## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (58-63) play the finale of a four-game series against the Buffalo Bisons (47-71) -- the Mets' top affiliate -- who are last in the North with the International League's worst record. With a 3-0 loss yesterday, the 'Pigs have lost two in a row to the Bisons following their four-game winning streak over Buffalo. Lehigh Valley is just 7-8 in its last 15 contests; but, over a longer stretch, is still 35-28 (.555) since 6/11... Buffalo is now 7-4 in its last 11 affairs and has played above .500 baseball (19-18) since July 8... First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m. at Coca-Cola Field...

- With SWB's loss last night, the 'Pigs remain 9.5 GB in the North; with DUR's win, they're now 9.5 GB of Wild Card.
- LHV was SHO for the 8th time in '09 (last: 8/6 @ SWB) -- 7 of the 8 have come on road. They were SHO 8x in '08.
- The 'Pigs need a win tonight to avoid falling 6 G below .500 for the first time since June 18 (30-36, 55 G ago).

## TAYLOR NAMED IL BATTER-OF-WEEK TODAY:

IronPigs OF **Michael Taylor** was near the top of the IL in several offensive categories this week, setting several new records for the LHV franchise along the way. Though he collected hits in just three of his six games, Taylor posted a .417 AVG (10th) with 2 HR (T-4th), 8 RBI (T-4th), 5 extra-base hits (T-5th), and a .833 SLG (5th). The first bit of history came Tuesday night, when Taylor became the first LHV outfielder to record two assists in one inning. The next evening, Taylor used his bat to make more LHV history. Going 5-5 with 2 doubles, a triple, a homer, and 4 RBI, Taylor became the franchise's first player to hit for the cycle. He also established new team records with 5 hits and 12 total bases. The cycle could hardly have come in more dramatic fashion, as the home run tied the game at 9-9 with one out in the bottom of the 9th (the 'Pigs won 10-9 in 10 innings). Taylor also homered and drove in four more runs over the weekend at Buffalo.

Taylor becomes just the 2nd LHV batter to win the award, following 1B **Andy Tracy**, who has won thrice(2008-09).

## TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Gustavo Chacin** -- making his 15th start as an IronPig -- is a 5-11, 207-pound, 28-year-old lefty signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 4/6/09 (he had been released by Washington at the end of Spring Training). After undergoing surgery for a slight tear in his labrum on 8/29/07, the native of Maracaibo, VZ, spent 2008 battling injuries rehabbing for Toronto in Single-A Dunedin (1-7, 7.88 in 11 GS before a season-ending ACL tear). Chacin last pitched in MLB for Toronto in 2007, and went 25-15, 4.18 in a 4-year stint with the Jays. He made his ML debut 9/20/04 at NYY and became the 7th Jay to win his first start (7 ip, 3 er). In his rookie season of '05, Chacin went 13-9, 3.72 in 34 GS and led TOR with 121 SO. The 13 wins set a team rookie record for starting pitchers and he was AL Rookie of the Month twice (April: 2-1, 2.48 in 5 GS; and July: 5-0, 2.97 in 6 GS) and became the fastest Blue Jay to ever reach the 10-win plateau. Chacin emerged in MiLB in 2004, when he went 16-2, 2.86 in 25 with New Hampshire and was an Eastern League post-season All-Star. Originally signed by TOR as a non-drafted free agent 7/3/98, he worked hand-and-hand with fragrance experts to concoct *Chacin Cologne* for a team promotion.

- GC started in Reading (1-0, 3.21, 2 G, 1 GS): winning his lone 5/23 @ ALT (5 ip, er) -- his first win since 6/4/08 @ FTM.
- GC, 8/12 vs. LOU (W, 10-9): n/d, 4.1 ip, 7 h, 6 r, 6 er, 3 bb, 4 k Up 4-1, 3 LO BB in 4th led to 4 R; KO'd by RBI-2B in 5th; left d 6-4

**LEAN, MEAN, FIGHTING CHACIN:** Even after getting roughed-up last start, **Chacin** has won 5 of his last 7 GS (would've had 6 straight if not for a BS on 8/2, Start #5 of span). Even so, he's 5-0, 3.67 (49 ip, 20 er, 6 QS) in his last 8 GS...

RHP **Kyle Snyder**, 31, is a 6-8, 222-pound righty signed by New York as a minor league free agent 1/26/09. Originally drafted first-round (7th overall) by Kansas City in 1999 out of University of North Carolina, the Sarasota native started last season in Boston's bullpen (2 g, 0-0, 21.60) before being designated and assigned to Pawtucket (1-4, 5.26 in 14 G, 7 GS). He had two separated stints on the FL (rt. groin) and rehabbed with the GCL Red Sox (0-0, 3.38 in 6 G, 3 GS) and Advanced Rookie Lowell (0-0, 0.00 in 1 GS). Snyder has had a career beset by injuries -- missing most of 2000 and 2001 due to a right elbow injury (had Tommy John surgery 9/7/00), much of 2003 (rt. shoulder surgery) all of 2004 (torn labrum). Through it all, he made his ML debut 5/1/03 at Boston (n/d, 5.0 ip, 1 er) and earned his first ML win 6/4/03 at LAD (6.0 ip, 1 er). He went 1-6, 5.17 in 15 GS as a rookie before the injuries again took their toll. His best year came in 2007 with Boston, when he finished 2-3, 3.81 in 46 G, 0 GS and was added to the Red Sox World Series Roster (though he didn't appear in the 4-G sweep of Colorado). In all, he is 8-17, 5.57 in 93 G, 29 GS in 4.047 years of ML service time.

### SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the season series, 6-4 (4-3 in BUF). The team split in '08, 8-8, with BUF winning 5 of the last 7 G vs. LHV -- of course, that was when BUF was a CLE affiliate. LHV was 5-3 at CCP; BUF was 5-3 at then-Dunn Tire Park.

• *Close Calls?*: Eight of the first 10 G between Bisons & 'Pigs have been decided by 1-3 R (1, 1, 1, 2, 2, 3, 3).

### NORTH STARS!:

The 'Pigs final 26 G are against the North Division -- and they have started 1-2. LHV is 29-28 (.509) vs. the North in '09. This comes after faring just 22-58 (.275) in 2008... In fact, the 'Pigs have gone 14-9 (.609) in their last 22 division games vs. the North... LHV had/has ND foes in 50 of the final 66 G (including 10 vs. division-leading SWB).

### ROAD WARRIORS:

The 'Pigs are 5-4 in last 9 road G (went 4-2 on their prev. 6-G road trip 8/1-8/7; 3-1 @ ROC, 1-1 @ SWB) and are now 17-15 (.531) in their last 33 G on the road.... This includes a rough 2-6 South road trip 7/20-7/27 (CHA & GWN).

### BACON BITS, PT. 1:

• *Night Owls?*: The 'Pigs are now just 10-19 (.345) in day games in 2009... and 48-44 in night games.

• *Giving up the Hits*: The 'Pigs staff has allowed 36 hits in the 2 G vs. BUF (36-98. **367**)... But last night, allowed just 7 hits snapping the franchise-record allowing 8-straight double-digit hit totals. During those 8 G, opponents batted .352 (103-293) and averaged 6.2 R/G (49).

• Since the trade of C **Lou Marson** (7/30), the 'Pigs staff is 7-9, 4.58 ERA (151.1 ip, 77 er) & .312 OBA (184-590)... Prior, they had a 3.75 ERA (908 ip, 378 er) and a .258 OBA (887-3436) in the first 105 G of 2009.

• *Paul Ball? (high-scoring affairs)*: The 'Pigs 4 G from 8/12-8/15 featured: 69 runs, 100 hits, 15 errors...

### .500 ALLERGY:

On 8/9, the 'Pigs fell short in their effort to get back to .500 -- as they still have only been at .500 for just two times in LHV history... and they still have never been above .500 in **265** games... It took 220 games for Lehigh Valley to get to .500 for the first time in franchise history -- which the 'Pigs did on 6/28/09 at 38-38 after a 6-1 win vs. NOR. But then they lost two-straight games and 7 of their next 9... The 'Pigs then reeled off seven wins in their next nine contests to get back to .500 for just the second time in team history (7/19/09 at 47-47 after a 3-2 win vs. ROC). But then lost three straight and 6 of 8... LHV is 2-8 in opportunities to get to .500 this season; 2-10 in franchise history...

### WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **Jason Ellison** has hit in his 4 of his last 5 G (8-20, .400-0-1, 4 R) & in last 10 GS (14-40, .350-0-5, 6 R)... OF **Michael Taylor** has hit in 5 of the last 8 G (13-31, .419-2-8, 2 2B, 2 BB); with the first cycle in LHV history in 8/12 vs. LOU (5-5, 4 RBI, 2 R). He's now reached safely in 24 of 29 G to start his Triple-A career... 1B **Andy Tracy** has 2 HR and 9 RBI in his last 4 G (5-11, 5 R, 6 BB). He's also hit in 16 of his last 20 G (22-73, .301-5-19, 3B) after a 2-36 skid... 2B **David Newhan** has 6 multi-hit games in his last 13 G (15-49, .306-0-5, 6 2B, 10 R). In his last 30 G, he's batting .324-1-11 (34-105, 10 2B, 3B)... OF **John Mayberry** has hit in 10 of 13 G (13-46, .283-1-3, 2 2B)... INF **Terry Tiffee** has hit in 17 of last 22 G (28-86, .326-3-13) and in 29 of last 37 G (48-147, .327-3-18, 6 2B)... In his last 32 G, OF **Mike Cervenak** in batting .313-2-21 (41-131, 9 2B, 3B) with 13 multi-hit G...

### WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 8-4 with a 2.67 ERA in his last 15 G, 14 GS with LHV (97.2 ip, 29 er, 83 k)... RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** has won 4 straight starts for LHV, going 4-0, 2.08 (26 ip, 6 er) -- he's now one win away from tying LHP Gustavo Chacin's record of winning 5 straight GS... RHP **Jason Anderson** has not allowed an earned run in his last 9 G (0-0, 3 SV, 10.2 ip, 3 h, r, 3 bb) and in 12.1 IP overall. In his last 23 G with LHV, he's gone 0-1, 1.46 and 4 SV (37.0 ip, 6 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 21 of last his 28 relief app's (5-1, 2.19, 2 SV, 49.1 ip, 12 er)... LHP **Cedrick Bowers** has been unscored upon in his last 7 G (1-0, 2 H, 7.0 ip, 0 R)...

### WELCOME BACK STARTERS:

This week, the IronPigs added back RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** (6-4, 4.13) and RHP **Kyle Kendrick** (6-6, 3.58) -- who both optioned back down from Philadelphia -- and have started 1-1 in games with them on the mound. Since these two key cogs in the rotation, the 'Pigs went just 2-9 in the game started by replacements -- with the starters in those games combining to go 2-8, 5.44 (46.1 ip, 28 er).

### BULLPEN: TAXED BUT TICKIN!:

Including spot-starter Jake Woods, the 'Pigs bullpen has now worked 91.2 IP in the last 23 G, an average of approximately 4.0 IP/G (starters have gone more than 6.0 IP just three times in the last 23 G)... Perhaps the wear-n-tear is showing, as the corps in 1-2, 4.28 (27.1 ip, 13 er) and 2 BS in the last 7 G... Still, since June 14, the corps has a 2.88 ERA (196.2 ip, 63 er) in 57 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.87 ERA (379.1 ip, 121 er) in 117 G.

### GETTIN' DEFENSIVE:

The 'Pigs have committed just 19 E in the last 37 G -- and have the best total (81 in the I.L. by 4 E ahead of SWB). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.982) and has turned an IL-best 132 double plays (SYR also has 128)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.
