TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (57-61) start a six-game road trip with Game One of a four-game series against the Buffalo Bisons (45-70) -- the Mets' top affiliate -- who are last in the North with the International League's worst record. With a 12-8 loss to Louisville last night, the 'Pigs dropped the series to the Bats, 3-1. Lehigh Valley is just 6-6 in its last 12 contests, but, over a longer stretch, is 34-26 (.567) since 6/11... Buffalo lost 9-4 against Rochester last night to fall in a five-game series, 3-2. Still, the Bisons have gone 5-3 in their last eight affairs following a six-game losing streak 7/31-8/6 -- and have played .500 baseball (17-17) since July 8...First-Pitch is 7:35 p.m. at Coca-Cola Field in Buffalo.

• With SWB's loss last night, the 'Pigs remain 9.5 GB in the North; with DUR's win, they're now 8.5 GB of Wild Card.

TOUGH STRETCH:

The 'Pigs just finished a stretch of 8 G vs. teams with the top 2 records in the IL (SWB, LOU) -- going just 3-5 (they're now 5-15 against those two teams)... Against the Top 4 teams (add DUR, GWN), LHV is just 12-24; 45-37 vs. the rest.

NORTH STARS?:

The 'Pigs now play their remaining 26 G against the North Division. LHV is 28-26 (.519) vs. the North in '09. This comes after faring just 22-58 (.275) in 2008... The 'Pigs have already played an 8-G stretch of 34 of their final 38 games against the North and have gone 5-3 so far... and the 'Pigs have gone 13-7 in their last 20 division games vs. the North... LHV had/has ND foes in 50 of the final 66 G (including 10 vs. division-leading SWB).

ROAD WARRIORS?:

The 'Pigs went 4-2 on their previous 6-game road trip 8/1-8/7 (3-1 @ ROC; 1-1 @ SWB) and are 16-13 (.552) in their 19 on the road.... This includes a rough 2-6 South Division road trip 7/20-7/27 through Charlotte and Gwinnett.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** -- a member of the 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-1, 187-pound, 33-year-old righty signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent on 3/5/09. A native of Mexico, Lopez missed most of 2008 recovering from "Tommy John" surgery 8/22/07. He was signed by Atlanta exactly one year later (8/22/08), and made two starts in the GCL (3 ip, 0 er) and in Single-A Rome (0-1, 2 ip, 9 er). Lopez was the runner-up for the 2002 A.L. Rookie of the Year (Eric Hinske) and twice won 15 games for Baltimore before being traded to Colorado for Jason Burch and Jim Miller, 1/12/07. Additional accolades for Lopez include representing Mexico in the 2006 World Baseball Classic (0-2, 3.86). Originally signed as a minor league free agent by San Diego on 3/21/95, Lopez has logged more than six years of ML service and has a career mark of 65-65, 4.80 (187 g, 161 gs, 1016.2 ip, 1113 h, 542 er, 315 bb, 674 k).

- RL was on D.L. (shoulder) from 4/19-27... His win 4/28 @ SWB was first since 7/7/07 (COL d. PHI, 6-3, at CBP).
- RL was promoted to PHI from 7/3-8/10, going 3-1, 5.70 in 7 G, 5 GS (last: 8/9 vs. FLA, n/d, 0.2 ip, 3 h, 6 er)
- Prior to promotion, RL had a 3-G win streak w/ LHV (3-0, 0.86, 21 ip, 19 h, 2 er) after going 0-2, 7.86 in prev. 4 GS.
- RL, 5/25 @ BUF (L, 8-7): n/d, 3.1 ip, 9 h, 5 r, 5 er, bb, 2 k Up 4-0, first 5 BF in 3rd reached in a 5-R inning (on 6 h); left up 6-5

RHP **Lance Broadway** -- a member of the Mets' 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-3, 190-pound, 25-year-old righty acquired by New York from the White Sox for C Ramon Castro and cash considerations on 5/30/09. The Dallas native was originally selected by Chicago in the 1st round (15th overall) of 2005 out of Texas Christian University -- where he went 15-1, 1.62 as a senior and was named Conference USA Male Athlete of the Year & Pitcher of the Year (led all D-I pitchers in wins). Broadway spent the majority of 2008 with Charlotte (11-7, 4.66 in 24 G, 23 GS) and had 3 stints with the White Sox (1-0, 7.07 in 7 G, 1 GS). He won his lone start 8/14/08 vs. KC (5.1 ip, 2 er)... Broadway made his ML debut 9/7/07 vs. MIN (0.2 ip, 0 er) and later won his first (and only) 2007 start 9/27 vs. KC (6 ip, 2 h, 0 r, 8 k) and finished 1-1, 0.87 in 4 G, 1 GS with CHI after spending the entire MILB season with CHA (8-9, 4.65 in 26 GS). A 2006 Southern League mid-season All-Star, Broadway threw the first no-hitter in Northwoods League history as an amateur.

- Broadway started '09 in CHA (0-2, 5.63 in 3 GS) before a stint w/ CHI-A (0-1, 5.06 in 8 G, 0 GS) from 4/28-5/21.
- Broadway wasn't sharp, but won his last start, 12-8 on 8/9 @ COL: W, 6.2 ip, 10 h, 6 r, 6 er, bb, k, hr (Barfield).

BLOWN LEADS:

The 'Pigs blew leads of 1-0, 7-4 and 8-7 last night -- with their 7th blown lead when leading after 7 and their 29th blown lead loss of year... The 'Pigs lead the IL in losses when leading after 5 inn (11), 6 inn (10), 7 inn (7) & 8 (5) inn.

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the season series, 5-2... The team split in '08, 8-8, with BUF winning 5 of the last 7 G vs. LHV -- of course, that was when BUF was a CLE affiliate. LHV was 5-3 at Coca-Cola Park; BUF was 5-3 at then-Dunn Tire Park.

• Close Calls: The Bisons & 'Pigs have played 7 G in '09 -- they've been decided by a total of 16 R (1, 1, 1, 2, 2, 3, 6).

TRANSACTIONS:

Today, C **Tuffy Gosewisch** was promoted to LHV from Double-A Reading, where we was batting .244-1-20 in 59 G... To make room, C **Kevin Nelson** was assigned to Reading... Yesterday, RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** (3-1, 5.70 in 7 G, 5 GS with PHI) and RHP **Kyle Kendrick** (0-1, 5.06 in 4 G, 0 GS with PHI) were added to the IronPigs roster after both were optioned to Lehigh Valley from Philadelphia. To make room, RHP **Patrick Overholt** assigned to Reading (AA) and LHP **Brian Mazone** placed on the D.L. (turf toe). Wednesday, RHP **Joe Bisenius** was promoted from Clearwater (0.00 in 3 G); RHP **Alex Concepcion** was assigned to Reading.

WELCOME BACK STARTERS:

Today, the IronPigs added back RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** (5-4, 3.91) and RHP **Kyle Kendrick** (6-6, 3.58), who both optioned back down from Philadelphia with the activation of RHP **Chad Durbin** and RHP **Pedro Martinez**. Since these two key cogs in the Lehigh Valley departed the rotation, the 'Pigs went just 2-9 in the game started by replacements -- with the starters in those games combining to go 2-8, 5.44 (46.1 ip, 28 er).

MYCLE CYCLE:

Last night, OF **Michael Taylor** became the first player in IronPigs history to hit for the cycle -- for or against LHV - and he did it in dramatic fashion. Trailing 9-8 in the bottom of the 9th and needing a HR for the cycle (he just missed it with his 2nd double of the game off the right-field wall in the 7th), Taylor hit a one-out, game-tying home run off RHP Logan Ondrusek -- the first run allowed by Ondrusek after starting with his Triple-A career with eight scoreless appearances. Taylor finished 5-5 with 2 2B, 3B, HR, 4 RBI and 2 R -- becoming the first 'Pigs to ever record a 5-hit game and setting a team record with 12 total bases in a game (previously 9, done by Andy Tracy twice)... One night prior, Taylor became the first IronPigs outfielder to record two assists in one inning (7-4, 7-2 in second inning).

• The cycle was the first in the IL in 2009 and the first in MiLB since former 'Pig OF **Brandon Watson** hit for one with Reno (PCL) on 7/23/09 vs. Portland (5-6, 4 R, 3 RBI). SS **Troy Tulowitzki** of Colorado hit for the last cycle in the Major Leagues two days prior to Taylor (8/10/09 vs. CHI) -- the 288th in ML history.

LEAN, MEAN, FIGHTING CHACIN:

Even after getting roughed-up Wed. (4.1 ip, 6 er, LHP **Gustavo Chacin** has won 5 of his last 7 GS (would've had 6 straight if not for a BS on 8/2, Start #5 of span). Even so, he's gone 5-0, 3.67 (49 ip, 20 er, 6 QS) in his last 8 GS...

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **Jason Ellison** has hit in his last 3 G (7-14, .500-0-1, 4 R) & in last 9 GS (13-35, .371-0-5, 6 R). At .255, he's at his highest AVG of season (prev. .253 on 5/10)... OF **Michael Taylor** has hit in 4 of the last 6 G (10-23, .435-1-4, 2 2B, 2 BB); with the first cycle in LHV history in 8/12 vs. LOU (5-5, 4 RBI, 2 R). He's now reached safely in 23 of 27 G to start his Triple-A career... 2B **David Newhan** has 6 multi-hit games in his last 11 G (14-42, .333-0-4, 6 2B, 9 R). In his last 28 G, he's batting .337-1-8 (33-98, 10 2B, 3B)... OF **John Mayberry** has hit in 8 of 10 G (11-35, .314-0-1, 2 2B)... INF **Terry Tiffee** has hit in 17 of last 20 G (28-82, .331-3-13) and in 25 of his last 30 G (42-122, .344-3-17)... OF **Mike Cervenak** has 13 multi-hit G in his last 31 G (39-124, .315-2-20, 9 2B, 3B)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 14 of his last 17 G (19-65, .292-4-15, 3B) after a 2-36 skid... INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit in 25 of last 29 G (34-110, .309-1-10)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 8-3 with a 2.16 ERA in his last 14 G, 13 GS with LHV (91.2 ip, 22 er, 78 k)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has not allowed an earned run in his last 9 G (0-0, 3 SV, 10.2 ip, 3 h, r, 3 bb) and in 12.1 IP overall. In his last 23 G with LHV, he's gone 0-1, 1.46 and 4 SV (37.0 ip, 6 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 21 of last his 27 relief app's (5-1, 2.18, 45.1 ip, 11 er)...

BULLPEN: TAXED BUT TICKIN':

Including spot-starter Jake Woods, the 'Pigs bullpen has now worked 85.2 IP in the last 21 G, an average of approximately 4.0 IP/G (starters have gone more than 6.0 IP just three times in the last 21 G)... Perhaps the wear-n-tear is showing, as the corps in 1-2, 5.49 (21.1 ip, 13 er) and 2 BS in the last 5 G... Still, since June 14, the corps has a 2.97 ERA (190.2 ip, 63 er) in 55 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.92 ERA (373.1 ip, 121 er) in 114 G.

GETTIN' DEFENSIVE:

The 'Pigs have committed just 15 E in the last 34 G -- and have the best total (78 in the I.L. by 5 E ahead of SWB). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.982) and has turned an IL-best 126 double plays (SYR also has 126)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.

BACON BITS:

• Long Ones vs. LOU: Last night's game was the longest 9-inning G for LHV this season -- 3:34, following a 3:38 10-inning affair Wed. The pair of games featured: 39 runs, 53 hits, 9 errors (all 2009 2-G highs) and 8 lead changes.
• On 8/8, the 'Pigs improved to 56-57 and surpassed their win total from the '08 season (55-89) -- with 31 games still remaining... LHV is still 8.0 games better from this point last season (49-69) & are on pace to finish 70-74.

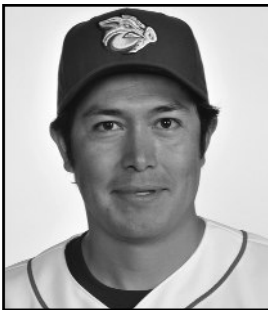
