TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (52-56) play Game Three of a four-game series against the Rochester Red Wings (50-55) -- Minnesota's top affiliate -- with whom they are tied for third in the North Division. With a 4-3 loss in walk-off fashion last night, the 'Pigs snapped their five-game winning streak against Rochester and have now dropped nine of their last 14 contests. Still, over a longer stretch, Lehigh Valley is 29-21 (.580) since 6/11... Rochester previously split a four-game series at Gwinnett -- but the Wings are just 6-12 since the All-Star Break. First-pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m.

- With SWB's win last night, the 'Pigs are now 9.0 GB in the North; with GWN's win, they're now 8.5 GB of Wild Card.
- *Suspension:* OF Jason Ellison will begin a three-game IL suspension tonight from an ejection on 7/31 (Burke).

NORTHERN BOUND:

Prior to this series, the 'Pigs finished a stretch of 12 straight games out of the North, finishing just 4-8 (.333)... They're in Game Three of a stretch of 32 of their final 36 games against the North... and the 'Pigs have gone 9-5 in their last 14 division games are now 24-24 (.500) vs. the North in '09 -- after faring just 22-58 (.275) in '08.... LHV had/has ND foes in 50 of the final 66 G (including 10 vs. division-leading SWB).

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Joe Savery** -- making his Triple-A debut -- is a 6-3, 215-pound, 23-year-old lefty drafted by Philadelphia in the first round (19th overall) in 2007 out of Rice University -- where he finished his standout career first-team All-America as a two-way player and earned his 2nd conference Player-of-the-Year award in three seasons. He led Rice through the NCAA regional with a Most Outstanding Player performance... The native of Bellaire, TX, spent 2008 with Advanced-A Clearwater, going 9-10, 4.13 in 27 G, 24 GS -- leading the Florida State League with 150.1 IP. Savery made his pro debut in 2007 with Advanced-R Williamsport (2-3, 2.73 in 7 GS) and pitched for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League following the season (1-1, 0.64 in 5 GS). He is ranked as the No. 20 prospect in the system by *Baseball America*.

- *After starting 0-1, 4.50 in 3 GS, Savery won 12 consecutive decisions from 4/28-7/9 in a span of 15 GS.*
- *Even though he managed a 2-3 record, JS had an 8.46 ERA (27.2 ip, 26 er) in his last 5 GS -- raising from 3.08.*
- *GC, 7/28 vs. COL (W, 4-2): W, 6 ip, 4 h, 1 r, 1 er, 3 bb, 2 k Ret'd 10 of first 12 BF til 1-out 1B led to R in 4th; then ret'd 7 of last 9*

LHP **Reid Santos**, 26, is a 6-1, 170-pound lefty who was claimed off waivers from Toronto in at the start of Spring Training 2009. The native of Kaneohe, HI, was originally drafted by Cleveland in the 13th round of 2002 out Saddleback College (Mission Viejo, CA) and was part of the Tribe's system until being claimed off waivers by the Blue Jays on 9/23/08. Santos started 2008 in Buffalo, going 2-2, 7.20 in 16 G, 0 GS, before being assigned to Double-A Akron -- where he finished 2-1, 3.78 and 2 SV in 29 G, 0 GS. In 2007, Santos spent the year in Akron -- where he was named an Eastern League mid-season All-Star -- and finished 8-3, 2.72 in 39 G, 10 GS. He also posted a 2.08 ERA (8.2 ip, 2 er) in four EL playoff games... Santos was the 2004 Appalachian League Co-Pitcher of the Year while pitching for Burlington.

LEAN, MEAN, FIGHTING CHACIN:

A blown lead by the bullpen last night denied LHP **Gustavo Chacin** (n/d, 7 ip, 2 r, 2 er) from becoming the first LHV starter to ever win five consecutive starts, so he remains tied in the record books with RHP **Carlos Carrasco**. Even so, the Venezuela native has gone 4-0, 3.26 ERA (38.2 ip, 14 er, 5 QS) in his last 6 GS...

BLOWN LEADS:

Last night, the 'Pigs blew a lead 3-2 lead after 7 innings -- their 6th blown lead when leading after 7 and their 26th blown lead of the year... The 'Pigs lead the IL in losses when leading after 5 inn (10), 6 inn (10), 7 inn (6) & 8 (5) inn.

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Walk this Way?:* The game-winning 1B by **Steve Tolleson** (9th) handed LHV its 5th walk-off loss in '09 (LHV has 4).
- *Tiffie Torments:* Former 'Wing **Terry Tiffie** had a 2-run HR last night and is now .393-1-4 in 7 G against Rochester.

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the season series, 7-5 -- sweeping the last series (7/16-19 @ Coca-Cola Park)... ROC won the 2008 series, 11-5 -- winning the last 4 G of the series and also sweeping the last meeting at Frontier Field.

THREE'S COMPANY:

With a loss to ROC last night, LHV is back in a tie with ROC for third place... They took their initial residence of 3rd place was for 4 days from 7/18-7/21... and have now had four stints in sole possession for a total of 8 days (last: 8/1)... Previously, the 'Pigs took their initial sole residence of 4th place for 10 days (4/16; 6/24-7/2).

ROAD WARRIORS?:

The 'Pigs went just 2-6 on their last road trip... but they'd previously been 10-5 in their 15 prior on the road... During the last road trip, LHV batted .255 (71-278) -- just .169 (13-77) w/ RISP. The 'Pigs had just 2 HR and averaged just 2.9 R/G (23 R)... and the pitching staff had a 5.61 ERA in the 8 G (67.1 ip, 42 er).

PITCHING FITS:

The 7.0 IP by Chacin last night marked the first time an IronPigs starter has gone more than 6.0 IP in any of the last 11 G -- as LHV has essentially had an amazing 5 bullpen days in the last 14 G... In these 14 G, starters have combined to go 3-6, 5.17 ERA (71.1 ip, 41 er) and the pitching staff as a whole has managed to go just 5-9, 4.66 ERA (121.2 ip, 63 er).

BULLPEN: TAXED BUT TICKIN!:

The 'Pigs bullpen has combined 19.1 IP in the last 5 G (9 ER)... Including spot-starter Jake Woods, the 'Pigs bullpen has now worked 47.1 IP in the last 11 G, an average of nearly 4.1 IP/G (starters have gone more than 6.0 IP just once in the last 11 G)... Still, since June 14, the corps is now 6-6, 2.66 (152.1 ip, 45 er) in 45 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.77 ERA (335.0 ip, 103 er) in 104 G.

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 12 or 13 G (19-57, .333-0-9, 2 2B) and has 12 multi-hit G in his last 21 G (31-89, .348-1-12, 6 2B, 3B)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in his last 8 G (12-33, .364-3-7) after a 2-36 skid... INF **Miguel Cairo** has a 7-G hitting streak (8-29, .276-0-1, 2 2B) and has hit in 19 of his last 21 G (24-79, .304)... INF **Terry Tiffie** has hit in 9 of his last 10 G (14-41, .341-2-8) and has hit in 17 of his last 20 G (28-81, .346-2-12)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit in 8 of his last 11 G (11-35, .314-0-5)... OF **Michael Taylor** has hit in 10 of his last 14 G (14-49, .286-2-7, 7 R) since starting his Triple-A career 2-13 -- and he has reached safely in 15 of 17 G... In his last 19 G, INF **David Newhan** is batting .348-1-6 (23-66, 4 2B, 3B)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 7-2 with a 1.83 ERA in his last 12 G, 11 GS with LHV (78.2 ip, 16 er, 65 k)... RHP **Steven Register** has been unscored upon in 9 of his last 11 G (14 ip, 3 er; 1-0, 1.93, 4 SV) and in 13 of his last 16 G (1-0, 2.28, 19.2 ip, 5 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 20 of last his 25 relief app's (5-0, 1.96, 41.1 ip, 9 er)... In his last 19 G with LHV, RHP **Jason Anderson** in 0-1, 1.72 and 3 SV (31.1 ip, 6 er)...

.500 ALLERGY?:

It took 220 games for Lehigh Valley to get to .500 for the first time in franchise history -- which the 'Pigs did on 6/28/09 at 38-38 after a 6-1 win vs. NOR. But then they lost two-straight games and seven of their next nine... The 'Pigs then reeled off seven wins in their next nine contests to get back to .500 for just the second time in team history (7/19/09 at 47-47 after a 3-2 win vs. ROC) -- and have now since lost 9 of their last 14 affairs...

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Power On!*: The IronPigs have had at least 1 HR in each of the last 4 G... Previously, LHV had just 9 HR in 239 innings (which inc. a 74.1-inning drought 6/30-7/8).
- *Back on the Offensive*: In the last 6 G, the 'Pigs are batting .282 (60-213), averaging 4.7 R/G (28 R)... In the previous 8 G, LHV batted .255 (71-278) -- just .169 (13-77) w/ RISP -- and averaged just 2.9 R/G (23 R).
- *Fast Starters*: LHV has scored at least one R in the first inning of 6 of its last 11 G (13 R) -- and are 4-2 in these G.
- *Difference a Year Makes*: LHV is 8.0 G better from this point last season (44-64) & is on pace to finish 70-74.
- *Scoring in Bunches!*: In the last 48 G, LHV has now scored multiple R in 54 innings...and after not scoring 4+ in an inning for 250 inn. (30 G from 5/14-6/13), LHV has done so in 15 times in their last 47 G.
- *Getting Defensive*: The 'Pigs have committed just 9 E in the last 24 G -- and have the best total (71 in the I.L. by 3 E ahead of SWB). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.982) and has turned an IL 2nd-best 115 double plays (SYR has 116)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.
- The win for LHP **Brian Mazone** Tuesday was his first since 7/30/08 @ NOR... He'd since been 0-7 w/ LHV; 0-1 w/ ALB.
- *Go West, Young Men?*: LHV is just 12-16 vs. the West this season -- the only division it has a losing record against.

TAYLOR MADE:

OF **Michael Taylor** was promoted from Reading (AA) to LHV on 7/16. The 6-6, 260-pound Eastern League All-Star was batting .333-15-65 in 86 G -- and was leading the EL in hits (106); 2nd in extra base hits (40); tied for 2nd in runs (59); 3rd in average (.333), RBI (65) and slugging percentage (.569); 4th in HR (15) and 5th in SB (18)...

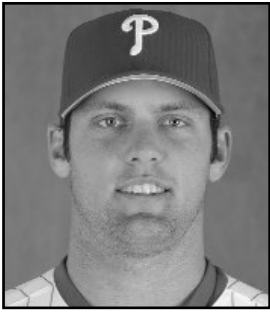
