TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (55-57) return home for a six-game homestand beginning tonight with the opener of a two-game series against the first-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Yankees (62-48) -- New York's top affiliate. With a 4-0 win last night, the 'Pigs have won three of their last four games and four of their last six. Over a longer stretch, Lehigh Valley is 32-22 (.593) since 6/11... Even with the loss last night, SWB has won five of its last seven affairs after a 5-9 stretch in the prior 14 games. Since starting 23-5 (May 8), SWB has gone 39-43 -- during which time LHV has gained just 1.5 games in the standings...

- First-Pitch tonight is set for 7:05 p.m. for Fireworks Night, presented by **Crossroads Harley-Davidson/Buell**.
- With SWB's loss last night, the 'Pigs are now 8.0 GB in the North; with GWN's loss, they're now 7.5 GB of Wild Card.

With Last Night's Win Tonight, the IronPigs:

- Matched their win total of 55 from the '08 season -- 32 games ahead of last year's pace, when they finished 55-89. The 'Pigs are 7.0 games better from this point last season (48-64) & are on pace to finish 71-73.

With a Win Tonight, the IronPigs Will:

- Set a new franchise record for wins in a season with 56.
- Win back-to-back games against SWB for the first time in franchise history (in 27 games).
- Be three games over .500 against the North Division for the first time in franchise history.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Joe Savery** -- making his 2nd career Triple-A start -- is a 6-3, 215-pound, 23-year-old lefty drafted by Philadelphia in the first round (19th overall) in 2007 out of Rice University -- where he finished his standout career first-team All-America as a two-way player and earned his 2nd conference Player-of-the-Year award in three seasons. He led Rice through the NCAA regional with a Most Outstanding Player performance... The native of Bellaire, TX, spent 2008 with Advanced-A Clearwater, going 9-10, 4.13 in 27 G, 24 GS -- leading the Florida State League with 150.1 IP. Savery made his pro debut in 2007 with Advanced-R Williamsport (2-3, 2.73 in 7 GS) and pitched for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League following the season (1-1, 0.64 in 5 GS). He is ranked as the No. 20 prospect in the system by *Baseball America*.

- *JS's 13 wins are tied for 2nd in all MiLB w/ 3 others -- one behind Carlos Hernandez (Stockton) & Craig Clark (San Jose).*
- *JS started '09 in Reading, going 12-4, 4.41 in 21 G, 20 GS, (CG, 112.1 ip, 111 h, 55 r, 55 er, 53 bb, 77 k, .262, 13 hr).*
- *After starting 0-1, 4.50 in 3 GS, Savery won 12 consecutive decisions from 4/28-7/9 in a span of 15 GS.*
- *Even though he managed to go 2-3, JS had an 8.46 ERA (27.2/26 er) in his last 5 GS @ REA -- raising from 3.08.*
- *GC, 7/28 vs. COL (W, 4-2): W, 6 ip, 4 h, 1 r, 1 er, 3 bb, 2 k Ret'd 10 of first 12 BF til 1-out 1B led to R in 4th; then ret'd 7 of last 9*

LHP **Kei Igawa**, 30, is a 6-1, 210-pound lefty out of Ibaraki, Japan. He signed with New York on a 5-year, 20-million dollar contract on 12/27/06 after the Yankees were the highest bidders once Igawa was posted by the Hanshin Tigers (11/16/06). He spent most of 2008 in SWB, going 14-6, 3.45 in 26 G, 24 GS; making his lone start for NY on 5/9/08 (L, 3 ip, 11 h, 6 r) and finishing 0-1, 13.50 in 2 G, 1 GS. In his first year in the U.S., Igawa started with NY and went 2-3, 6.25 in 14G, 12GS over three stints (4/2-5/7; 6/22-7/27; 9/9-9/30)... A No. 2 draft choice of the Hanshin Tigers in 1998, Igawa spent a couple of years in the Hanshin minor league system prior to entering the rotation in 2001. In his first full season season as a starter, Igawa went 9-13 for the last-placed Tigers, but finished with a Central League second-best 2.67 ERA. In 2002, he improved to 14-9 and finished third in ERA (2.49), while leading the CL with 206 K. In 2003, the Tigers won the CL pennant and Igawa won the MVP -- going 20-5, 2.80 and ranking 3rd with 179 strikeouts. He also won the Sawamura Award (Japanese equivalent of the Cy Young Award).

In eight seasons in Japan, we went 86-60 with a 3.14 ERA in 190 G (1244 ip, 1174 k) while leading in Ks three times (2002, '04, '06) and appearing in the Nippon Professional Baseball All-Star Game thrice (2001, '02, '03).

SERIES INFORMATION:

SWB leads the 2009 series, 7-3 -- and overall series, 21-4 (.840). The Yanks won 8 straight G from 8/16/08 (4) through 4/12/09 (4). Of note: the Triple-A Yanks Spring Training team was 4-0 vs. the Phils' this exhibition season.

TOUGH STRETCH:

The 'Pigs began Thursday with a stretch of 8 G vs. teams with the top 2 records in the IL (SWB, LOU) -- teams they're now 3-11 against -- and have started 1-1... Against the Top 4 teams (add DUR, GWN), LHV is 10-20; 45-37 vs. the rest.

NORTH STARS?:

Prior to the two-game split @ SWB, the 'Pigs took 3 of 4 at ROC -- giving LHV its first North Division road series victory since 5/25-5/28 @ BUF (3-1) -- and just its second of 2009... LHV is now 27-25 (.519) vs. the North in '09. This comes after faring just 22-58 (.275) in 2008...

NORTHERN BOUND:

The 'Pigs are in Game Seven of a stretch of 32 of their final 36 games against the North (4-3 so far)... and the 'Pigs have gone 12-6 in their last 18 division games vs. the North. They're now 26-25 (.510) vs. the North in '09 -- after faring just 22-58 (.275) in '08.... LHV had/has ND foes in 50 of the final 66 G (including 10 vs. division-leading SWB).

THREE'S A CROWD:

LHV regained sole possession of third place in the North for the last 4 days... They took their initial residence of 3rd place was for 4 days from 7/18-7/21... and have now had five stints in sole possession for a total of 13 days (last: 8/7)... Previously, the 'Pigs took their initial sole residence of 4th place for 10 days (4/16; 6/24-7/2).

LEAN, MEAN, FIGHTING CHACIN:

LHP **Gustavo Chacin** has won 5 of his last 6 GS (would have been 6 straight if not for a BS on 8/2, start 5 of span). Even so, he has gone 5-0, 2.82 ERA (44.2 ip, 14 er, 6 QS) in his last 7 GS...

SO SAVERY!:

Phillies' 2007 first-round pick (19th overall) LHP **Joe Savery** won his Triple-A debut on Monday (W, 6 ip, 4 h, 1 r, 1 er, b bb, 0 k). The Rice University product started his season in Double-A Reading and is now a combined 13-4 this season. His win total (13) is tied for second in all of MiLB w/ three others (inc. former IronPig and Louisville Bat Justin Lehr) -- one behind leaders Carlos Hernandez of Stockton (CAL) and Craig Clark of San Jose (CAL)...

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

INF **Terry Tifee** has hit in 12 of his last 14 G (22-59, .373-2-11) and has hit in 20 of his last 24 G (36-99, .364-2-15)... INF **David Newhan** has a 4 multi-hit G in his last 6 G (10-27, .370-0-2, 3 2B, 8 R). In his last 23 G, he's now batting .345-1-6 (29-84, 7 2B, 3B)... OF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 15 or 17 G (23-73, .315-0-13, 5 2B) and has 13 multi-hit G in his last 25 G (35-105, .333-1-18, 9 2B, 3B)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 11 of his last 12 G (15-50, .300-3-10, 3B) after a 2-36 skid... INF **Miguel Cairo** has hit in 21 of his last 24 G (27-90, .300-0-4)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit in 10 of last 15 G (15-518, .294-0-9)... OF **Michael Taylor** has reached safely in 17 of 21 G to start his Triple-A career... OF **Jason Ellison** has a 4-game hitting streak (4-14, .286)...

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Drew Carpenter** has now gone 8-2 with a 1.91 ERA in his last 13 G, 12 GS with LHV (84.2 ip, 18 er, 71 k)... RHP **Steven Register** has been unscored upon in 10 of his last 12 G (15 ip, 3 er; 1-0, 1.80, 4 SV) and in 14 of his last 17 G (1-0, 2.18, 20.2 ip, 5 er)... LHP **Jake Woods** is unscored upon in 21 of last his 26 relief app's (5-0, 1.91, 42.1 ip, 9 er)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has been unscored upon in his last 7 G (0-0, 4 SV, 7.2 ip, 1 h, 2 bb) and 9.1 IP overall. In his last 21 G with LHV, he's gone 0-1, 1.59 and 5 SV (34.0 ip, 6 er)...

PITCHING FITS:

Pigs starters are 3-1, 2.79 (29 ip, 9 er) in the last 5 G... but have gone more than 6.0 IP in just 1 of the last 15 G -- as LHV has essentially had an amazing 5 bullpen days in the last 18 G... In these 18 G, starters have combined to go 6-7, 4.73 (93.1 ip, 49 er) and the pitching staff as a whole has managed to go just 8-10, 4.31 (156.2 ip, 75 er)...

BULLPEN: TAXED BUT TICKIN!:

Including spot-starter Jake Woods, the 'Pigs bullpen has now worked 60.1 IP in the last 15 G, an average of more than 4.0 IP/G (starters have gone more than 6.0 IP just once in the last 15 G)... Still, since June 14, the corps is now 6-6, 2.67 (165.1 ip, 49 er) in 49 G -- which included a 21.1 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) from 6/23-7/3... And since the first series of '09 (18 ip, 26 er), the corps has a combined 2.77 ERA (348.0 ip, 107 er) in 108 G.

GETTIN' DEFENSIVE:

The 'Pigs have committed just 10 E in the last 28 G -- and have the best total (73 in the I.L. by 6 E ahead of BUF). LHV leads the IL in fielding percentage (.982) and has turned an IL 2nd-best 119 double plays (SYR has 121)... They turned just 118 DPs in all of 2008.

BACON BITS, PT 2:

• *Back on the Offensive:* In the last 10 G, the 'Pigs are batting .279 (101-362), averaging 4.9 R/G (49 R)... In the previous 8 G, LHV batted .255 (71-278) -- just .169 (13-77) w/ RISP -- and averaged just 2.9 R/G (23 R).

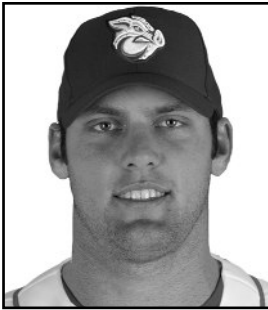
