TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (57-60) play the finale of a four-game series against the Louisville Bats (67-50) -- the Reds' top affiliate - who lead with West with the International League's best record. With a dramatic 10-9 walk-off win in 10 innings last night, the 'Pigs snapped a three-game skid and an eight game losing streak to the Bats going back to 2008 (their second longest winless streak to one team in LHV history behind a nine-gamer to Pawtucket from 4/7/08-7/4/08). Lehigh Valley is now 6-5 in its last 11 contests and, over a longer stretch, is 34-25 (.576) since 6/11... Louisville had its three-game winning streak halted; but has still emerged victorious in seven of its last 10 affairs. Since June 6 (when LOU hosted LHV), the Bats are 41-22 (.651) in their last 63 games.

* First-Pitch tonight is scheduled at 7:05 p.m. for Fireworks Night, presented by **Coors Light**... *Following the game, the 'Pigs travel to Buffalo to begin a four-game series and a six-game road trip on Friday at Coca-Cola Field.*

MYCLE CYCLE:

Last night, OF **Michael Taylor** became the first player in IronPigs history to hit for the cycle -- for or against LHV - and he did it in dramatic fashion. Trailing 9-8 in the bottom of the 9th and needing a HR for the cycle (he just missed it with his 2nd double of the game off the right-field wall in the 7th), Taylor hit a one-out, game-tying home run off RHP Logan Ondrusek -- the first run allowed by Ondrusek after starting with his Triple-A career with eight scoreless appearances. Taylor finished 5-5 with 2 2B, 3B, HR, 4 RBI and 2 R -- becoming the first 'Pigs to ever record a 5-hit game and setting a team record with 12 total bases in a game (previously 9, done by Andy Tracy twice)... One night prior, Taylor became the first IronPigs outfielder to record two assists in one inning (7-4, 7-2 in second inning).

* The cycle was the first in the IL in 2009 and the first in MiLB since former 'Pig OF **Brandon Watson** hit for one with Reno (PCL) on 7/23/09 vs. Portland (5-6, 4 R, 3 RBI). SS **Troy Tulowitzki** of Colorado hit for the last cycle in the Major Leagues two days prior to Taylor (8/10/09 vs. CHI) -- the 288th in ML history.

WESTERN WOES:

The 'Pigs are just 13-18 (.419) vs. the West Division this season -- the only division they have a losing record against.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Joe Savery** -- making his 3rd career Triple-A start -- is a 6-3, 215-pound, 23-year-old lefty drafted by Philadelphia in the first round (19th overall) in 2007 out of Rice University -- where he finished his standout career first-team All-America as a two-way player and earned his 2nd conference Player-of-the-Year award in three seasons. He led Rice through the NCAA regional with a Most Outstanding Player performance... The native of Bellaire, TX, spent 2008 with Advanced-A Clearwater, going 9-10, 4.13 in 27 G, 24 GS -- leading the Florida State League with 150.1 IP. Savery made his pro debut in 2007 with Advanced-R Williamsport (2-3, 2.73 in 7 GS) and pitched for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League following the season (1-1, 0.64 in 5 GS). He is ranked as the No. 20 prospect in the system by *Baseball America*.

- JS's 14 wins are tied for 2nd most in all MiLB w/ 2 others -- one win behind Carlos Hernandez (Stockton, 15).
- JS started '09 in Reading, going 12-4, 4.41 in 21 G, 20 GS, (CG, 112.1 ip, 111 h, 55 r, 55 er, 53 bb, 77 k, .262, 13 hr).
- After starting 0-1, 4.50 in 3 GS, Savery won 12 consecutive decisions from 4/28-7/9 in a span of 15 GS.
- Even though he managed to go 2-3, JS had an 8.46 ERA (27.2/26 er) in his last 5 GS @ REA -- raising from 3.08.
- JS, 8/8 vs. SWB (W, 4-3): W, 5 ip, 6 h, 2 r, 2 er, 4 bb, 5 k Stranded 5 in 3 IP; Up 2-0, allowed 3 1B + BB in 2-R 4th; ret'd last 5

LHP **Ben Jukich**, 26, is a 6-5, 205-pound lefty acquired by Cincinnati as the player to be named later in a trade with Oakland that sent RHP Marcus McBeth to the Reds in exchange for OF Chris Denorfia, 4/27/07. The Duluth, MN, native was originally drafted by the Athletics in the 13th round of 2006 out of Dakota Wesleyan -- where he became the first player from Great Plains Athletic Conference ever to be selected in the ML draft. Jukich spent most of 2008 with Double-A Chattanooga, going 10-4, 3.82 in 26 G, 25 GS and was the starting and winning pitcher for the North team in the Southern League All-Star Game (1ip, 0h, 0r). He also appeared in Louisville, going 1-1, 4.37 in 4 G, 3 GS. In 2007, he went a combined 11-6, 4.35 in 26 GS with Advanced-A Stockton and Advanced-A Sarasota -- where he turned in a career highlight blanked Clearwater for 7.0 hitless IP (2bb, 5k) in the first round of the FSL Playoffs, 9/4/07.

- BJ as a Starter: 6-3, 2.69 in 12 GS (73.2, 22 bb, 65 k, .236); As a Reliever: 1-2, 9.00 in 12 G (20.0 ip, .326).
- BJ last 6 G: 3-1, 1.41 in 6 GS lowering ERA from 5.86... Vs. LHV: 1-0, 6.00 in 2 G, 0 GS (3 ip, 2 er; W on 6/6).
- BJ was a tough-luck loser last time out, 3-0 on 8/7 @ ROC: L, 5 ip, 8 h, 3 r, 0 er, bb, 6 k (LOU committed 3 Es).

SERIES INFORMATION:

LOU leads the season series, 6-1 -- with an 8-game winning streak from 7/8/08-8/11/08... LOU also won the '08 series, 5-3 -- but the two teams split at Coca-Cola Park, 2-2, from 7/6-7/9/08.

TRANSACTIONS:

Today, RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** (3-1, 5.70 in 7 G, 5 GS with PHI) and RHP **Kyle Kendrick** (0-1, 5.06 in 4 G, 0 GS with PHI) were added to the IronPigs roster after both were optioned to Lehigh Valley from Philadelphia. To make room, RHP **Patrick Overholt** assigned to Reading (AA) and LHP **Brian Mazone** placed on the D.L. (turf toe). Yesterday, RHP **Joe Bisenius** was promoted from Clearwater (0.00 in 3 G); RHP **Alex Concepcion** was assigned to Reading.

WELCOME BACK STARTERS:

Today, the IronPigs added back RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** (5-4, 3.91) and RHP **Kyle Kendrick** (6-6, 3.58), who both optioned back down from Philadelphia with the activation of RHP **Chad Durbin** and RHP **Pedro Martinez**. Since these two key cogs in the Lehigh Valley departed the rotation, the 'Pigs went just 2-9 in the game started by replacements -- with the starters in those games combining to go 2-8, 5.44 (46.1 ip, 28 er).

BACON BITS:

- *Walk this Way!*: The game-winning 1B by **Miguel Cairo** (10th) gave LHV its 5th walk-off win in '09 (first since David Newhan's RBI-2B in the 9th on 7/19 vs. ROC) -- and 4th by a game-winning single. LHV has had 5 walk-off losses.
- *Extra! Extra!*: LHV is now 5-8 in extra-innings games; but the 'Pigs are 4-2 in their last 6 after starting 1-6 in extras.
- On 8/8, the 'Pigs improved to 56-57 and surpassed their win total from the '08 season (55-89) -- with 31 games still remaining... LHV is still 8.0 games better from this point last season (48-67) & are on pace to finish 70-74.
- Since starting 23-5 (May 8), SWB has gone 42-44 -- during which time LHV has gained 0.0 games in the standings.
- *Taylor-Made!*: Last night, OF **Michael Taylor** became the first LHV player to ever record 2 OF assists in the same inning (7-4, 7-2 in 2nd). Last season, **T.J. Bohn** had a record 3 OF-ASTs 8/17 vs. SWB, but in 3 separate innings.

*LOVIN' LEFTIES?:

LHV faces the 3rd straight LH starter. So far in '09, the 'Pigs are 14-13 when facing LH starters; just 43-47 when facing RH starters... Further, LHV is batting .293 (.407 SLG) .vs LHP as compared to .251 (.376 SLG) vs. RHP.

TOUGH STRETCH:

The 'Pigs began Thursday with a stretch of 8 G vs. teams with the top 2 records in the IL (SWB, LOU) -- teams they're now 5-14 against -- and have started 3-4... Against the Top 4 teams (add DUR, GWN), LHV is 12-23; 45-37 vs. the rest.

NORTH STARS?:

Following tonight's game, the 'Pigs play their remaining 26 G against the North Division. LHV is now 28-26 (.519) vs. the North in '09. This comes after faring just 22-58 (.275) in 2008... The 'Pigs have played 8 G of a stretch of 34 of their final 38 games against the North (5-3 so far)... and the 'Pigs have gone 13-7 in their last 20 division games vs. the North... LHV had/has ND foes in 50 of the final 66 G (including 10 vs. division-leading SWB).

DOUBLE-TROUBLE:

2B **David Newhan's** RBI-1B in the 7th on Mon. snapped his string in which each of his previous 6 hits were all 2Bs... All his '2-sackers' have come since he's moved to '2nd' in the order & starting playing '2nd' base. In all, Newhan has 6 multi-hit games in his last 10 G (14-37, .378-0-4, 6 2B, 8 R). In his last 26 G, he's batting .351-1-8 (33-94, 10 2B, 3B).

LEAN, MEAN, FIGHTING CHACIN:

Even after getting roughed-up Wed. (4.1 ip, 6 er, LHP **Gustavo Chacin** has won 5 of his last 7 GS (would've had 6 straight if not for a BS on 8/2, Start #5 of span). Even so, he's gone 5-0, 3.67 (49 ip, 20 er, 6 QS) in his last 8 GS...

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **Michael Taylor** has hit in 4 of the last 5 G (10-19, .526-1-4, 2 2B, 2 BB); with the first cycle in LHV history in 8/12 vs. LOU (5-5, 4 RBI, 2 R). He's now reached safely in 22 of 26 G to start his Triple-A career...OF **John Mayberry** has hit in 8 of 9 G (11-32, .344-0-1, 2 2B)... INF **Terry Tiffee** has hit in 16 of his last 19 G (26-78, .333-3-13) and in 24 of his last 29 G (40-118, .339-3-17)... OF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 19 or 22 G (27-91, .297-1-15, 5 2B) and has 13 multi-hit G in his last 30 G (39-123, .317-2-20, 9 2B, 3B)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 13 of his last 16 G (17-62, .275-3-10, 3B) after a 2-36 skid... INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit in 24 of his last 28 G (33-106, .311-1-9)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 8-3 with a 2.16 ERA in his last 14 G, 13 GS with LHV (91.2 ip, 22 er, 78 k)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has not allowed an earned run in his last 9 G (0-0, 3 SV, 10.2 ip, 3 h, r, 3 bb) and in 12.1 IP overall. In his last 23 G with LHV, he's gone 0-1, 1.46 and 4 SV (37.0 ip, 6 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 21 of last his 27 relief app's (5-1, 2.18, 45.1 ip, 11 er)...

BULLPEN: TAXED BUT TICKIN!:

Including spot-starter Jake Woods, the 'Pigs bullpen has now worked 82.1 IP in the last 20 G, an average of approximately 4.0 IP/G (starters have gone more than 6.0 IP just three times in the last 20 G)... Still, since June 14, the corps has gone 7-7, 2.79 (187.1 ip, 58 er) in 54 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.82 ERA (370.0 ip, 116 er) in 113 G.

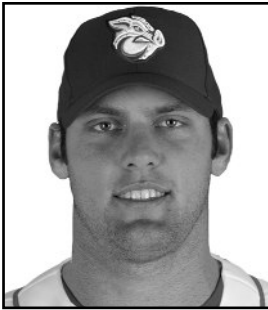
