.**
- *Go West, Young Men?*: LHV is just 12-16 vs. the West this season -- the only division it has a losing record against.

## NOT YET BACK TO .500:

Last night, the 'Pigs fell short in their effort to get back to .500 -- as they still have only been at .500 for just two times in LHV history... and they still have never been above .500 in 257 games... It took 220 games for Lehigh Valley to get to .500 for the first time in franchise history -- which the 'Pigs did on 6/28/09 at 38-38 after a 6-1 win vs. NOR. But then they lost two-straight games and 7 of their next 9... The 'Pigs then reeled off seven wins in their next nine contests to get back to .500 for just the second time in team history (7/19/09 at 47-47 after a 3-2 win vs. ROC). But then lost three straight and 6 of 8... LHV is 2-8 in opportunities to get to .500 this season; 2-10 in franchise history...

## With Their last Win on Saturday, the IronPigs:

- Surpassed their win total from the '08 season (55-89) -- with 31 games still remaining... The 'Pigs are still 8.0 games better from this point last season (48-66) & are on pace to finish 71-73.
- Won back-to-back games against SWB for the first time in franchise history (in 27 games).

## TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- a member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-3, 225-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 2nd round of 2006 out of Long Beach State. The Vacaville, CA, native spent a bulk of 2008 in Double-A Reading, going just 6-8 with a 5.67 ERA in 16 GS -- but was on the move in the second half, with a stint in Advanced-A Clearwater (3-3, 2.92 in 8 GS from 6/16-7/31), a ML debut with Philly (scoreless IP of relief 8/27 vs. NYM) and a start with LHV on 8/31 @ PAW (L, 7 ip 6 h, 2 er). Carpenter had a stellar 2007 season in Clearwater - where he led the Florida State League in wins (17) and shutouts (2) while being selected to play in the 2007 FSL All-Star Game. He finished the season 17-6, 3.20 with 1 SV in 27 G, 24 GS, and tied for the league lead in CG (3). Among the highlights in his three-year MILB career was a 7-inning perfect game 8/27/07 vs. Fort Myers (7 ip, 7 k). He also won both his postseason starts (2-0, 2.92) as the Threshers won the 2007 FSL Championship.

- DC -- No. 22 Prospect in system by BA -- got the 'W' in the '09 Triple-A All-Star Game (K'd 3-4-5 in 2nd on 9 pitches).
- DC won his MLB starting debut 5/16 @ WAS-G2: W\*, 4.1 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k \*Rule 10.17 (b) (2).
- Since winning his 1st ML start, DC is 8-2, 1.91 in 13 G, 12 GS w/ LHV (84.2 ip, 18 er, 71 k); SHO thru 7th in 6 GS
- Recalled by PHI from 7/23-7/25, DC appeared in 2 G out of the Phillies bullpen (1.1 ip, 3 h, 2 er, bb, k),
- DC, 8/4 @ ROC (W, 7-4): W, 6 ip, 6 h, 4 r, 2 er, bb, 6 k Up 3-0, allowed 2-R HR (D.Martin); LO E-6 led to 2 w/e R in 5th; left up 6-4

RHP **Micah Owings** -- making a ML Rehab for Cincinnati -- is a 6-5, 220-pound, 26-year-old righty acquired by the Reds as a PTBNL (9/12/08) along with Dallas Buck and Wilkin Castillo from Arizona for OF Adam Dunn on 8/14/08. The native of Cumming, GA, was drafted by the Diamondbacks in the 3rd round (83rd overall) of 2005 -- after he had been originally selected by Colorado in the 2nd round (50th overall) in the 2002 and in the 19th round (576th overall) by the CHI-N in 2003, but did not sign. Owings spent most of 2008 in the ML, going 6-9, 5.93 in 22G, 18 GS between AZ and CIN. He made his major league debut with Arizona on 4/6/07 vs. Washington (5 ip, 1 h, 0 r, 6 k) and entered the season 14-17, 4.97 in 51 G, 45 GS in the ML... Known for his exceptional hitting, Owings hit his first ML home run 7/26/07 vs. FLA (off Byung-Hyun Kim) and was the NL's 2007 Silver Slugger Award winner for P (.333-4-15)... On 4/30/08, Owings had a pinch-hit 2-run HR vs. Houston (first PH by a P in the majors in more than 4 years... since MIL's Brooks Kieschnick). He entered the season .319-5-21 in 75 ML G; .354-1-14 in 52 MiLB G.

- MO left his start, 7/26/09 vs. CHI-N after 3.0 IP and was placed on the 15-Day DL on July 27 (tight r. shoulder).
- MO is batting .229-3-9 for CIN in '09, inc. a game-tying PH, HR w/ 2-outs in 9th on 5/10/09 vs. STL (Franklin).
- MO's best start of the season came in a win 5/12 vs. AZ when he allowed just 1 R on 4 H over 7.0 solid innings.

LOU leads the season series, 4-0 -- sweeping the first series of 2009 from 6/6-6/9 at Louisville Slugger Field... LOU also won the '08 series, 5-3 -- but the two teams split at Coca-Cola Park, 2-2, from 7/6-7/9/08.

### TOUGH STRETCH:

The 'Pigs began Thursday with a stretch of 8 G vs. teams with the top 2 records in the IL (SWB, LOU) -- teams they're now 4-12 against -- and have started 2-2... Against the Top 4 teams (add DUR, GWN), LHV is 11-21; 45-37 vs. the rest.

### REHABS:

Last night, Phillies RHP **Chad Durbin** (back, DL's 7/23) made a ML rehab with LHV as the starter (n/d, 1.0 ip, 1 h, 0 r, 0 bb, k... 13 pitches)... Now tonight, the Bats will throw RHP Micah Owings on a rehab appearance for Cincinnati.

### SO SAVERY!:

Phillies' 2007 first-round pick (19th overall) LHP **Joe Savery** has now won his first 2 career Triple-A games (2-0, 2.45). The Rice University product started his season in Double-A Reading and is now a combined 14-4 this season. His win total (14) is tied for second in all of MiLB w/ two others -- one behind leader Carlos Hernandez of Stockton (CAL)... The Texas native won his Triple-A debut on 8/3 @ ROC (W, 6 ip, 4 h, 1 r, 1 er, b bb, 0 k)...

### LEAN, MEAN, FIGHTING CHACIN:

LHP **Gustavo Chacin** has won 5 of his last 6 GS (would have been 6 straight if not for a BS on 8/2, start 5 of span). Even so, he has gone 5-0, 2.82 ERA (44.2 ip, 14 er, 6 QS) in his last 7 GS...

### THREE'S A CROWD:

LHV has held sole possession of third place in the North for the last 6 days... They took their initial residence of 3rd place was for 4 days from 7/18-7/21... and have now had five stints in sole possession for a total of 15 days (last: 8/9)... Previously, the 'Pigs took their initial sole residence of 4th place for 10 days (4/16; 6/24-7/2).

### WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF **Terry Tiffie** has hit in 14 of his last 16 G (24-66, .364-3-12) and has hit in 22 of his last 26 G (38-106, .358-3-16)...

INF **David Newhan** has a 5 multi-hit G in his last 7 G (12-31, .387-0-3, 5 2B, 8 R). In his last 24 G, he's now batting .352-1-7 (31-88, 9 2B, 3B)...

OF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 17 or 19 G (25-81, .309-1-14, 5 2B) and has 13 multi-hit G in his last 27 G (37-113, .327-2-19, 9 2B, 3B)...

1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 12 of his last 14 G (16-57, .281-3-10, 3B) after a 2-36 skid... INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit in 22 of his last 25 G (28-94, .298-0-4)...

C **Paul Hoover** has hit in 11 of last 16 G (16-54, .296-0-9)...

OF **Michael Taylor** has reached safely in 19 of 23 G to start his Triple-A career... OF **Jason Ellison** has a 6-G hit streak (6-21, .286-0-4)...

### WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 8-2 with a 1.91 ERA in his last 13 G, 12 GS with LHV (84.2 ip, 18 er, 71 k)...

RHP **Jason Anderson** has been unscored upon in his last 8 G (0-0, 3 SV, 8.2 ip, 2 h, 2 bb) and 10.1 IP overall. In his last 22 G with LHV, he's gone 0-1, 1.54 and 4 SV (35.0 ip, 6 er)...

RHP **Steven Register** has been unscored upon in 10 of his last 13 G (16 ip, 4 er; 1-0, 2.25, 5 SV)...

LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 21 of last his 27 relief app's (5-1, 2.18, 45.1 ip, 11 er)...

### PITCHING FITS:

Pigs starters are 4-1, 2.83 (35 ip, 11 er) in the last 7 G... but have gone more than 6.0 IP in just 1 of the last 17 G -- as LHV has essentially had and an amazing 6 bullpen days in the last 20 G... In these 20 G, starters have combined to go 7-7, 4.62 (99.1 ip, 51 er) and the pitching staff as a whole has managed to go 9-11, 4.38 (170.2 ip, 83 er)...

### BULLPEN: TAXED BUT TICKIN!:

Including spot-starter Jake Woods, the 'Pigs bullpen has now worked 72.1 IP in the last 17 G, an average of more than 4.0 IP/G (starters have gone more than 6.0 IP just once in the last 17 G)...

Still, since June 14, the corps has gone 6-7, 2.84 (177.1 ip, 56 er) in 51 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.80 ERA (360.0 ip, 114 er) in 110 G.

### GETTIN' DEFENSIVE:

The 'Pigs have committed just 11 E in the last 30 G -- and have the best total (73 in the I.L. by 6 E ahead of BUF). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.983) and has turned an IL 2nd-best 120 double plays (SYR has 123)...

They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.

### BACON BITS:

• Since starting 23-5 (May 8), SWB has gone 40-44 -- during which time LHV has gained just 1.5 games in the standings.

• With SWB's win last night, the 'Pigs are now 8.0 GB in the North; with GWN's loss, they remain 7.5 GB of Wild Card.

• With 8 hits last night, the 'Pigs snapped their franchise record of 5 consecutive double-digit hit totals (14, 10, 11, 11, 11). They previously had 4 straight 7/8-7/11/09 and *never* had more than 3 straight in 2008.

• *Back on the Offensive:* In the last 12 G, the 'Pigs are batting .282 (120-425), averaging 4.5 R/G (54 R)... In the previous 8 G, LHV batted .255 (71-278) -- just .169 (13-77) w/ RISP -- and averaged just 2.9 R/G (23 R).
