## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (66-72) play the finale of a two-game series with the second-place Syracuse Chiefs (74-64) -- Washington's top affiliate. With a 2-1 loss last night, the 'Pigs have now lost five straight to the Chiefs (and eight of last nine) and are now 2-1 in this season-ending nine-game, eight-game homestand. Still just 10-15 in its last 25 contests, LHV remains 43-37 (.538) since 6/11... Syracuse was just swept in a very important two-game home series against Scranton -- which followed their three-game sweep of Lehigh Valley. The Chiefs have gone just 7-8 in their last 15 contests. But last .500 in June 16 (32-32), the Chiefs are 42-32 (.568) in their last 74 games...

### The IronPigs need a Win Tonight to:

- Still have a chance to finish the season at .500... they need to go **6-0** in their remaining 6 G in order to do so...
- Do their part to avoid falling to a season-high 13.5 GB in the North Division. Last 12.5 GB on 8/20, they haven't been further behind since ending the 2008 season at 33.0 GB of SWB in the North.

## REHAB NEWS:

RHP **Brett Myers** may have finished his MLB Rehab stint last night after working a scoreless innings on back-to-back nights. In his first outing, he pitched a perfect ninth with a pair of strikeouts to notch a save in a 3-2 win over Pawtucket. He then had a scoreless eighth inning with one strikeout Wednesday in a 2-1 loss to Syracuse.

• RHP **Clay Condrey** is expected to rehab with LHV on Saturday. The 33-year-old has been on Philadelphia's D.L. since July 23 with a left oblique strain -- his second stint on the D.L. (6/19-7/17) this year. Condrey is 6-2 with a 3.41 ERA and a save in 36 appearances for the Phillies.

## TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Gustavo Chacin**, 28, is a 5-11, 207-pound lefty signed by PHI as a minor league free agent 4/6/09 (released by WAS at the end of Spring Training). After undergoing surgery for a slight tear in his labrum on 8/29/07, the native of Maracaibo, VZ, spent 2008 battling injuries rehabbing for Toronto in Single-A Dunedin (1-7, 7.88 in 11 GS before a season-ending ACL tear). Chacin last pitched in MLB for Toronto in 2007, and went 25-15, 4.18 in a 4-year stint with the Jays. He made his ML debut 9/20/04 at NYY and became the 7th Jay to win his first start (7 ip, 3 er). In his rookie season of '05, Chacin went 13-9, 3.72 in 34 GS and led TOR with 121 SO. The 13 wins set a team rookie record for starting pitchers and he was AL Rookie of the Month twice (April: 2-1, 2.48 in 5 GS; and July: 5-0, 2.97 in 6 GS) and became the fastest Blue Jay to ever reach the 10-win plateau. Chacin emerged in MiLB in 2004, when he went 16-2, 2.86 in 25 with New Hampshire and was an Eastern League post-season All-Star. Originally signed by TOR as a non-drafted free agent 7/3/98, he worked with fragrance experts to concoct *Chacin Cologne* for a team promotion 6/27/06.

- GC started in Reading (1-0, 3.21, 2 G, 1 GS): winning his lone 5/23 @ ALT (5 ip, er) -- his first win since 6/4/08 @ FTM.
- GC lost for the first time in 11 GS and exactly 2 months his last outing (see below)...
- Even so, GC's gone 5-1, 3.28 (CG, 68.2 ip, 25 er, 8 QS) in his last 11 GS...
- GC, 8/29 @ SYR-1 (L, 4-0): CG, 6 ip, 3 h, 4 r, 4 er, 4 bb, k, hr Duel w/ Estrada; all 4 R came on GS (Desmond) in 4th after 3 BB

RHP **Marco Estrada** -- a member of the Nationals 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-0, 197-pound, 26-year-old righty selected by Washington in the 6th round of the 2005 draft out of Long Beach State (CA) -- where he was honorable mention All-Big West his only season there (8-3, 2.43 in 18 G, 16 GS). The native of San Fernando, Calif., started in Double-A Harrisburg (6-3, 2.66 in 13 GS) and made it all the way to the ML. On 6/16, he was promoted to Columbus -- where he went 3-3, 3.58 in 12 GS before making his ML debut on 8/20 at PHI (2.0 ip, 2 h, 0 r, 2 k). In all, he went 0-0, 7.82 in 11 G, 0 GS with Washington. Estrada was born in Sonora, Mexico, and became the 5th Mexican-born National and the 4th member of the Nationals' initial draft class to reach the big leagues.

### SERIES INFORMATION:

SYR leads the season series, 9-5 (6-2 at ABS), with SYR taking 6 of the last 7 G. SYR -- then a Toronto affiliate -- won the '08 series, 10-6 (2-6 at ABS); but the 'Pigs had a split against the Nationals affiliate last season (COL).

### TAYLOR WINS OWENS AWARD:

IronPigs OF **Michael Taylor** and Reading RHP **Kyle Drabek** were named winners of the 2009 Paul Owens Award for the best pitcher and player, respectively, in the Phillies minor league system. The two players will receive their awards during a pre-game presentation on Tuesday, September 15, when the Phillies host the Washington Nationals at Citizens Bank Park. Taylor -- on the D.L. (strained oblique) since winning the International League Batter-of-the-Week from 8/10-8/16 -- combined to bat .320-20-84 with 28 doubles, five triples and 21 stolen bases in 116 games between Double-A Reading and Lehigh Valley. Named the Eastern League's Rookie of the Year, the 23-year-old hit for the cycle on August 12 against Louisville, going 5-for-5 with two doubles, a triple, a home run and four RBI. Taylor finished .282-5-19 (.359 OBP, .491 SLG) in 30 G with the IronPigs.

### DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES:

on August 8, LHV improved to 56-57 -- passing its win total from the inaugural season (55-89) with 31 games still to play... At current, the 'Pigs are 66-72 and guaranteed to finish at least 11.0 G better than in '08. At this point last season, they has 13 fewer wins at 53-85 -- and were 33.0 GB (a difference of 20.5 games from where they are now).

### BACON BITS, PT. 1:

• North Stars?: The 'Pigs are now 22-18 (.550) in their last 40 games vs. the North. However, the Chiefs have won eight of the last nine against the 'Pigs -- including five in a row.

• The 'Pigs need to go 6-1 in their remaining 7 G to finish at .500; 7-0 to finish above .500 (where LHV's never been).

• Home Boys!: LHV had its 4-G home winning streak snapped last night... but are still .500 (33-33) at CCP... The 'Pigs need to go 4-2 to in their final 6 G to finish above .500 at CCP; 3-3 to finish at .500.

• RED-HOT Relief: The 'Pigs bullpen is 3 hits away from being perfect in its last 4 G (9.1 ip, 0 r, 28 of 32 retired)... in the last 13 G, the corps has allowed just 4 R in 34.2 IP for a 1.04 ERA (2-1, 3 SV) -- and until 2 inherited runners scored against Jake Woods Tuesday, had stranded 13 of 13 inherited runners in the first 11 G of the span.

• A Hello to Arms?: In the last 13 G, the LHV staff is a combined 7-6, 2.69 (113.2 ip, 34 er) and .222 OBA (91-410)... This follows a 13-G stretch during which opp's batters hit .356 (155-435) with 6.1 R/G (79).

• Nipping Nemeses: LHV has won 8 of its last 9 G vs. PAW and SWB -- teams LHV finished 3-29 against in '08. The 'Pigs finished 16-16 (.500) against the Yanks and Sox this season, a 13-game swing.

### MORE ON MYERS, REHABS:

RHP **Brett Myers**, recovering from June 4 hip surgery, was originally placed on the disabled list on May 30 (retroactive to May 28) with a torn labrum in his right hip.

• REHAB STATS COMBINED: 0-1, SV, 1.13 ERA in 6 G (8 ip, 4 h, 1 r, 1 er, 2 bb, 13 k)

In 232 career games, he has gone 73-63 with a 4.39 ERA (1176.2 IP, 1185 H, 606 R, 574 ER, 410 BB, 982 K). Myers was selected by the Phillies in the first round (12th overall) of the 1999 draft and moved rapidly through the system, reaching the Major Leagues in 2002.

Relegated to Triple-A at the 2008 season's midway point with just a 3-9 record and a 5.84 ERA, Myers regain his form with the IronPigs -- and, after returning to Philadelphia, went 7-4, 3.06 for the remainder of the regular season. During the Phillies memorable post-season run, Myers made headlines in a gutsy nine-pitch at-bat that resulted in a two-out walk against Milwaukee's ace C.C. Sabathia and set the stage for Shane Victorino's NLDS heroics. On the mound in last year's post-season, he made three starts and posted an impressive 2-1 mark with a 3.79 ERA.

Myers also proved invaluable in Philadelphia's late-season push in 2007, notching 21 saves while pitching out of the bullpen for the first time in his career -- helping to guide the Phillies to the post-season for the first time since 1993. **Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Network** is the exclusive sponsor of all Major League rehabilitation appearances at Coca-Cola Park. *Other notable rehabs at Coca-Cola Park*: OF **Shane Victorino** (4/26-4/27/08), RHP **Rudy Seanez** (8/11/08), C **Carlos Ruiz** (4/25-5/1), LHP **J.C.
