TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (64-71) start their final homestand of the season -- an eight-day, nine-gamer -- with Game One of a two-game series with the fifth-place Pawtucket Red Sox (57-77) -- Boston's top affiliate. With a 3-1 loss at Syracuse last night, the 'Pigs were swept in three games to the Chiefs and finished 4-5 on their season-long, nine-game road trip. Now just 8-14 in its last 22 contests, LHV remains 41-36 (.532) since 6/11... Pawtucket split a doubleheader last night, but still dropped the three-game series at SWB -- which followed a two-game sweep versus Buffalo (their first back-to-back wins in a span of 17 games). The Red Sox have gone 4-3 in their last seven games after losing 12 of 14. Once 42-36 on July 2, the Paw Sox have gone just 15-41 (.268) in their last 56 games...

- First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m. at Coca-Cola Park for Football Night.
- *Sweepless?*: The game sweep at SYR marked the first time LHV was swept in a 3- or 4-game series vs. an ND foe since the opening series of 2009 (four games 4/9-4/12 vs. SWB) -- 13 such series ago...
- *North Stars?*: Even after being swept in SYR, the 'Pigs are still 20-17 (.541) in their last 37 games vs. the North.

2009 ROAD SCHEDULE FINISHED:

The 'Pigs finished 33-39 (.458) on the road after finishing 24-48 (.333) on the road last season. Three of their '09 "road" games were actually played at Coca-Cola Park (1-2 vs. SWB)... Since July 4 (19-17), LHV went just 14-22 as visitors and dropped its last 3 G... They finished losing their final 5 G on the road in 2008 -- and went just 2-14 in their final 16 G away from CCP.

FORTUNE .500?:

The 'Pigs need to go **8-1** in their remaining 9 G to finish at .500; **9-0** to finish above .500 (where LHV's never been).

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- a member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and LHV's first 10-game winner -- is a 6-3, 225-pound, 24-year-old righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 2nd round of 2006 out of Long Beach State. The Vacaville, CA, native spent a bulk of 2008 in Double-A Reading, going just 6-8 with a 5.67 ERA in 16 GS -- but was on the move in the second half, with a stint in Advanced-A Clearwater (3-3, 2.92 in 8 GS from 6/16-7/31), a ML debut with Philly (scoreless IP of relief 8/27 vs. NYM) and a start with LHV on 8/31 @ PAW (L, 7 ip 6 h, 2 er). Carpenter had a stellar 2007 season in Clearwater -- where he led the Florida State League in wins (17) and shutouts (2) while being selected to play in the 2007 FSL All-Star Game. He finished the season 17-6, 3.20 with 1 SV in 27 G, 24 GS, and tied for the league lead in CG (3). Among the highlights in his three-year MLB career was a 7-inning perfect game 8/27/07 vs. Fort Myers (7 ip, 7 k). He also won both his postseason starts (2-0, 2.92) as the Threshers won the 2007 FSL Championship.

RHP **Michael Bowden** -- a member of Boston's 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-3, 215-pound, 22-year-old right-hander drafted by Boston as a sandwich pick (47th overall) in the 2005 Draft out of Waubonise Valley (IL) HS. Last year, Bowden climbed from Double-A all the way up to the Majors. He started 2008 in Portland and went 9-4, 2.33 in 19 GS. After a stint on the DL (calf) that kept him out of the 2008 Eastern League All-Star Game, he was promoted to Pawtucket on 7/21 and went 0-3, 3.38 in 7 G, 6 GS -- and later pitched 1.2 scoreless IP of relief in Game 3 of the first round of the IL postseason vs. SWB. He made his ML debut for Boston on 8/30 vs. CHI-A -- starting and winning 8-2 in his first and only ML appearance (W, 5 ip, 2 er). At 21 years, 356 days, became the youngest Red Sox pitcher to start and win his ML debut since Juan Pena on 5/8/99 (21 years, 315 days) and the 3rd-youngest A.L. pitcher to appear in a game in '08 behind LAA's Nick Adenhardt (4/24/86) and NYY's Phillip Hughes (6/24/86). He was optioned back to Pawtucket the following day. In his senior year of HS, Bowden went 8-1, 0.59 in 10 G.

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the series, 8-6 -- after the teams have split 3 prior series... PAW dominated in '08, 15-1 -- which included winning the first 9 G (and last 6 G) vs. LHV. PAW swept LHV in all 8 G at CCP, and LHV's lone win took place 7/5 @ PAW.

- LHV just won its first series all-time against PAW -- in Series #12 (they went 1-15 overall vs. the 'Sox in 2008).
- *Home Away from Home?*: After sweeping the '08 series in A-Town, PAW is now 11-3 all-time at Coca-Cola Park.

BACON BITS, PT. 1:

- Since coming back from PHI (8/14), RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** is just 1-1, 6.14 in 4 GS (22 ip/15) and .340 (34-100, 5 hr).
- *A Hello to Arms?*: Even after the SYR sweep, the LHV staff is a combined 5-5, 3.01 (86.2 ip, 29 er) and .228 OBA (71-312) in the last 10 G. This follows a 13-G stretch during which opp's batters hit .356 (155-435) with 6.1 R/G (79).
- The loss by LHP **Gustavo Chacin** Sat. snapped a 10-start, loss-less streak and was his first since 6/29 vs. NOR.

BLOWN LEADS:

The 'Pigs blew a 1-0 lead in the 6th on Sunday -- their 35th blown-lead loss of year... The 'Pigs lead the IL in losses when leading after 5 inn (15) and 7 inn (8); they have the 2nd highest loss total after 6 inn (10; BUF-11) & 8 inn (5; NOR-6).

TIFFEE, BOWERS TO PLAY IN WORLD BASEBALL CUP:

3B Terry Tiffée and LHP Cedrick Bowers have both been selected to play in the upcoming World Baseball Cup, USA Baseball announced on Thursday. Team USA is the defending World Cup champion, having defeated Cuba, 6-3, in the 2007 final in Taiwan. It was the first World Cup title for the U.S. since 1974. The 2009 World Cup will take place in Europe from September 9-27... Tiffée started all nine games for Team USA in the 2008 Summer Olympics in Beijing, China, and helped lead the unit to a Bronze Medal by finishing with a .324 batting average... Bowers made his Major League debut for the Rockies last season, 12 years after being drafted in the fourth round of the 1996 draft by the Tampa Bay Rays... *Both players are expected to leave the 'Pigs for Team Usa on September 1.*

NORTHERN EXPOSURE:

The 'Pigs final 26 G are against the North Division -- and they have started 7-10. LHV is 35-36 (.493) vs. the North in '09. This comes after faring just 22-58 (.275) in 2008... Still, the 'Pigs have gone 20-17 (.541) in their last 37 division games vs. the North... LHV had/has ND foes in 50 of the final 66 G (including 10 vs. division-leading SWB).

WELCOME BACK STARTERS:

Earlier this month, the 'Pigs added back RHP **Rodrigo Lopez** and RHP **Kyle Kendrick** -- who both optioned back down from Philadelphia. They're since **4-3** in games with them on the mound. When these two key cogs left the rotation, the 'Pigs went just 2-9 in the game started by replacements -- with starters combining to go 2-8, 5.44 (46.1 ip, 28 er).

GETTIN' DEFENSIVE:

The 'Pigs have committed just 22 E in the last 50 G -- and have the best total (86 in the I.L. by 9 E ahead of SWB). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.983) and has turned an IL 2nd-best 143 double plays (SYR has 146)...

BULLPEN: TAXED BUT TICKING!:

In the last 10 G, the 'Pigs relief corps has only allowed 4 R in 27.2 IP -- for a **1.30 ERA** ... Including spot-starter Jake Woods, the 'Pigs bullpen has worked 125.2 IP in the last 37 G, an average of almost 4.0 IP/G (starters have gone more than 6.0 IP just 4x times in the last 35 G)... Perhaps the wear-n-tear has shown over time, as the corps has gone 3-5, 4.70 (61.1 ip, 32 er) and 4 BS in the last 21 G... Still, since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the pen has a combined 3.05 ERA (413.2 ip, 140 er) in 131 G.

FOURTH DOWN:

LHV remains in 4th place in the North... They held sole possession of third place for a franchise-long 15 straight days from 8/3-8/17... They took their initial residence of 3rd place was for 4 days from 7/18-7/21... and have now had five stints in sole possession for a total of 22 days (last: 8/17)... Previously, the 'Pigs took their initial sole residence of 4th place for 10 days (4/16; 6/24-7/2).

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **Rich Thompson** has hit safely in 13 of his last 16 G (21-55, .382-1-2, 17 R) and has 9 multi-hit G in his last 18 G (25-70, .357)... OF **Jason Ellison** has hit in 13 of his last 18 G (23-69, .333-1-7, 14 R) & in 19 of his last 22 GS (29-90, .322-1-11, 18 R)... OF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 3 of his last 4 G (6-14, .429-0-6, 3 2B). In his last 45 G, he's batting .316-3-36 (60-190, 18 2B, 3B) with 20 multi-hit G... OF **John Mayberry** has hit in 8 of his last 9 G (11-34, .324-2-2)... OF **Michael Taylor** -- currently on the DL (strained rt. oblique) -- has hit in 5 of the last 8 G (13-31, .419-2-8, 2 2B, 2 BB); with the first cycle in LHV history in 8/12 vs. LOU (5-5, 4 RBI, 2 R). He's now reached safety in 24 of 29 G to start his Triple-A career... INF **J.J. Furmaniak** has hit in 6 of his last 7 G (8-24, .333-1-3)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

LHP **Gustavo Chacin** has won 5 of his last 6 decisions (would've had LHV record 5-start winning streak if not for a BS on 8/2). Even so, he's gone 5-1, 3.28 (CG, 68.2 ip, 25 er, 8 QS) in his last 11 GS... Since coming back from PHI, RHP **Kyle Kendrick** is 2-1, 2.04 (17.2 ip, 4 er) in 3 GS... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 23 of last his 31 relief app's (5-1, 2.17, 2 SV, 54.0 ip, 13 er)... LHP **Cedrick Bowers** has been unscored upon in 11 of his last 12 G (1-1, 2 H, 0.73, 12.1 ip)... LHP **Jack Taschner** has only allowed 1 R in his last 9 G (9.1 ip, SV, H, 0.95)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has earned a win in 2 of his last 3 G (2-0, 1.80, 5.0 ip, 1 r)... RHP **Gary Majewski** has been unscored upon in his last 4 G (4.2 ip, 2 h, 0 r, 7 k, IN-4, ST-4)...
