TONIGHT'S GAMES:

After a postponement in Moosic last night, the IronPigs (58-65) return home for a doubleheader in what is now a three-game series versus first-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (68-52) -- the Yankees' top affiliate. With a 10-5 loss on Tuesday, the 'Pigs have lost four straight games -- and eight of their last 10 contests -- finishing just 1-4 on the road trip. Still, over a longer stretch, LHV remains 35-30 (.538) since 6/11... The Yankees are now 6-3 in their last nine affairs following their 10-13 skid. Since starting 23-5 (May 8), SWB has gone just 45-47 -- during which time LHV has actually lost 2.0 games in the standings...

- First-pitch is now **6:05 p.m.** for Poster Night, presented by **Partnership for a Tobacco-Free Northeast PA.**
- *Double-Trouble?*: The 'Pigs had their first DH sweep of 2009 in their last twinbill, 7/18 vs. ROC (7-5, 6-3). In all, the 'Pigs are 3-5 in DH games -- swept 5/14 @ COL and 7/3 vs. SYR (Day-Night); split 6/4 @ IND.
- *Dog Days of Summer*: LHV is now 7-10 in August after finishing 7-23 in the month in '08 -- now 14-33 (.298).

With Tuesday's Loss, the IronPigs:

- Fell to 7 games below .500 for first time since 6/17 (29-36) and 11.5 GB for the first time since 6/16.
- Have a four-game losing streak for the first time since being swept in 4 G at LOU, 6/6-6/9/09 (a span of 64 G).
- Have a four-game losing streak to the North since being swept by SWB in Opening Series (4/9-4/12/09).

The 'Pigs Need a Win Tonight:

- To avoid falling to 8 games below .500 for first time since 6/16 (28-36) -- 59 games ago.
- Fall back to their season-high of 12.5 GB in the North for the first time since 5/30 -- 75 games ago.
- To avoid their first five-game losing streak since their season-high 7-game skid 5/11-5/18 -- 86 games ago.
- To avoid their first five-game losing streak to the North in '09 (they lost 7 in a row 8/30/08-4/12/09).

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS (G2 STARTERS ON PAGE 2):

RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** -- is a 6-1, 187-pound, 33-year-old righty signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent on 3/5/09. A native of Mexico, Lopez missed most of 2008 recovering from "Tommy John" surgery 8/22/07. He was signed by Atlanta exactly one year later (8/22/08), and made two starts in the GCL (3 ip, 0 er) and in Single-A Rome (0-1, 2 ip, 9 er). Lopez was the runner-up for the 2002 A.L. Rookie of the Year (Eric Hinske) and twice won 15 games for Baltimore before being traded to Colorado for Jason Burch and Jim Miller, 1/12/07. Additional accolades for Lopez include representing Mexico in the 2006 World Baseball Classic (0-2, 3.86). Originally signed as a minor league free agent by San Diego on 3/21/95, Lopez has logged more than six years of ML service and has a career mark of 65-65, 4.80 (187 g, 161 gs, 1016.2 ip, 1113 h, 542 er, 315 bb, 674 k).

- *RL, 8/14 @ BUF (W, 12-6): W, 5 ip, 11 h, 5 r, 4 er, 0 bb, 2 k Up 4-0, LO 1B led to R in 1st; allowed Rs in 3rd, 4th, 5th stranding 5*

Going for a Record: With a win tonight, RL will become the first 'Pig to win 5 straight GS -- going 4-0, 2.08 in his last 4 GS (26.0 ip, 6 er). He's tied the record of 4 by Carlos Carrasco (6/15-7/2) and Gustavo Chacin (7/9-7/28).

RHP **Ivan Nova**, 22, is a 6-4, 210-pound righty signed by New York as a non-drafted free agent on 7/15/04. The San Cristobal, D.R., spent 2008 in Tampa, going 8-13, 4.36 in 26 G, 24 GS (148.2 ip, 168 h, 72 er, 46 bb, 109 k, .294).

- *IN started '09 in Double-A Trenton, going 5-4, 2.36, 12 GS (72.1 ip, 65 h, 27 r, 19 er, 31 bb, 47 k, .244).*
- *IN didn't figure in the decision of his last start, a 9-5 SWB win 8/14 @ DUR: n/d, 4.1 ip, 9 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k.*

SERIES INFORMATION:

SWB leads the 2009 series, 9-4 -- and overall series, 23-6 (.791). The Yanks won 8 straight G from 8/16/08 (4) through 4/12/09 (4). Of note: the Triple-A Yanks Spring Training team was 4-0 vs. the Phils' this exhibition season.

TAYLOR NAMED IL BATTER-OF-WEEK MONDAY... BUT:

OF Michael Taylor was has not played since his final AB on Saturday (P-4) due to a strained rt. oblique (day-to-day).

TAXED BULLPEN:

Including spot-starter Jake Woods, the 'Pigs bullpen has now worked 96.0 IP in the last 25 G, an average of approximately 4.0 IP/G (starters have gone more than 6.0 IP just three times in the last 24 G)... Perhaps the wear-n-tear is showing, as the corps in 1-3, 7.11 (31.2 ip, 25 er) and 3 BS in the last 9 G... Still, since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 3.12 ERA (383.2 ip, 133 er) in 119 G.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS (G2 STARTERS ON PAGE 2):

RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- a member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-3, 225-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 2nd round of 2006 out of Long Beach State. The Vacaville, CA, native spent a bulk of 2008 in Double-A Reading, going just 6-8 with a 5.67 ERA in 16 GS -- but was on the move in the second half, with a stint in Advanced-A Clearwater (3-3, 2.92 in 8 GS from 6/16-7/31), a ML debut with Philly (scoreless IP of relief 8/27 vs. NYM) and a start with LHV on 8/31 @ PAW (L, 7 ip 6 h, 2 er). Carpenter had a stellar 2007 season in Clearwater - - where he led the Florida State League in wins (17) and shutouts (2) while being selected to play in the 2007 FSL All-Star Game. He finished the season 17-6, 3.20 with 1 SV in 27 G, 24 GS, and tied for the league lead in CG (3). Among the highlights in his three-year MILB career was a 7-inning perfect game 8/27/07 vs. Fort Myers (7 ip, 7 k). He also won both his postseason starts (2-0, 2.92) as the Threshers won the 2007 FSL Championship.

- DC -- No. 22 Prospect in system by BA -- got the 'W' in the '09 Triple-A All-Star Game (K'd 3-4-5 in 2nd on 9 pitches).
- DC won his MLB starting debut 5/16 @ WAS-G2: W*, 4.1 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k *Rule 10.17 (b) (2).
- Since winning his 1st ML start, DC is 8-4, 2.67 in 15 G, 14 GS w/ LHV (97.2 ip, 29 er, 83 k); SHO thru 7th in 6 GS
- Recalled by PHI from 7/23-7/25, DC appeared in 2 G out of the Phillies bullpen (1.1 ip, 3 h, 2 r, 2 er, bb, k),
- Last 2 G: 0-2, 7.62 ERA (13 ip, 20 h, 11 r, 11 er, 2 bb, 12 k, 3 hr, .364); First 19 G: 9-2, 2.72 ERA, .245 OBA

LHP **Kei Igawa**, 30, is a 6-1, 210-pound lefty out of Ibaraki, Japan. He signed with New York on a 5-year, 20-million dollar contract on 12/27/06 after the Yankees were the highest bidders once Igawa was posted by the Hanshin Tigers (11/16/06). He spent most of 2008 in SWB, going 14-6, 3.45 in 26 G, 24 GS; making his lone start for NY on 5/9/08 (L, 3 ip, 11 h, 6 r) and finishing 0-1, 13.50 in 2 G, 1 GS. In his first year in the U.S., Igawa started with NY and went 2-3, 6.25 in 14G, 12GS over three stints (4/2-5/7; 6/22-7/27; 9/9-9/30)... A No. 2 draft choice of the Hanshin Tigers in 1998, Igawa spent a couple of years in the Hanshin minor league system prior to entering the rotation in 2001. In his first full season season as a starter, Igawa went 9-13 for the last-placed Tigers, but finished with a Central League second-best 2.67 ERA. In 2002, he improved to 14-9 and finished third in ERA (2.49), while leading the CL with 206 K. In 2003, the Tigers won the CL pennant and Igawa won the MVP -- going 20-5, 2.80 and ranking 3rd with 179 strikeouts. He also won the Sawamura Award (Japanese equivalent of the Cy Young Award).

In eight seasons in Japan, we went 86-60 with a 3.14 ERA in 190 G (1244 ip, 1174 k) while leading in Ks three times (2002, '04, '06) and appearing in the Nippon Professional Baseball All-Star Game thrice (2001, '02, '03).

• *Giving up the Hits:* The 'Pigs staff has allowed 14 more hits last night and has yielded 62 hits in the 5 G (62-166, .373)... Until holding BUF to 7 hits on Sunday, the 'Pigs had allowed a franchise-record 8-straight double-digit hit totals. During those 8 G, opponents batted .352 (103-293) and averaged 6.2 R/G (49).

• Since the trade of C **Lou Marson** (7/30), the 'Pigs staff is 7-11, 5.16 ERA (167.1 ip, 96 er) & .319 OBA (210-658)... Prior, they had a 3.75 ERA (908 ip, 378 er) and a .258 OBA (887-3436) in the first 105 G of 2009.

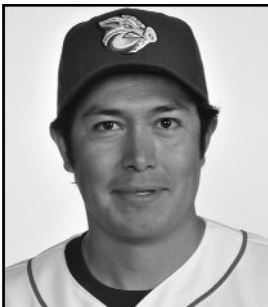
