TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (13-14) play Game Two of a four-game series against the Toledo Mud Hens (12-16) at Fifth-Third Field. With a thrilling 5-4 win against the Mud Hens last night, the 'Pigs have won three of their last four games and are 1-0 on this eight-game West Division road trip... Toledo -- previously swept in a four-game series at Pawtucket -- has lost five straight games and eight of its last 10 games (it could have been a 10-game losing streak had they not erased back-to-back ninth-inning deficits 5/2-5/3 at Coca-Cola Park). The Hens are 4-14 since starting 8-2. First-Pitch is at 7:00 p.m.

- *Comeback!*: With 2 R in the 9th last night, the 'Pigs won for the first time this season when trailing after 8 innings (now 1-11). In team history, they're now 5-88 in such instances. LHV has come-from-behind to win 8x in '09.

With a win today, the IronPigs will:

- Finally get to .500 for the first time during a season in franchise history. In their year-plus, the IronPigs are 0-4 with a chance to get to .500+... The Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't been .500 since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP Rodrigo Lopez, 33, is a 6-1, 187 pound righty signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent on 3/5/09. A native of Mexico, Lopez missed most of the 2008 campaign recovering from "Tommy John" surgery 8/22/07. He was signed by Atlanta exactly one year later (8/22/08), and made two starts in the GCL (3 ip, 0 er) and in Single-A Rome (0-1, 2 ip, 9 er). Lopez was the runner-up for the 2002 A.L. Rookie of the Year (Eric Hinske) and twice won 15 games for Baltimore before being traded to Colorado for Jason Burch and Jim Miller, 1/12/07. Additional accolades for Lopez include representing Mexico in the 2006 World Baseball Classic (0-2, 3.86). Originally signed as a minor league free agent by San Diego on 3/21/95, Lopez has logged more than six years of Major League service and has a career mark of 65-65 with a 4.80 ERA (187 g, 161 gs, 1016.2 ip, 1113 h, 577 r, 542 er, 315 bb, 674 k).

- Lopez was on the D.L. (*right shoulder strain*) from 4/19 through 4/27.
- Lopez's win on 4/28 @ SWB was his first since 7/7/07, when the Rockies defeated the Phil, 6-3, at CBP.

***LHP Lucas French**, 23, is a 6-4, 220-pound lefty drafted in the 8th round of the 2004 out of Heritage (CO) H.S. The Littleton, Colorado, native spent the 2008 season in Double-A Erie, going 9-11, 4.02 in 27 G, 26 GS (3 cg, 170 ip, 195 h, 60 bb, 88 k) -- and finishing 4-0 in his final 5 starts. French played in the 2007 Florida State League All-Star Game in a year he finished just 5-14, 4.05 in 27 GS with Advanced-A Lakeland. Prior to being drafted, French was selected to play in the inaugural AFLAC All-America High School Baseball Classic (8/23/03) in Ft. Myers, Fla.

- French was a tough-luck loser (again) his last start, a 2-1 loss 5/4 @ PAW: L, 6 ip, 7 h, 2 r, 2 er, bb, 2 k.

*LEFT OUT?:

LHV is facing just its 3rd opposing starting LHP ('Pigs have gone 2-0; K.Johnson, 4/24 vs. PAW; D.Willis, 5/1 vs. TOL). This point last year, the 'Pigs had faced 13 of 27 (48%). This season, LHV is batting .320 (40-125) vs. LHP; .236 vs. RHP.

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the 2009 series, 3-2... TOL won the 2008 series, 6-2, taking 3 of 4 at both Coca-Cola Park and Fifth-Third Field. The 'Hens also won the 2007 series vs. OTT, 5-3 -- but the teams were an even 2-2 at Fifth-Third Field.

Crazy Series!: The team leading going into the 9th is now 0-3 in the last 3 G between TOL and LHV. The 5 G have been decided by a total of 8 R (2, 1, 3, 1, 1) with 2 extra-inning games -- and have featured 12 lead changes.

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *Road Warriors?*: The 'Pigs are 5-4 on the road this season. Last season, the 'Pigs lost 14 of their last 16 road games.
- *Let's Get it Started!*: The 'Pigs are now 7-2 in series openers this season... 3-1 on the road.
- *Lead Story*: LHV has scored in all 5 G vs. TOL & in 6 of last 8 G. Prior, the 'Pigs opponents scored first in 11 of last 13 G.
- *Pen is Mightier*: Since blowing leads in the 2 G vs. TOL (10.1 ip, 11 er), the pen is unscored upon in last 4 G (8.2 ip).
- *Blown Chances*: The 'Pigs have blown leads in their last 3 losses. In addition, LHV is 1-5 in extra-inning Gs -- all at home!
- *Walk the Way!*: The walk-off win Wednesday was the 2nd of '09 for LHV (Hoover had GW-1B in 12th 4/30 vs. TOL).

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Tyler Walker** (on DL) has a season-starting 11.0 scoreless IP streak in his first 6 G. He has only allowed four batters to reach safely: 2 1Bs (inc. a hit-and-run dribbler), a BB and a HB. He's retired 32 of 37 BF (86.4%)... RHP **Dave Borkowski** has a current 10.1 scoreless IP streak (5+ G, 0-0, 6 h, 4 bb, 4 k) and has been unscored upon in last 5 G (10.0 ip) after allowing Rs in first 3 G (5 ip, 8 er)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has not allowed a R in his last 5 G (6.0 IP). Combined with Reading stats, he has a personal 11.1 scoreless IP streak... LHP **Jake Woods** snapped his team-high 12.0 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) on 2-out 2-R 2B by Ryan Roberson on Sunday... He has since gone 2.2 scoreless innings in his last appearance... RHP **Mike Koplove** hasn't allowed an ER in last 10 G (1-1, SV, 2 H, 13.2 ip, 10 h, 5 r, 8 bb, 16 k)...

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in a 2009 LHV-high 8 straight games (11-34, .324-0-3, 3 2B, 2 3B, 9 R, 5 SB). He is a perfect 9-9 in SB (100%) this season and is now 34-36 (94%) in IronPigs career... In his last 16 G, OF **John Mayberry** is batting .283-4-15 (17-60, 5 2B, 7 BB)... INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 8 of his last 10 G (15-39, .385-0-11, 5 R); inc. 3 multi-hit G. Has reached safely in his last 20 G (26 h, 5 BB, HBP) and is 9 for his last 15 w/ RISP (.600).

PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

In the last 23 G, the 'Pigs pen is 5-4, 1.55 with 3 SV (87.1 ip, 15 er)... The corps had an **amazing run** over a span of 12 G (4/18-5/1) in which it allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41), retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%... At one point, the corps had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 in the first 4 G (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES!:

- LHV is now 13-14. The IronPigs were 3-24 at this point in 2008. It took the 'Pigs 27 games to get win No. 13 in 2009. Last year, it took 47 games to get win No. 13 – May 20 @ Buffalo, when they 'improved' to 13-34.
- The 'Pigs have scored 120 runs in their first 26 G of 2009. It took them until Game 42 (5/15) to get to 120 R in '08.

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Thou Shalt Steal!*: During the 'Long Ball' Era, the stolen base base been coined 'a lost art.' Maybe it should be found. The 'Pigs have have a 92% success rate (23 of 25). Opponents have a 91% success rate (32 of 35) and 2 of the 3 CS were on PO moves by pitchers!
- With 15 DPs in the last 10 G, LHV has now turned an IL-best 34 double plays. The next closest teams have 27.
- *In a Pinch!*: With **Jeremy Slayden's** PH BB and **Pablo Ozuna's** PH 1B on 5/6, LHV pinch-hitters are 4-5 (.800) with a BB, HBP (.857 OBP)... they started 3-24 (.125) in '08.
- *Kyle Kan!*: In his last 2 G, RHP **Kyle Kendrick** is 1-0, 0.82 ERA (11.0 ip, 7 h, 1 r, 1 er, 4 bb, 9 k).
- *Bowers Powers*: The "W" recorded by LHP **Cedric Bowers** on 5/6 was his first in the IL since 8/20/03 vs. NOR (w/ DUR).
- *Northern Exposure*: The 'Pigs are 10-12 vs. North Division teams after starting 0-4 (started 1-20 last season). Going back to '08, the 'Pigs are just 17-39 (.304) in their last 56 G vs. the ND and 32-70 (.314) in franchise history.
- *April Showers*: LHV finished 9-11 in April and is now just 12-34 (.261) during the month of April in franchise history.
- *Past Last!*: Since 4/14, the 'Pigs have climbed out of the ND cellar. LHV spent the first 5 days of this season in last place after starting in the cellar their first 70 days of 2008.

TUESDAY NIGHT'S SHUTOUT: FIRST FOR 'KING' LEHR!

After going 70 games without a shutout (dating back to Les Walrond's 17-strikeout gem on 7/6/08 vs. LOU), the IronPigs have two SHOs in their last seven games... RHP Rodrigo Lopez started a 6-0 win 4/28 @ SWB. For RHP **Justin Lehr**, it was his first shutout (as well as CG) in 115 starts in his professional career. Lehr joins Walrond (9.0 ip and 7.0 ip) and LHP Brian Mazzone (7.0 ip) as the only LHV pitchers toss a shutout. In his IL career, Lehr is now 9-3, 2.52 (85.2 ip, 24 er) in 20 G, 12 GS.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 82-129 (.389) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 100-166 (.376) & a combined 68.0 GB.

- The 'Pigs spent the first 5 days of the '09 season in last place... after spending the first 70 days of '08 in last. In franchise history, they've been in the cellar for all but 50 of 180 days (6/13-6/15; 6/23-7/3; 7/28-8/9; 4/15-Pres).

TOP PROSPECTS:

According to *Baseball America*, three of the Top 4 Prospects in the Phillies' system will start in the Lehigh Valley: the returning 22-year-old RHP **Carlos Carrasco** (#2), a three-time member of the World Team's Future Game roster and a pair of 2008 Olympians, C **Lou Marson** (#3) and SS **Jason Donald** (#4).

HUPPERT AMONGST WINNINGEST MANAGERS:

'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** entered 2009 in 3rd place in wins amongst all active managers. The Top 5 also includes two other current IL managers: (1) Marc Bombard, CHA – 1,709; (2) Tom Kotchman – 1,542; (3) **Dave Huppert** – 1,480; (4) Dave Miley, SWB – 1,356; (5) Rick Sweet, LOU – 1,352; (6) Buddy Bailey – 1,309.

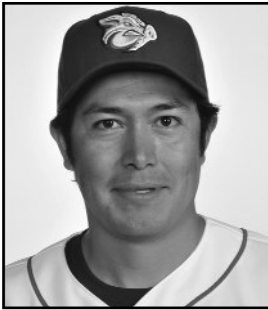
